

THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve were defeated, 6-2, on Friday to start the homestand. Bowie outhit the Curve, 13-8 in the win. Bowie's Zach Jarrett hit a two-run double to open up a 3-0 lead in the top of the fourth before Carlos Perez socked a solo homer in the sixth. During the seventh, Cedric Mullins pulled a two-run homer down the right field line to make it 6-1. Oneil Cruz knocked home Jared Oliva on a double in the fourth for the first Curve run of the night while Bligh Madris scored on an error in the ninth to tighten the final score to four.

TODAY'S GAME: The penultimate homestand continues for the Curve with the second contest of a three-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Bowie has won each of the previous two series played between the two ballclubs, including taking 2 of 3 in Altoona on May 6-8 and 3 of 4 in Bowie on July 18-21, and have outscored the Curve 49-27. The Curve play four more games at Prince George's Stadium on their next road trip on August 22-25. Altoona is in the homestretch of the season with 17 games remaining over the next 17 days.

THE CURVE: The Curve have lost 5 of 6 and have been outscored 46-25 while facing Reading, Harrisburg and Bowie. Since the July 8-10 break, the Curve are 12-25, have won just one series and have been outscored 177-130 while batting .232 (274/1180), the second-lowest average in the league over that stretch. Altoona went 25-10 from June 3-July 13, including wins in 7 of 8 entering the All-Star Break, to climb from a season-low five games under .500 (24-29) to a season-best 10 games over (49-39). The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE BAYSOX: Bowie was 7-23 when the club last visited Altoona and have gone a league-best 61-32 since that date, including 20 wins in each June and July. Bowie is armed with the best pitching staff in the Eastern League, holding a 3.20 ERA overall with the second-best starter ERA (3.32) and fourth-best bullpen (3.02). Offensively, Bowie leads the league in the clutch by batting .266 with runners in scoring position. The Baysox score runs at the third-highest rate in the league (4.19). per game), rank second in overall team batting average (.245) and have hit the sixth-most homers (84) in the E.L.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Pedro Vasquez will make his 21st outing for the Curve and 22nd overall between Double-A and Triple-A. In his last start, he took a no-decision on August 11 versus Reading and was taken out 4.2 innings, 90 pitches, three runs allowed and a season-high three walks. Vasquez was an Eastern League All-Star and pitched a 1-2-3 third inning in the Eastern League All-Star Game in Richmond to aid a 5-0 victory for the Western Divison over the Eastern Divison on July 10. He ranks fifth in the E.L. with a 2.91 ERA and fourth with a 1.13 WHIP. The right-hander from Santo Domingo was originally signed by Seattle as an international free agent in 2015 and was acquired by the Pirates in a trade on September 1, 2016 as a player-to-be-named later for RHP Arquimedes Caminero...For more on Vasquez, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander Zac Lowther makes his 23rd start of the year and third against the Curve. Lowther, a 2019 Eastern League All-Star, Lowther struck out eight in seven innings on August 11 in Richmond but was handed the loss when he allowed three runs in a 3-1 defeat. In two starts against the Curve, Lowther won his July 19 in Bowie (3 R/7 IP) and was defeated at PNG Field on May 7 (3 R/6 IP). He pitched a scoreless fourth inning for the Western Division All-Stars in the E.L. All-Star Game in Richmond that resulted in a 5-0 win over the Eastern Division. A native of Northeast Ohio, the lefty leads the E.L. in wins (12) and batting average against (.192) while he ranks fourth in ERA (2.71), third in strikeouts (124), fifth in WHIP (1.14) and walked the second-most (58). Lowther was the 74th overall selection by the Orioles in the second Competive Balance round of the 2017 draft out of Xavier and is the No. 10 prospect in Baltimore's system.

BRAKE MEN: A number of relievers have been reliable options out of the Curve bullpen. **Blake Cederlind** has a 1.40 ERA (4 ER/25.2 IP) with 26 strikeouts in his last 19 games since June 14. **Matt Eckelman** is the ninth player in club history to record 20 saves in a single season while his 32 career saves with Altoona are second-most in franchise history. Eckelman has allowed just five earned runs, seven total, with 30 strikeouts in 26 games since the start of June for a 1.61 ERA (5 ER/28 IP). During his last 24 games since May 19, **Angel German** has yanked his ERA down from 7.07 to 3.75 with 19 scoreless outings, allowing just 17 hits, struck out 35 and has a 2.31 ERA (9 ER/35 IP). In parts of two seasons with the Curve, **Jesus Liranzo** has allowed just one earned run over 34.2 innings.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: Eastern League pitchers in 2019 have handcuffed hitters to a .239 league-wide batting average with teams scoring 3.95 runs per game. The last time the league average finished below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs were scored per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57). The league average has finished under .240 just five times since becoming a Double-A league in 1963: 1971 (.234), 1968 (.219), 1967 (.228), 1966 (.234) and 1965 (.236). The circuit has witnessed eight no-hitters in 2019 (two against Altoona), the most since a league-record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. Strikeouts have also spiked to 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965. The Curve are on pace to set new offensive lows in team batting average (.252 in 2013), runs scored (539 in 2008) and hits (1,142 in 2018) while also nearing the most strikeouts (1,155 in 2014) by a team in club history.

