THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve and Senators played to a scoreless tie through nine innings until the Curve put up three in the top of the 10th to win, 3-0, on Wednesday. Oneil Cruz singled home the placed runner with one out and Logan Hill homered on the next pitch to conclude the entire night's scoring in a two-pitch sequence. Cam Vieaux held Harrisburg to two hits over six scoreless innings during his first game back with the Curve. Jesus Liranzo and Blake Cederlind each pitched two hitless innings to close out Altoona's 13th shutout win of the year.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve play the rubber match of a three-game series versus the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Altoona returns to City Island to finish the season over Labor Day weekend on August 30-September 2 and have 19 games remaining in 19 days.

THE CURVE: The Curve are have won 5 of 9 and seek their second series win since the All-Star Break. Since the July 8-10 break, the Curve are 12-23 and have been outscored 159-127 while batting .234 (261/1116), the second-lowest average in the league over that stretch. Altoona went 25-10 from June 3-July 13, including wins in 7 of 8 entering the All-Star Break, to climb from a season-low five games under .500 (24-29) to a season-best 10 games over (49-39). The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE SENATORS: The First Half Western Division Champions are playoff bound for the first time since 2013. Harrisburg rattled off 21 wins in April before beating the Curve by five games through the end of First Half. From May 1 until the All-Star Break, the Senators went 26-37 but have rebounded to a 17-15 since the break, including a 15-12 mark in July. Harrisburg's 3.35 ERA since the break is the third-best in the E.L. and rank fourth overall at 3.45, fourth in starter ERA at 3.63 and sixth in bullpen ERA at 3.17. Offensively, Harrisburg is fifth in the league scoring 4.03 runs per game, ninth with a .239 batting average, second with a .259 average with men in scoring position and ninth with 79 homers.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Cody Bolton makes his ninth Double-A start and his 21st in the Pirates organization. In his last start, the 21-year-old picked up his second win for the Curve with five scoreless innings to lead a 2-0 win over Richmond at PNG Field last Thursday. Bolton was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star for A-Adv. Bradenton and led the FSL with a 1.61 ERA over his 12 starts at the time of his promotion on June 26. He ranks second among pitchers in the Pirates system with a 0.99 WHIP and ranks fifth with a 2.86 ERA between both levels. Pittsburgh drafted Bolton out of Tracy (Calif.) High School in the sixth round of the 2017 draft. He is ranked by Baseball America as the Pirates' No. 5 prospect while MLB. com ranks the righty at No. 13 in the system... FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Tyler Mapes makes his 22nd start and third against the Curve. Mapes went six innings in his latest outing and allowed five runs (three earned) in his sixth loss of the season. In six starts since the All-Star Break, Mapes is 2-1 with a 3.28 ERA (13 ER/35.2 IP). The Plano, Texas native has pitched twice in Altoona this season and is 0-1 with a 5.91 ERA (7 ER/10.2 IP) against the Curve. Mapes is in his third season with the Senators and is 18-18 with a 3.88 ERA over 54 starts with Harrisburg since 2016, which included an Eastern League All-Star nod in 2016. In 2018, Mapes went 6-1 with a 1.76 ERA over 12 starts for A-Adv. Potomac and was a Carolina League All-Star. Mapes was drafted by the Nationals in the 30th round in 2016 out of Tulane. BRAKE MEN: Altoona's bullpen has been stabalized with a 2.91 ERA (63 ER/194.2 IP) over 57 games since June 12. **Blake Cederlind** has a 1.40 ERA (4 ER/25.2 IP) with 26 strikeouts in his last 19 games since June 14. **Matt Eckelman** is the ninth player in club history to record 20 saves in a single season while his 32 career saves with Altoona are second-most in franchise history. Eckelman has allowed just five earned runs, seven total, with 29 strikeouts in 25 games since the start of June for a 1.67 ERA (5 ER/27 IP). Over 13 outings since June 26, **Joel Cesar** has thrown nine scoreless games with a 2.89 ERA (6 ER/18.2 IP). **Yeudy Garcia** has anchored a 2.61 ERA (9 ER/31 IP) in 17 games since May 30. During his last 23 games since May 19, **Angel German** has yanked his ERA down from 7.07 to 3.97 with 18 scoreless outings, allowing just 17 hits, struck out 32 and has a 2.51 ERA (9 ER/32.1 IP). In parts of two seasons with the Curve, **Jesus Liranzo** has allowed just one earned run over 34.2 innings.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: Eastern League pitchers in 2019 have handcuffed hitters to a .239 league-wide batting average with teams scoring 3.97 runs per game. The last time the league average finished below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs were scored per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57). The league average has finished under .240 just five times since becoming a Double-A league in 1963: 1971 (.234), 1968 (.219), 1967 (.228), 1966 (.234) and 1965 (.236). The circuit has witnessed eight no-hitters in 2019 (two against Altoona), the most since a league-record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. Strikeouts have also spiked to 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965.

