THE LAST TIME OUT: Erie's Spencer Torkelson swatted a go-ahead two-run home run in the bottom of the eighth inning to snag a 4-2 win for the SeaWolves over the Curve on Friday night at UPMC Park. The series stands even at two games apiece as Erie and Altoona played a game decided by two runs or less for ninth time in ten matchups this season. Altoona struck first with three hits and a run in the top of the first inning. After Oneil Cruz singled and Canaan Smith-Njigba bunted his way aboard, Erie's starter Jesus Rodriguez came back to get two outs; but Brendt Citta grounded a base hit through the left side of the infield to take a 1-0 Curve lead. Erie drew even on a sacrifice fly from Ryan Kreidler in the third inning, but Curve starter Trey McGough kept firing strikes and using a low-90's fastball, solid slider and curveball to keep the SeaWolves off-balance. After Altoona took a 2-1 lead on a solo home run from Jonah Davis in the fifth, Erie drew even with a sacrifice fly from Dillon Dingler in the sixth inning. McGough was lifted after allowing the sac fly, finishing his longest start of the campaign, 5.2 innings. He struck out five and allowed two runs on six hits and no walks. He threw just 76 pitches, 57 strikes in his outing

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve look to take the upperhand in the series, 9 of the 10 games between Erie and Altoona have been decided by two runs or less.

SWING IT BABY: Friday's game between Erie and Altoona saw neither team draw a walk. It marked the fourth time this season that Altoona went an entire game without drawing a walk (5/18 @ HBG, 5/26 vs. Erie, 6/11 vs AKR), but the first time that both teams in the game didn't draw a free pass.

HOMER HAPPY: Rodolfo Castro and Mason Martin hit back-to-back home runs in the first inning on Thursday night at Erie, marking the third time this season that the Curve have hit back-to-back home runs in a game. Častro's three-run shot gave the Curve the lead just three batters into the top of the first inning and Martin made it 4-0 with a blast to right. Altoona hit a season-high four home runs in the victory with Cal Mitchell blasting an opposite field shot off the Erie Insurance Arena to leadoff the third inning and Martin added his second homer of the night, a go-ahead two-run shot to left-center, to lead the Curve to an 8-7 win.

LET'S CRUZ: Infielder **Oneil Cruz** is in the midst of a team-best 20-game on-base streak, batting 28-for-79 (.354) with four doubles, two triples, six homers, 17 RBI, .400 on-base percentage, .684 slugging percentage and 1.084 OPS. Cruz enters today ranked in several of the top-10 categories in the league: T-6th in HR (8), T-7th in RBI (26), 6th in SLG % (.560), 7th in OPS (.913), T-4th in H (42), T-2nd in 3B (3), T-7th in XBH (17), T-4th in R (28), T-4th in SB (8).

EVERYBODY HITS, WOOHOO!: The Curve offense saw every starter record a hit in Wednesday's 4-2 win at Erie, the first time this season that every Altoona batter had a hit in the game. 13 hits in all was the second-highest total in a game this season, behind the 18 hits on 6/5 at Richmond.

THAT'S RODOLFOLOUS: Over a six-game stretch leading into Saturday's doubleheader, Rodolfo Castro batted .555 (15-for-27) with 3 2B, 4 HR, and 13 RBI. In the series against Akron he hit .364 with a double, two homers, seven RBI and 1.030 OPS in Altoona's six-game series against Akron. Castro is 3rd in the league in hits (44), T-3rd in RBI (32), and T-6th in HR (8).

THE SEAWOLVES: Erie enters the series as one of the top teams in the Southwest Division. Their Manager, Arnie Beyeler, is one of 12 managers in MiLB history to accumulate more than 1,000 wins in his career; passing that mark on May 12 in a 4-0 win over Akron. Headlining the roster is OF Riley Greene, Greene was selected #5 overall in 2019 and ranks as the #2 prospect in the Tigers system according to MLB.com. INF Ryan Kreidler ranks #22 in the system. The rest of the roster features several Double-A veterans including Cale Coshow (Trenton), Ricardo Pinto (Reading), Joe Navilhon (Erie), and Drew Ward (Harrisburg).

FOR ALTOONA: RHP Osvaldo Bido makes his seventh start for the Curve on the season on Saturday night, last time out he went 5.0 innings and allowed 2 runs in game 2 of the doubleheader against Akron...*For more on Bido, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: RHP Chance Kirby makes his Double-A debut tonight for Erie. Kirby made seven starts and recorded a 3.48 ERA for High-A West Michigan before the call-up. A 25th round pick out of UT-San Antonio in 2018, Kirby hails from Austin, TX.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features eight of the top-30 prospects in the Pirates organization according to Baseball America. INF Oneil Cruz (No. 2 Pirates, No. 50 overall), INF Ji-Hwan Bae (No. 9), INF Mason Martin (No. 16), OF Cal Mitchell (No. 19), Rodolfo Castro (No. 22), and RHP Travis MacGregor (No. 28) are all ranked by BA.

Miguel Perez was named the 12th manager in franchise history after Dave Turgeon was tabbed to lead the team for the 2020 season.

Perez is the first former Curve to serve as the team's Manager and enters his 14th season as a member of the Pirates organization in 2021. Perez served as the Curve's Third Base Coach in 2015 under Manager Tom Prince and played 92 games for the Curve combined between the 2008, 2009, 2012, and 2013 seasons,batting .271 with four home runs and 36 RBI. Perez made two appearances for the Cincinnati Reds as a 21-year-old in September of 2005, going 0-for-3 with a strikeout. Perez also spent time with Akron Aeros (44 games in 2010, batted .280), and the Harrisburg Senators (3 games in 2011, went 0-for-9)

Drew Benes Pitching Coach

1st season 5th overall

Drew Benes was slated to be the Pitching Coach for a second consecutive season with the Bradenton Mauraders in 2020 before the COVID-19 pandemic.

Born in Evansville, IN, Drew is the son of former major league pitcher Andy Benes and the nephew of former big leaguer Alan Benes and minor leaguer Adam Benes. Originally selected as a third baseman by the Cincinnati Reds in the 47th round of the 2007 by the University Rens in the 47th round of the 2007 draft, but did not sign, Benes converted to the mound when at Arkansas State University. Benes was selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 35th round of the 2010 draft and spent three seasons in their system accumulating a 9-11 record with a 4.57 ERA in 66 appearances.

David Newhan Hitting Coach

Newhan comes to the Curve for his first year in the Pirates organization and 10th season as a coach in Priates organization and four season as a coach in professional baseball. His first managing experience came in the Athletics organization in 2014, In 2015-16, he was on the Detroit Tipners' major league coaching staff as the Assistant Hitting Coach. Newhan played parts of eight seasons in the big leagues and 14 seasons overall as an infielder and outfielder with the Padres (1999-2000), Phillies (2000-01), Orioles (2004-06), Mets (2007) and Astros (2008).

Gary Green Bench Coach

Gary Green is in his first season with the Curve and 16th season as a minor league instructor for the Pirates. He has served as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Infield Instructor for the Pirates since the 2011 season and joins an affiliate coaching staff for the first time since 2010.

Green was selected 27th overall by the San Diego Padres in the 1984 amateur draft and earned a silver medal for Team USA in the '84 Olympics in Los Angeles. He batted .222 with nine doubles and 11 RBI in 106 major league games across four seasons with the Padres, Rangers and Reds.
