THE LAST TIME OUT: Domingo Robles led the second nine-inning, complete-game shutout in four games for the Curve to beat the RubberDucks, 5-0. Robles held Akron to five hits and struck out five, walking just one. The offense was put up all the run support he needed with three runs in the third inning, **Bligh Madris** singled home **Jason Delay** with one out fol-lowed by a two-run single by **Logan Hill**. Later in the sixth, **Adrian Valerio** recorded his second hit of the game and plated a pair to tack on a couple of insurance runs. The victory was No. 1,500 for the Altoona franchise.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue their final homestand of the 2019 season with the second of a four-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. The season series has seen the Curve win 3 of 4 series, outscore Akron 58-50 and play 10 games decided by three runs or less. The RubberDucks opened PNG Field back in April and will play the last games in Altoona for the second straight year, including the 2018 playoffs. The 2019 Eastern League playoffs will not feature Altoona or Akron for the first time since 2013.

THE CURVE: The Curve are 9-9 over their last 18 games and have pitched seven shutouts in that period. Since the All-Star Break, the Curve are 18-29 and have been outscored 204-174. The Curve went 25-10 from June 3-July 13, including wins in 7 of 8 entering the All-Star Break, to climb from a season-low five games under .500 (24-29) to a season-best 10 games over (49-39). In the franchise's 20 previous seasons, the Curve have compiled 13 winning seasons, including four in a row since 2015.

THE RUBBERDUCKS: Akron will finish with their second losing season in three years but just the eighth overall in 31 years of Eastern League action. The five-time league champs were a season-low 16 games below .500 before they swept Richmond in four games prior to their trip to Altoona. Akron's franchise had not been more than 15 games under .500 since the end of the 2004 season (63-78). The 'Ducks score 4.03 runs per game, fifth-most in the E.L., and are tied with Altoona for the fourth-highest team batting average of .242 while ranking seventh with runners in scoring position (.249). Addition-ally, Akron's 99 home runs are fourth-most but their 76 steals as a team are second-fewest. From a pitching perspective, the RubberDucks are fifth with a 3.49 team ERA but have the best bullpen in the league with a 2.77 ERA. Akron's roster includes Top 30 Indians prospects INF Nolan Jones (No. 1), LHP Sam Hentges (No. 15) and INF Ernie Clement (No. 26).

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Pedro Vasquez** will make his 23rd outing for the Curve and 25th overall between Double-A and Triple-A. After Vasquez pitched eight scoreless innings two starts ago versus Bowie, the Baysox chased him after two innings in his most recent start with four early runs and 58 pitches. Vasquez was an Eastern League All-Star and pitched a 1-2-3 third inning in the Eastern League All-Star Game in Richmond to aid a 5-0 victory for the Western Divison over the Eastern Divison on July 10. He ranks fifth in the E.L. with a 2.97 ERA, seventh with a 1.15 WHIP and 10th in the league with a .243 batting average against. The right-hander from Santo Domingo was originally signed by Seattle as an international free agent in 2015 and was acquired by the Pirates in a trade on September 1, 2016 as a player-to-be-named later for RHP Arquimedes Caminero...*For more on Vasquez, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Kyle Dowdy takes the hill for the sixth time for Akron (third start) and 29th time overall in 2019. Dowdy was originally a 12th round pick by the Detroit Tigers out of the University of Houston in 2015 and was traded to the Cleveland Indians on July 31, 2018 with infelder Will Castro for outfielder Leonys Martin. The New York Mets made Dowdy a Rule 5 selection and traded him to the Texas Rangers on March 26, 2019 and made his MLB debut on Opening Day (March 28, 2019) pitching in relief against the Chicago Cubs. Dowdy pitched 13 games for the Rangers, including one start and two games against the Pittsburgh Pirates in May, before he was designated for assignment and returned to the Indians on July 28. The 26-year-old spent most of 2018 in the Eastern League with Erie and Akron and went 0-3 with a 7.64 ERA (15 ER/17.2 IP) in five outings against the Curve.

CHANGING THE NARRATIVE: The Curve have already clinched the season series against Akron, making 2019 the seventh time with a .500 record or better and fifth winning year against the Akron franchise. The Curve went 6-1 at Canal Park in 2019, just the fourth time in franchise history that an Altoona team had a winning record in Akron. In three seasons under Altoona manager Michael Ryan, the Curve are 33-24 and have won the season series two years in a row.

RYAN'S REIGN: Indiana, Pa. native **Michael Ryan** became the winningest manager in Curve history with his 214th win on August 18 over Bowie. Ryan is now 218-193 as Altoona's manager and was the fastest to reach the 200-win milestone in his 365th game on July 12 in Erie. Over his seven-year managerial career, Ryan is a two-time league champion, which included the 2017 Eastern League Championship with the Curve, and has a career record of 498-462.

