THE LAST TIME OUT: Canaan Smith-Njiqba knocked his seventh double of the season as part of a four-hit day, but the effort was not enough to overcome Erie's offense as Altoona dropped the series finale, 6-4, on Sunday afternoon at UPMC Park in Erie. It was the first four-hit game of the season for Smith-Njigba and seventh for a Curve batter this season. He also scored Team two runs in the loss. Rodolfo Castro hit his team high ninth home run of the campaign, a two-run blast off Erie starter A.J. Ladwig (Win, 2-2) in the first inning to score Smith-Njigba and give the Curve a 2-0 early lead.

TODAY'S GAME: Altoona begins the second of three series this season against the Senators. Altoona took four of six in the first series at FNB Field in late-May.

SWING IT BABY: Friday's game between Erie and Altoona saw neither team draw a walk. It marked the fourth time this season that Altoona went an entire game without drawing a walk (5/18 @ HBG, 5/26 vs. Erie, 6/11 vs AKR), but the first time that both teams in the game didn't draw a free pass.

JUNE RUNS: Altoona has broken out the bats in the month of June and stand second in the league with 98 runs scored entering play on Tuesday. The Curve have hit 24 home runs this month, third-most in the cicuit, and have homered in four straight games.

HOMER HAPPY: Rodolfo Castro and Mason Martin hit back-to-back home runs in the first inning on Thursday night at Erie, marking the third time this season that the Curve have hit back-to-back home runs in a game. Castro's three-run shot gave the Curve the lead just three batters into the top of the first inning and Martin made it 4-0 with a blast to right. Altoona hit a season-high four home runs in the victory with Cal Mitchell blasting an opposite field shot off the Erie Insurance Arena to leadoff the third inning and Martin added his second homer of the night, a go-ahead two-run shot to left-center, to lead the Curve to an 8-7 win.

LET'S CRUZ: Infielder Oneil Cruz had a team-best 21-game on-base streak come to an end on Sunday. In the stretch he batted 31-for-84 (.369) with six doubles, two triples, six homers, 17 RBI, .411 on-base percentage, .702 slugging percentage and 1.113 OPS.

THAT'S RODOLFOLOUS: Rodolfo Castro has hit safely in six straight games, batting .423 (11-for-26). Over his last 15 games he's hitting .426 (26-for-61) with 3 2B, 7 HR, 23 RBI. Ćastro is 3rd in the league in hits (49) and RBI (35), and T-7th in HR (8).

THE SENATORS: Harrisburg enters the series after dropping 4-of-6 in their series at Reading last week and enter this week in last place in the Southwest Division. First-year Manager Tripp Kiester, a native of Hockessin, Delaware, is in his fifth season as a coach in the Nationals minor league system and his first as the Manager for Harrisburg. As a player, Kiester was drafted in the 33rd round by the NY Mets in 1992 and reached Double-A Binghamton in his fourth season.

Senators roster features several of the organization's top-30 prospects per Baseball America. RHP Cade Cavalli (#1) and LHP Matt Cronin (#11) recently joined Harrisburg after a dominant stretch to start the season at High-A Wilmington. LHP Tim Cate (#8) is joined by RHP Sterling Sharp (#26) as the only other pitchers in the top-30. The position player group has been decimiated by the injury of Jackson Cluff and the recent demotion of Drew Mendoza.

FOR ALTOONA: RHP Roansy Contreras makes his eighth start for the Curve on the season on Tuesday. Contreras struck out 10 for the third time this season in his start last Tuesday at Erie, matching the franchise record for most games with 10+ strikeouts in a season... For more on Contreras, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: RHP Andrew Lee makes his third start of the season for Harrisburg. Lee was selected in the 11th Round in 2015 out of the University of Tennessee and has split his career appearances just about evenly between starting and relieving. Lee reached Double-A for the first tie in 2019 and 0-1, with a 2.56 ERA in 11 appearances, 4 starts. He was named a 2019 Čarolina League Mid-season All-Star and played for Surprise in the Arizona Fall League in the fall of 2019.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features eight of the top-30 prospects in the Pirates organization according to Baseball America. INF Oneil Cruz (No. 2 Pirates, No. 50 overall), INF Ji-Hwan Bae (No. 9), INF Mason Martin (No. 16), OF Cal Mitchell (No. 19), Rodolfo Castro (No. 22), and RHP Travis MacGregor (No. 28) are all ranked by BA.