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz is hitting .394 (13/33) with seven RBIs over his last nine games and has raised his batting average from .136 to .291. The 6-foot-6 shortstop was limited to 35 games for A-Adv. Bradenton due to a right foot fracture in late April but he still hammered seven homers the Marauders. Since he was activated from the injured list on June 30 until his promotion to Double-A, Cruz led the Florida State League with six homers over a 24-game period along with a .330 (31/94) average, 13 RBIs and 18 runs to earn FSL Player of the Month honors for July. Cruz is the 11th 20-year-old to play for the Curve and the first since Cole Tucker made his Double-A debut on July 20, 2017.

J.O. ON A ROLL: Jared Oliva has hit safely in 25 of his last 32 games since July 13, batting .328 (40/122) but has gone 5-for-25 (.200) over his last six games. Going back to June 3, Oliva has raised his batting average from a season-low .188 to .281, seventh in the E.L., by reaching base in 56 of 65 games by hitting .338 (81/240), 25 points higher than second-best, and has a .404 on-base percentage over that period, also the highest rate in the league. He currently ranks 10th in the E.L. in OPS (.770), eighth in on-base percentage (.356), seventh in hits (108), sixth in triples (5) and sixth in runs (60). In the stolen base department, Oliva ranks second in the E.L. and leads the Pirates system with 32 steals and is the ninth player in club history to surpass 30 stolen bases in a single season.

BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris is ranked eighth in the Eastern League with a career-high 25 doubles and is 10th on the circuit with 106 hits, which also ranks fourth among Pirates minor leaguers. In 14 games since July 31, Madris is batting .333 (13/39) with five doubles. Over his last 39 games since July 2, Madris is hitting .294 (37/126) with 15 extra-base hits and 20 RBIs. All eight of his home runs have occurred on the road while five of them have been go-ahead or game-tying blasts in Curron wice.

POPE'S POKES: Brett Pope has gotten stronger at the plate as the season has progressed. Over his last 53 games since May 25, he has raised his batting average from .169 to .251 by batting .300 (42/140) with eight doubles, one triple, one homer and 16 walks for a .357 on-base percentage. Pope batted a season-best .291 through the month of June and over his last 18 games since July 22, he is hitting .347 (17/49) and is 9-for-24 (.375) with four extra-base hits in 11 August games.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features four of *Baseball America*'s Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects with infielder **Oneil Cruz** (No. 3), right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 5), right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 24) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Ponce** (No. 30). After the latest MLB.com Mid-Season update, four Top 30 Pirates prospects are in Altoona with Cruz (No. 3), **Jared Oliva** (No. 11), Bolton (No. 13) and right-handed reliever Cederlind (No. 28). Across all of baseball, Cruz is ranked by *Baseball America* as their No. 79 overall prospect while MLB.com ranks him at No. 62.

Altoona franchise is 6 wins from reaching 1,500 regular season victories over the ballclub's 21-year history. Manager **Michael Ryan** is 8 wins from 500 for his managerial career and needs two more victories to reach 214 as the Curve skipper, which would be the most by a manager in team history. He is 212-187 overall for the Curve and his next win will tie Dale Sveum (2001-03) and Tim Leiper (2006-08) for the club record. **Matt Eckelman** is seven saves from passing **Montana DuRapau** for the franchise's all-time saves record.