HEROES OF THE ZEROES: Domingo Robles' nine-inning, complete-game shutout against Akron on Monday was the 17th scoreless effort by the pitching staff in 2019, setting a new single-season club record and the most in the Eastern League this season. The 2015 Curve pitching staff held the previous record of 16 shutouts. The nine-inning shutout for Robles was the second during the current trip through the rotation, joining **Sean Brady**'s complete-game shutout on Friday night in Bowie. Four of the Curve's shutouts this season have been individual feat while Robles is one of just six pitchers in Minor League Baseball with multiple complete-game shutouts. There have now been 18 nine-inning, complete-game shutouts in team history and the first time that multiple have been thrown in the same season since Tom Gorzelanny fired two in 2005. ัพลร game shutouts in fired two in 2005.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: Eastern League pitchers in 2019 have handcuffed hitters to a .239 league-wide batting average with teams scoring 3.94 runs per game. The last time the league average finished below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs were scored per game was in 1971 (.234, 3.57). The league average has finished under .240 just five times since becoming a Double-A league in 1963: 1971 (.234, 1988 (.219), 1967 (.228), 1966 (.234) and 1965 (.236). The circuit has witnessed eight no-hitters in 2019 (two against Altoona), the most since a league-record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. Strikeouts have also spiked to 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965. The Curve are on pace to set new offensive lows in team batting average (.252 in 2013), runs scored (539 in 2008) and hits (1,142 in 2018) while already tying the most strikeouts (1,155 in 2014) by a team in club history.

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz drove his first Double-A homer to the opposite field on Saturday night in Bowie. The Pirates' No. 3 prospect is hitting .301 (22/73) with 14 RBIs, eight extra-base hits and seven walks over his last 21 games since August 5 to raise his batting average from .136 to .263. The 6-foot-6 shortstop was limited to 35 games for A-Adv. Bradenton due to a right foot fracture in late April but he still hammered seven homers for the Marauders. Since he was activated from the infjured list on June 30 until his promotion to Double-A, Cruz led the Florida State League with six homers over a 24-game period along with a .330 (31/94) average, 13 RBIs and 18 runs to earn FSL Player of the Month honors for July. Cruz is the 11th 20-year-old to play for the Curve and the first since Cole Tucker made his Double-A debut on July 20, 2017.

J.O. IS ALL-E.L.: Jared Oliva was named an End-of-Season All-Star by the Eastern League on Friday by having one of the most complete seasons on both sides of the ball. Oliva ranks second in the E.L. batting race at .285 behind Portland's C.J. Chatham (.297) and has a chance to become the third Curve player to win the batting title, joining Brock Holt (.322) in 2012 and Starling Marte (.332) in 2011. Jeff Keppinger hit .341 in 2004 but played 82 of 96 E.L. games for the Curve and was traded to the Mets at the trade deadline. From a defensive standpoint, Oliva's 107 games in the outfield and 284 total chances are each the most by any outfielder without an error in Minor League Baseball. Since June 3, Oliva has batted .336 (94/280) over 76 games with a .400 on-base percentage, .882 OPS, 94 hits and 51 runs scored, all league-highs over that period. Overall this season, Oliva ranks ninth in the E.L. in OPS (.771), seventh in on-base percentage (.358), fifth in hits (121), third in triples (6) and fifth in runs (69). In the stolen base department, his 34 steals are second in the E.L. and the Pirates minor league system.


KING OF THE HILL: Logan Hill was named Eastern League Player of the Week for August 12-18 by leading the leauge with three homers, nine RBIs, a .958 slugging percentage and 1.438 OPS while hitting .458 (11/24) over six games. Since August 10, Hill has hit safely on 11 of 16 and is batting .328 (20/61) with five homers, four doubles and 19 RBIs. Hill is ranked third in the Eastern League with 67 RBIs while also tied for sixth with 41 extra-base hits and seventh with 26 doubles.

BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris is ranked 10th in the Eastern League with a career-high 25 doubles and seventh with 115 hit: which also ranks fourth among Pirates minor leaguers. In 24 games since July 31, Madris is batting .293 (22/75) with f doubles. Over his last 49 games since July 2, Madris is hitting .284 (46/162) with 15 extra-base hits and 22 RBIs. All eig of his home runs have occurred on the road while five of them have been go-ahead or game-tying blasts in Curve wins

POPE'S POKES: Brett Pope has gotten stronger at the plate as the season has progressed. Over his last 64 games since May 25, he has raised his batting average from .169 to .247 by batting .283 (51/180) with 11 doubles, one triple, one homer and 16 walks for a .347 on-base percentage. After Pope batted a season-best .291 through the month of June, he is hitting .292 (26/89) over his last 30 games since July 22 and is 18-for-64 (.281) with seven extra-base hits in 22 August games.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features two of *Baseball America*'s Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects with infielder **Oneil Cruz** (No. 3) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 5). After the latest MLB.com Mid-Season update, three Top 30 Pirates prospects are in Altoona with Cruz (No. 3), **Jared Oliva** (No. 11) and Bolton (No. 13). At the start of the season, Oliva was rated by *Baseball America* as the Pirates' No. 19 prospect and "Best Defensive Outfielder". Across all of baseball, Cruz is ranked by *Baseball America* as their No. 79 overall prospect while MLB.com ranks him at No. 62.


