**THE LAST TIME OUT:** The Curve were led by **Cam Vieaux** in a shutout, 3-0 win over Hartford on Monday. The left-handed starter went seven scoreless innings, his second straight scoreless start since returning to Altoona, before single frames from **Jesus Liranzo** and **Matt Eckelman**. Altoona's offense connected on four straight singles that led to all three of their runs in the first inning against Antonio Santos. Santos settled in to pitched seven innings and allowed one hit beyond the opening frame.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The penultimate homestand continues for the Curve with the second game of three against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. The current three-game series will conclude the season series between the Curve and Yard Goats and is the last cross-divisional series for Altoona in 2019. The two ballclubs met on June 21-23 at Dunkin' Donuts Park and saw Hartford claim 2 of 3. Altoona is in the homestretch of the season with 14 games remaining over the next 14 days.

**THE CURVE:** The Curve have won three straight and 6 of 11, including five via the shutout. The last four-game winning streak for Altoona was in the final four games before the league's All-Star Break. Since the All-Star Break, the Curve are 15-25 and have been outscored 181-143 while batting .235 (298/1270), the second-lowest average in the league over that stretch. Altoona has also won just two series since the break, including 2 of 3 over Bowie to start the homestand. The Curve went 25-10 from June 3-July 13, including wins in 7 of 8 entering the All-Star Break, to climb from a season-low five games under .500 (24-29) to a season-best 10 games over (49-39). In the franchise's 20 previous seasons, the Curve have compiled 13 winning seasons, including four in a row since 2015.

**THE YARD GOATS:** Hartford had their season-long, five-game winning streak snapped on Monday in Altoona. They started their current road trip with a three-game sweep in Binghamton and have won 9 of 12. The Yard Goats' surge has the club in contention for the Second Half, trailing first place Reading by five games, after finishing the First Half just two games behind Trenton and Reading's first-place tie. Hartford's offense ranks second-to-last in runs per game (3.77) and team batting average (.232) but is tied for third in batting with runners in scoring position (.258), home runs (98) and stolen bases (102). From a pitching perspective, Yard Goats pitchers have the third-best ERA (3.29), fourth-best rotation (3.60) and second-best bullpen (2.87). The Hartford roster includes three Top 30 Rockies prospects according to MLB.com: INF Colton Welker (No. 3), INF Tyler Nevin (No. 11) and RHP Justin Lawrence (No. 18).

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Beau Sulser** makes his fourth start of the season and 31st outing overall. He last pitched in relief on August 15 in Harrisburg with 3.1 scoreless frames. After he allowed 10 runs in 6.2 innings over three games from July 16-24, Sulser has returned to form in his last five games with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/14 IP). Sulser has logged multiples in 26 times with scoreless efforts on 18 occasions. A native of Escondido, Calif., Sulser has starting experience from his 2017 debut season with short-season West Virginia and at Dartmouth College, where he was the Ivy League Pitcher of the Year as a senior. Sulser was drafted by the Pirates in the 10th round of the 2017 draft...*For more on Sulser, see page two.*

**FOR HARTFORD:** Left-hander **Matt Whitehouse** takes the mound for his 11th outing (sixth start) for the Yard Goats. He last pitched in relief on August 11 versus Binghamton and spent August 12-19 on the injured list. Whitehouse started the season in the Indians organization and was on Akron's Opening Day roster prior to getting called up to Triple-A Columbus to make his season debut. He was released by Cleveland on June 17 before he was picked up by the Rockies on June 22. Whitehouse was drafted by the Indians in the 19th round in 2013 out of UC Irvine and has made 77 of his 158 career outings in the Eastern League. Today's start is his 10th appearance against Altoona and is 0-1 with a 4.79 ERA (11 ER/20.2 IP).

**RYAN'S REIGN:** Indiana, Pa. native **Michael Ryan** became the winningest manager in Curve history with his 214th win on Sunday over Bowie. Ryan is now 215-189 as Altoona's manager and was the fastest to reach the 200-win milestone in his 365th game on July 12 in Erie. Over his seven-year managerial career, Ryan is a two-time league champion, which included the 2017 Eastern League Championship with the Curve, and has a career record of 495-458.

