**THE LAST TIME OUT:** Trailing by three runs in the bottom of the eighth, Altoona designated hitter Brendt Citta came to the plate with two runners on and drove the first pitch he saw deep to center field. The shot could have left the yard, giving the Brookies a late lead, but Senators center fielder Cole Freeman made an outstanding leaping catch against the wall to end the inning. The catch fueled a Harrisburg win, 4-2, at Peoples Natural Gas Field on Saturday night. The Brookies (27-19) tried to pull off a ninth inning comeback for the second night in a row when Cal Mitchell blasted his sixth homer of the season, a lead-off, solo shot to center field. The comeback ended when the next three batters were retired by Senators reliever Gabe Klobosits (Save, 3) to end the contest.

**TODAY'S GAME:** Altoona looks for an even split of the six-game series on Sunday afternoon. Altoona took four of six in the first series at FNB Field in late-May.

**WE ARE THE BROOKIES:** Altoona takes on an alternative identity this weekend as the Altoona Brookies, paying homage to the official state fish of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Brook Trout. Named the official fish of the Commonwealth in 1970, the Brook Trout is the only native salmonid (trout/salmon) in the streams of the Eastern US and Pennsylvania.

**JUNE RUNS:** Altoona has broken out the bats in the month of June and stand tied for fourth in the league with 112 runs scored and second in the league with a .274 team batting average entering play on Sunday.

**WALK IT OFF:** Mason Martin's walk-off two-run homer on Friday night marked the second walk-off victory of the season for the Curve. It was the 22nd time in franchise history that the Curve have hit a walk-off home run, first since Hunter Owen defeated New Hampshire with a 2-run homer on June 1, 2019.

**THAT'S RODOLFOLOUS:** Rodolfo Castro had a 9-game hit streak end on Friday, during which he batted .394 (15-for-38). Over his last 20 games he's hitting .395 (32-for-81) with 4 2B, 7 HR, 24 RBI. Castro is 2nd in the league in hits (55) and RBI (37), and T-8th in HR (9).

**THE SENATORS:** Harrisburg enters the series after dropping 4-of-6 in their series at Reading last week and enter this week in last place in the Southwest Division. First-year Manager Tripp Kiester, a native of Hockessin, Delaware, is in his fifth season as a coach in the Nationals minor league system and his first as the Manager for Harrisburg. As a player, Kiester was drafted in the 33rd round by the NY Mets in 1992 and reached Double-A Binghamton in his fourth season.

Senators roster features several of the organization's top-30 prospects per Baseball America. RHP Cade Cavalli (#1) and LHP Matt Cronin (#11) recently joined Harrisburg after a dominant stretch to start the season at High-A Wilmington. LHP Tim Cate (#8) is joined by RHP Sterling Sharp (#26) as the only other pitchers in the top-30. The position player group has been decimated by the injury of Jackson Cluff and the recent demotion of Drew Mendoza.

**FOR ALTOONA:** RHP Noe Toribio makes his eighth start of the season on Sunday afternoon. He last 4.2 innings in his start last Thursday at Erie...*For more on Toribio, see page two.*

**FOR HARRISBURG:** RHP Andrew Lee makes his second start of the series against Altoona. He earned a no-decision on Tuesday night with 5.0 innings of three-run ball. Lee was selected in the 11th Round in 2015 out of the University of Tennessee and has split his career appearances just about evenly between starting and relieving. Lee reached Double-A for the first time in 2019 and 0-1, with a 2.56 ERA in 11 appearances, 4 starts. He was named a 2019 Carolina League Mid-season All-Star and played for Surprise in the Arizona Fall League in the fall of 2019.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features eight of the top-30 prospects in the Pirates organization according to *Baseball America*. INF Oneil Cruz (No. 2 Pirates, No. 50 overall), INF Ji-Hwan Bae (No. 9), INF Mason Martin (No. 16), OF Cal Mitchell (No. 19), Rodolfo Castro (No. 22), and RHP Travis MacGregor (No. 28) are all ranked by BA.
