LHP Sean Brady (5-12, 4.32) vs. RHP Kevin McGowan (1-3, 5.06) END OF SEASON

THE LAST TIME OUT: After five superb innings from **Domingo Robles**, the Curve lost a 5-1 lead when Harrisburg posted 13 runs against the bullpen and rolled to a 14-7 victory. Robles retired the first 11 hitters he faced in the game and struck out six over five one-run innings. Altoona built a lead behind two early **RBIs** from **Logan Hill** and **Bligh Madris** along with a solo homer by **Brett Pope**. Harrisburg inched within two runs in the sixth with a pair against Altoona reliever **Yeudy Garcia** and then scored 11 runs in the seventh after 14 batters went to the plate against four different pitchers. Austin Stevenson capped off the scoring for Harrisburg with a grand slam off **Angel German**.

TODAY'S GAME: The last series of the season for the Curve continues with the third contest of a four-game series versus the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. With wins in the first two games of the series, the Senators have already clinched the season series and have taken back the Route 22 Trophy for the first time since the 2015-16 seasons, snapping Altoona's two-year run with the hardware. The Senators won 2 of 3 the last time the two clubs met on City Island on August 13-15 and outscored Altoona 25-14. In 18 games between the two ballclubs in 2019, Harrisburg has outscored the Curve 82-74.

THE CURVE: The Curve have lost their last two by a combined score of 18-8 after they won their previous four entering the series. Over the last 23 games, the Curve are 12-11 with eight shutout wins. Before the current series with Harrisburg began, Altoona was 9-4 over their previous 13 games and had a 2.29 ERA (29 ER/114 IP) over that period, the second-lowest mark in the E.L. Since the All-Star Break, the Curve are 21-31 and have been outscored 225-196. The Curve went 25-10 from June 3-July 13, including wins in 7 of 8 entering the All-Star Break, to climb from a season-low five games under .500 (24-29) to a season-best 10 games over (49-39). The next victory for the Curve would guarantee a .500 finish and set up a chance at a fifth straight winning season, which would be the 14th in the team's 21-year history.

THE SENATORS: The First Half Western Division Champions are playoff bound for the first time since 2013. Harrisburg rattled off 21 wins in April before beating the Curve by five games through the end of First Half. From May 1 until the All-Star Break, the Senators went 26-37 but have rebounded to a 27-22 record since the break. More recently, Harrisburg is 9-5 over their last 14. Harrisburg ranks fourth in pitching with a 3.49 ERA, fifth in starter ERA at 3.77 and third in bullpen ERA at 3.02. Offensively, Harrisburg is fourth in the league scoring 4.1 runs per game, fourth with a .242 batting average, tied for first with a .268 average with men in scoring position and their 87 homers rank ninth.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Pedro Vasquez will make his team-leading 23rd start and 26th appearance overall between Double-A and Triple-A. In his latest start, Vasquez earned his eighth win of the year after seven scoreless innings versus Akron on Tuesday. The 2019 Eastern League All-Star has pitched to a 2.12 ERA (4 ER/17 IP) over his last three starts that featured scoreless efforts of eight and seven innings. He ranks fifth in the E.L. with a 2.79 ERA and 1.11 WHIP. This marks the first start on City Island for Vasquez and has a 0.82 (1 ER/11 IP) with 12 strikeouts and no walks in two career starts against Harrisburg. The right-hander from Santo Domingo was originally signed by Seattle as an international free agent in 2015 and was acquired by the Pirates in a trade on September 1, 2016 as a player-to-be-named later for RHP Arquimedes Caminero... FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Mario Sanchez takes the hill for his 23rd outing and 19th start. He had his shortest start of the season in his latest assignment on Tuesday in Hartford when he lasted 3.2 innings and allowed five runs. Prior to that outing, he had thrown four straight quality starts and pitched to a 1.04 ERA (3 ER/26 IP) with 21 strikeouts and one walk. Sanchez is ranked seventh in the league with his nine wins and has allowed the third-most homers (17) in the league. He started the year in Harrisburg and spent most of May at Triple-A Fresno but allowed 21 runs (18 earned) in four outings. The 24-year-old native of Venezuela was originally an international signing by the Nationals in 2012 and was traded to the Phillies on December 12, 2016 as the player to be named for RHP Jimmy Cordero, who was dealt a month earlier. Sanchez reached Double-A Reading in 2017 but missed most of 2018 recovering from Tommy John surgery. Washington resigned him as a minor league free agent prior to the 2019 season.

RYAN'S REIGN: Indiana, Pa. native **Michael Ryan** became the winningest manager in Curve history with his 214th win on August 18 over Bowie. Ryan is now 221-195 as Altoona's manager and was the fastest to reach the 200-win milestone in his 365th game on July 12 in Erie. Over his seven-year managerial career, Ryan is a two-time league champion, which included the 2017 Eastern League Championship with the Curve, and has a career record of 501-464.