**HEROES OF THE ZEROES:** Monday's 3-0 win over Hartford was the 15th scoreless effort by the pitching staff in 2019, the second-highest total by a team in the Eastern League and one shy of a team record. The 2015 Curve pitching staff obliterated the previous record of 11 with 16 shutouts. That ballclub featured notable pitching alumni Steven Brault, Tyler Glasnow and Chad Kuhl.

**BRAKE MEN:** A number of relievers have been reliable options out of the Curve bullpen. **Blake Cederlind** has a 1.35 ERA (4 ER/26.2 IP) with 27 strikeouts in his last 20 games since June 14. **Matt Eckelman** is the ninth player in club history to record 20 saves in a single season while his 33 career saves with Altoona are second-most in franchise history. Eckelman has allowed just five earned runs, seven total, with 30 strikeouts in 28 games since the start of June for a 1.50 ERA (5 ER/30 IP). During his last 24 games since May 19, **Angel German** has yanked his ERA down from 7.07 to 3.75 with 19 scoreless outings, allowing just 17 hits, struck out 35 and has a 2.31 ERA (9 ER/35 IP). In parts of two seasons with the Curve, **Jesus Liranzo** has allowed just one earned run and 17 hits over 35.22 innings.

**YEAR OF THE PITCHER:** Eastern League pitchers in 2019 have handcuffed hitters to a .239 league-wide batting average with teams scoring 3.94 runs per game. The last time the league average finished below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs were scored per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57). The league average has finished under .240 just five times since becoming a Double-A league in 1963: 1971 (.234), 1968 (.219), 1967 (.228), 1966 (.234) and 1965 (.236). The circuit has witnessed eight no-hitters in 2019 (two against Altoona), the most since a league-record nine no-hos were thrown in 1967. Strikeouts have also spiked to 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965. The Curve are on pace to set new offensive lows in team batting average (.252 in 2013), runs scored (539 in 2008) and hits (1,142 in 2018) while also nearing the most strikeouts (1,155 in 2014) by a team in club history.

**CRUZ CONTROL:** **Oneil Cruz** is hitting .341 (16/47) with 12 RBIs and six walks over his last 14 games since August 5 and has raised his batting average from .336 to .275. The 6-foot-6 shortstop was limited to 35 games for A-Adv. Bradenton due to a right foot fracture in late April but he still hammered seven homers for the Marauders. Since he was activated from the injured list on June 30 until his promotion to Double-A, Cruz led the Florida State League with six homers over a 24-game period along with a .330 (31/94) average, 13 RBIs and 18 runs to earn FSL Player of the Month honors for July. Cruz is the 11th 20-year-old to play for the Curve and the first since Cole Tucker made his Double-A debut on July 20, 2017.

**J.O. ON A ROLL:** Since June 3, **Jared Oliva** has resurrected his batting average from a season-low .188 to .283, fourth in the E.L., by reaching base in 59 of 69 games by hitting .337 (86/255), 18 points higher than second-best, and has a .399 on-base percentage over that period, also the highest rate in the league. He currently ranks ninth in the E.L. in OPS (.774), ninth in on-base percentage (.355), sixth in hits (113), second in triples (6) and fifth in runs (64). In the stolen base department, Oliva ranks second in the E.L. and leads the Pirates system with 33 steals and is the ninth player in club history to surpass 30 stolen bases in a single season. Defensively, Oliva has played 100 games in the outfield without an error and leads Eastern League outfielders in total chances.

**KING OF THE HILL:** **Logan Hill** was named Eastern League Player of the Week for August 12-18 by leading the league with three homers, nine RBIs, a .958 slugging percentage and 1.438 OPS while hitting .458 (11/24) over six games. Since August 10, Hill has hit safely on 7 of 9 and is batting .361 (13/36) with four doubles, three homers and 11 RBIs. Hill is now ranked fifth in the Eastern League with 59 RBIs, 26 doubles and sixth with 39 extra-base hits.

**BLIGH GUY:** **Bligh Madris** is ranked 10th in the Eastern League with a career-high 25 doubles and 110 hits, which also ranks fifth among Pirates minor leaguers. In 18 games since July 31, Madris is batting .321 (11/33) with five doubles. Over his last 43 games since July 2, Madris is hitting .293 (41/140) with 15 extra-base hits and 21 RBIs. All eight of his home runs have occurred on the road while five of them have been go-ahead or game-tying blasts in Curve wins.