CURRENT NOTES

2021: Began the season as the 9th-youngest player in the AA Northeast League at 21 years and 179 days, Erie's Riley Green (20 years, 219 days) was the youngest player on an Opening Day roster...Started on Opening Day and made his organizational debut with a career-high 11 strikeouts over five scoreless innings against Bowie on May 4... Matched his career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 no-hit innings on 5/11 at Binghamton, combined with Jeff Passantino on a 1-hit shutout, only baserunners were back-to-back walks in the 6th inning against Thomas McIlraith and Desmond Lindsay, retired the first 17 batters he faced prior to the walks... Delivered the longest start by a Curve starter on 5/18 at Harrisburg going 6.2 scoreless innings, faced minimum in 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th innings, threw 89 pitches, 55 strikes... Named the Double-A Northeast League Pitcher of the week for the week ending May 23 after his scoreless start at Harrisburg on 5/18... Was charged with his first loss of the season on 5/25 vs. Erie, allowed his first runs of the season in the 2nd inning, ending a 18.2 consecutive scoreless inning streak to start his Curve career; walked 3 men in the 3rd inning of his start, had walked just 3 batters in his first three starts of the season combined... Struck out eight over six scoreless innings on 6/13 at Richmond... Left two runners on with a 3-1 lead in the 6th inning on 6/8 vs Akron, both runs came into score off LHP Oddy Nunez, recorded all 5 strikeouts in the first 3 innings of his start... Became the first Curve pitcher to go 7.0 innings on 6/15 at Erie, struck out 10 batters for the 3rd time this season, matching Ian Snell (2004) for the most 10-strikeout games in a single-season by a pitcher in franchise history... AA Northeast League Rankings/MiLB Ranks: 1st/4th in WHIP (0.80), 2nd in ERA (2.03), 2nd in K (57), 2nd/10th in BAA (.163)...

2020: Did not pitch due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Was added to the Yankees' 40-man roster on 11/20/2020

2019: Led Yankees organization and South Atlantic League in wins while spending entire season with Charleston... Miguel Perez was named the 12th manager in franchise history after Dave Turgeon was tabbed to lead the team for the 2020 season.

Perez is the first former Curve to serve as the team's Manager and enters his 14th season as a member of the Pirates organization in 2021. Perez served as the Curve's Third Base Coach in 2015 under Manager Tom Prince and played 92 games for the Curve combined between the 2008, 2009, 2012, and 2013 seasons,batting .271 with four home runs and 36 RBI. Perez made two appearances for the Cincinnati Reds as a 21-year-old in September of 2005, going 0-for-3 with a strikeout. Perez also spent time with Akron Aeros (44 games in 2010, batted .280), and the Harrisburg Senators (3 games in 2011, went 0-for-9)

Drew Benes Pitching Coach

1st season 5th overall

Drew Benes was slated to be the Pitching Coach for a second consecutive season with the Bradenton Mauraders in 2020 before the COVID-19 pandemic.

Born in Evansville, IN, Drew is the son of former Born in Evansville, IN, Drew is the son of former major league pitcher Andy Benes and the nephew of former big leaguer Alan Benes and minor leaguer Adam Benes. Originally selected as a third baseman by the Cincinnati Reds in the 47th round of the 2007 draft, but did not sign, Benes converted to the mound when at Arkansas State University. Benes was selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 35th round of the 2010 draft and spent three seasons in their system accumulating a 9-11 record with a 4.57 ERA in 66 appearances.

David Newhan Hitting Coach

Gary Green is in his first season with the Curve and 16th season as a minor league instructor for the Pirates. He has served as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Infield Instructor for the Pirates since the 2011 season and joins an affiliate coaching staff for the first time since 2010.

Green was selected 27th overall by the San Diego Padres in the 1984 amateur draft and earned a silver medal for Team USA in the '84 Olympics in Los Angeles. He batted .222 with nine doubles and 11 RBI in 106 major league games across four seasons with the Padres, Rangers and Reds.