HEROES OF THE ZEROES: Altoona extended a team record with their 18th shutout over Akron on Tuesday, which also leads the Eastern League this season. Two individual nine-inning, complete-game shutouts by **Sean Brady** and **Domingo Robles** tied and surpassed the previous team record of 16 shutouts by the 2015 Curve. Brady and Robles' performances are the first multiple nine-inning shutouts to be pitched by the Curve in the same season since Tom Gorzelanny threw two in 2005.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: Eastern League pitchers in 2019 have handcuffed hitters to a .239 league-wide batting average with teams scoring 3.94 runs per game. The last time the league average finished below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs were scored per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57). The league average has finished under .240 just five times since becoming a Double-A league in 1963: 1971 (.234), 1968 (.219), 1967 (.228), 1966 (.234) and 1965 (.236). The circuit has witnessed eight no-hitters in 2019 (two against Altoona), the most since a league-record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. Strikeouts have also spiked to 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965. The Curve are on pace to set new offensive lows in team batting average (.252 in 2013) and hits (1,142 in 2018) while already setting a new single-season record for offensive strikeouts (1,201 to pass 1,155 in 2014) in club history.

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz batted .377 (20/53) over 16 games between August 5-21 with 13 RBIs and six extra-base hits. He slumped over his next six games from August 22-27 by going 2-for-24 with 12 strikeouts, but did hit his first Double-A homer. Cruz has rebounded in his last four games by going 6-for-16 with three RBIs. The 6-foot-6 shortstop was limited to 35 games for A-Adv. Bradenton due to a right foot fracture in late April but he still hammered seven homers for the Marauders. Since he was activated from the injured list on June 30 until his promotion to Double-A on July 30, Cruz led the Florida State League with six homers over a 24-game period and hit .330 (31/94) with 13 RBIs and 18 runs to earn FSL Player of the Month honors for July. Cruz is the 11th 20-year-old to play for the Curve and the first since Cole Tucker made his Double-A debut on July 20, 2017.

J.O. IS ALL-E.L.: Jared Oliva was named an End-of-Season All-Star by the Eastern League last Friday. Since June 3, Oliva has raised his batting average from .188 to .278, ranked fifth in the league, by hitting at a .322 (95/295) pace over 81 games with a .390 on-base percentage, .851 OPS, 95 hits and 52 runs scored, all league-highs over that period. Overall this season, Oliva ranks eighth in the E.L. in OPS (.755), seventh in on-base percentage (.354), lifth in hits (122), fourth in triples (6) and fourth in runs (70). In the stolen base department, his 35 steals are second in the E.L. Over Oliva's last four games, he has gone 0-for-his-last-14 for his longest hitless streak of the season season. From a defensive standpoint, Oliva's 112 games in the outfield and 290 total chances are each the most by any outfielder without an error in Minor League Baseball.

KING OF THE HILL: Logan Hill has hit safely in 15 of 21 since August 10 and has five three-hit games over that period while batting .321 (26/81) with five homers, five doubles and 21 RBIs. He was named Eastern League Player of the Week for August 12-18 by leading the leauge with three homers, nine RBIs, a .958 slugging percentage and 1.438 OPS while hitting .458 (11/24) over six games. Overall this season, Hill is ranked tied for second in the Eastern League with 69 RBIs while also tied for fourth with 42 extra-base hits and seventh with 27 doubles.

BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris is ranked ninth in the Eastern League with a career-high 26 doubles and seventh with 117 hits, which also ranks fourth among Pirates minor leaguers. In 28 games since July 31, Madris is batting .270 (24/89) with six doubles. Over his last 53 games since July 2, Madris is hitting .273 (48/176) with 16 extra-base hits and 25 RBIs. All eight of his home runs have occurred on the road while five of them have been go-ahead or game-tying blasts in Curve wins.

POPE'S POKES: Brett Pope has gotten stronger at the plate as the season has progressed. Over his last 68 games since May 25, he has raised his batting average from .169 to .258 by batting .297 (57/192) with 12 doubles, one triple, two homers and 17 walks for a .364 on-base percentage. After Pope batted .291 through the month of June, he hit a season-best .316 (24/76) with two homers in August and is batting .317 (32/101) over his last 34 games since July 22.

LOOKIN' SHARPE: Since his promotion to Double-A on June 21, **Chris Sharpe** has been one of Altoona's top power hitters. The outfielder's 11 homers are the fourth-most in the league since his debut while he ranks second with 44 runs scored, third with 38 RBIs and sixth with 25 extra-base hits.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features two of Baseball America's Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects with infielder Oneil Cruz (No. 3) and right-handed pitcher Cody Bolton (No. 5). After the latest MLB.com Mid-Season update, three Top 30 Pirates prospects are in Altoona with Cruz (No. 3), Jared Oliva (No. 11) and Bolton (No. 13). At the start of the season, Oliva was rated by Baseball America as the Pirates' No. 19 prospect and "Best Defensive Outfielder". Across all of baseball, Cruz is ranked by Baseball America as their No. 79 overall prospect while MLB.com ranks him at No. 62.