**POPE'S POKES:** **Brett Pope** has gotten stronger at the plate as the season has progressed. Over his last 57 games since May 25, he has raised his batting average from .169 to .254 by batting .299 (47/157) with 10 doubles, one triple, one homer and 14 walks for a .362 on-base percentage. After Pope batted a season-best .291 through the month of June, he is hitting .333 (22/66) over his last 24 games since July 22 and is 14-for-41 (.341) with six extra-base hits in 16 August games.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features four of *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects with infielder **Oneil Cruz** (No. 3), right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 5), right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 24) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Ponce** (No. 30). After the latest *MLB.com* Mid-Season update, four Top 30 Pirates prospects are in Altoona with Cruz (No. 3), **Jared Oliva** (No. 11), Bolton (No. 13) and right-handed reliever Cederlind (No. 28). Across all of baseball, Cruz is ranked by *Baseball America* as their No. 79 overall prospect while *MLB.com* ranks him at No. 62.

Drafted by the Pirates in the 10th round (298th overall) in 2017 out of Dartmouth College...Attended Ramona (Calif.) High School and was a three-time letterman...Over four years at Dartmouth, compiled a 13-7 record and 3.48 ERA over four-year career including a 6-1 record and 1.40 ERA over seven starts as a senior...2017 Ivy League Pitcher of the Year while 0.80 WHIP ranked second in the nation and 1.40 ERA was third-lowest...Brother, Cole, is a pitcher in the Rays organization and was drafted by the Indians in the 25th round out of Dartmouth in 2015...Started pro career with short-season West Virginia Black Bears in 2017 and went 2-4 with a 5.31 ERA in 18 appearances with six starts...Spent all of 2018 in the Single-A West Virginia Power bullpen and compiled a 2.35 ERA and 5-8 record...Led all SAL relievers with the lowest walk rate (0.47) and fewest baserunners (7.85) per nine innings...Ranked fourth among Pirates minor leaguers with eight saves in 2018

Ryan is the all-time winningest manager in Altoona Curve history, a record he set on Aug. 18, 2019. He is in his third season after guiding the Curve to back-to-back Western Division crowns. In his first season, the Curve won the 2017 Eastern League title. He went on to manage the 2018 Eastern League All-Star Game. Ryan started his coaching career with the Curve in 2012. He is in his seventh season as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders from 2015-16 and the West Virginia Power from 2014-15. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016 and won the Florida State League championship. Ryan played 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors, after he was a fifth-round draft choice by the Minnesota Twins in 1996.

Hanrahan joins the Curve in 2019 for his third season as a pitching coach in the Pittsburgh minor league system. He started his coaching career with the Bristol Pirates in 2017 and most recently oversaw pitchers for the West Virginia Power last year. Hanrahan was a two-time National League All-Star with the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2011 and 2012 while he served as the team's closer. He was the first Bucs closer to notch 40 saves in a single season and recorded 82 saves, fifth all-time, during four seasons in Pittsburgh. A second-round pick by the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2000, he played 14 total seasons and seven years as a right-handed reliever in the majors. He also played six major league seasons.

Nunnally comes to the Curve for his first year in the Pirates organization and 12th season as a coach in professional baseball. During the 2010-11 seasons, he was the hitting coach for the Cleveland Indians under manager Manny Acta. Nunnally spent the last two seasons as the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for the Los Angeles Angels. He has served as a hitting coach in the Indians, Toronto Blue Jays and Boston Red Sox development systems with Eastern League stops in New Hampshire (2012, 14) and Portland (2016). As a player, Nunnally was drafted by Cleveland in the third round in 1992 and played 15 seasons. He also played six major league seasons.

Paniagua joins the Curve for his third season as a coach in the Pirates organization. He started his coaching career in 2017 with the Bristol Pirates and was the hitting coach for the Dominican Summer League affiliate last year. He played for 13 years as an international signee out of the Dominican Republic. Paniagua spent parts of six seasons as a member of the Boston Red Sox and New York Mets minor league systems that included Eastern League experience with Portland (2007) and Binghamton (2008-09). He also spent six seasons (2011-16) with the independent York Revolution and is the longest-tenured position player in franchise history.

In his eighth season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens returns to Altoona for a third season in 2019. In 2018, Ahrens was the trainer for the Western Division for the Eastern League All-Star Classic. He spent two years in Bradenton from 2015-16, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. He spent each of the last six seasons on the same staff as manager Michael Ryan. Ahrens received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.