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz is hitting .368 (14/38) with nine RBIs and four walks over his last 11 games since August 5 and has raised his batting average from .136 to .283. The 6-foot-6 shortstop was limited to 35 games for A-Adv. Bradenton due to a right foot fracture in late April but he still hammered seven homers the Marauders. Since he was activated from the injured list on June 30 until his promotion to Double-A, Cruz led the Florida State League with six homers over a 24-game period along with a .330 (31/94) average, 13 RBIs and 18 runs to earn FSL Player of the Month honors for July. Cruz is the 11th 20-year-old to play for the Curve and the first since Cole Tucker made his Double-A debut on July 20, 2017.

J.O. ON A ROLL: Jared Oliva has hit safely in 26 of his last 33 games since July 13, batting .331 (42/127). Going back to June 3, Oliva has raised his batting average from a season-low .188 to .283, fifth in the E.L., by reaching base in 56 of 65 games by hitting .339 (83/245), 25 points higher than second-best, and has a .404 on-base percentage over that period, also the highest rate in the league. He currently ranks ninth in the E.L. in OPS (.771), seventh in on-base percentage (.357), seventh in hits (110), sixth in triples (5) and sixth in runs (61). In the stolen base department, Oliva ranks second in the E.L. and leads the Pirates system with 32 steals and is the ninth player in club history to surpass 30 stolen bases in a single season.

BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris is ranked eighth in the Eastern League with a career-high 25 doubles and 109 hits, which also ranks fifth among Pirates minor leaguers. In 16 games since July 31, Madris is batting .348 (16/46) with five doubles. Over his last 41 games since July 2, Madris is hitting .301 (40/133) with 15 extra-base hits and 20 RBIs. All eight of his home runs have occurred on the road while five of them have been go-ahead or game-tying blasts in Curve wins.

POPE'S POKES: Brett Pope has gotten stronger at the plate as the season has progressed. Over his last 55 games since May 25, he has raised his batting average from .169 to .249 by batting .295 (43/146) with nine doubles, one triple, one homer and 13 walks for a .358 on-base percentage. After Pope batted a season-best .291 through the month of June, he is hitting .327 (18/55) over his last 21 games since July 22 and is 10-for-30 (.300) with five extra-base hits in 13 August

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features four of *Baseball America*'s Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects with infielder **Oneil Cruz** (No. 3), right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 5), right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 24) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Ponce** (No. 30). After the latest MLB.com Mid-Season update, four Top 30 Pirates prospects are in Altoona with Cruz (No. 3), **Jared Oliva** (No. 11), Bolton (No. 13) and right-handed reliever Cederlind (No. 28). Across all of baseball, Cruz is ranked by *Baseball America* as their No. 79 overall prospect while MLB.com ranks him at No. 62.

MILESTONE TRACKER: The Altoona franchise is 6 wins from reaching 1,500 regular season victories over the ballclub's 21-year history. Manager Michael Ryan is 8 wins from 500 for his managerial career and needs two more victories to reach 214 as the Curve skipper, which would be the most by a manager in team history. He is 212-187 overall for the Curve and his next win will tie Dale Sveum (2001-03) and Tim Leiper (2006-08) for the club record. Matt Eckelman is seven saves from passing Montana DuRapau for the franchise's all-time saves record.

Signed as an international free agent by the Seattle Mariners on April 8, 2015...Made 15 starts in the DSL that year and tied for the league lead with eight wins, led the league with 91.0 innings pitched and finished third in the circuit with a 0.88 WHIP...Began 2016 with rookie AZL Mariners and turned in quality starts in three of four games started before a promotion to Single-A Clinton on July 17, 2016...Threw an eight-inning complete game on July 30, 2016 but was charged with loss in 1-0 defeat...Revealed as player to be named later along with LHP Jake Brentz on September 1, 2016 in trade that sent RHP Arquimedes Caminero to the Mariners on August 6, 2016...
