#### **NEWS & NOTES**

ABOUT LAST GAME: Zach Rheams and Luc Rennie led Columbia to a doubleheader split against Lakewood on Monday. Rheams blasted the decisive two-run homer and Rennie was splendid on the hill in a 2-0 game one win. The BlueClaws bounced back and defeated the Fireflies, 12-6, in the second game.

0 0 0 0: Rennie led Columbia to its fifth shut-out win of the season. The San Diego native has allowed just two earned runs in 14.2 IP as a Firefly (three appearances), good for a 1.23 ERA. After Rennie logged 6.2 IP, **Carlos** Hernandez needed one pitch to retire the final batter of the game. It was the second shutout of the road trip (5-0 win @ Hagerstown, July 11).

THE LEGEND OF THE RED RAIDER: Former Texas Tech slugger Zach Rheams has gotten off to guite the start with Columbia. The lefty tallied 3 more hits during the doubleheader on Monday. In his first 5 games (in all of which, he's reached base safely), Rheams is batting .357 (5-14) with a .526 on-base percentage, 3 runs, 4 doubles, a homer, 3 RBI, 2 BBs and he's been hit 3 times.

BT CRUISER: Blake Tiberi has had arguably the best road trip at the plate of anyone on the team. The former Louisville Cardinals infielder notched a pair of hits not once, but twice on Monday during the doubleheader. Tiberi has recorded 11 hits in five games during the trip and has raised his batting average 20 points (.245 to .265) since July 11. His current six-game hit streak is one off his season high of seven. Tiberi has had plenty of success vs. Lakewood, too, owning a .438 average against the club in nine games.

HEY, MA!: Playing in front of nearly two dozen friends and family members, catcher **Scott Manea** demolished a 417-foot home run in the nightcap on Monday night as part of a 3-hit game. The blast was Manea's 7th of the season. The one-time New Jersey resident is hitting .409 during the road trip (and not to mention .326 during the month of July) with 5 extra-base hits and 6 RBI.

DID WE MENTION HIS DEFENSE?: Manea's also been stellar behind the plate. The catcher has not allowed a passed ball during the trip. In 43 starts behind the plate this year, Manea has been charged with just four passed balls - no other catcher in the league with 40 or more starts has fewer than 4 passed balls.

[INSERT WILLIE NELSON SONG TITLE]: The Fireflies finish their road trip on Tuesday and will head back to the Soda City. Columbia visited Hagerstown, Maryland, from July 11-13 and then faced the Lakewood BlueClaws in New Jersey from July 14 through Tuesday. Columbia will log nearly 1,500 miles traveling from Columbia to the two aforementioned cities and back



# 2018 Fireflies Manager & Coaching Staff

# **MANAGER PEDRO LOPEZ**



On January 17, 2018, the **New York Mets named two-time Eastern League (AA) Manager of the Year Pedro Lopez** the next Fireflies skipper. The 2018 season marks Lopez's 11th year as a manager in the Mets minor league system and his 17th overall. Lopez has managed every full-season level of the Mets system after piloting the triple-A Las Vegas 51s in 2017.

The **2013 Eastern League Manager of the Year** has accumulated 865 wins over 16 years as a manager and has guided dozens of future big leaguers including Noah Syndergaard, Matt Harvey, Jacob deGrom and Edinson Volquez. In fact, **Lopez has guided his teams to the playoffs in six of his 10 years in the Mets system**.

The 49-year-old led the double-A Binghamton Mets (now Rumble Ponies) to one of the most prolific stretches in the club's history from

2012 to 2016. The 'B-Mets' won the 2014 Eastern League crown and Lopez was inducted into the Binghamton Baseball Shrine the following year (2015). The 2013 campaign was stellar as well. The Vega Baja, Puerto Rico, native guided the Mets to a franchise-record 86 victories and a playoff appearance. He is the winningest manager in Binghamton Mets history.

Lopez enjoyed a lengthy playing career before joining the coaching ranks. **The former catcher** and infielder was drafted in 1988 by the San Diego Padres out of Arizona Western College in the 21st round. Lopez played 13 years of Minor League Baseball in the Padres (1988-1994),

Milwaukee Brewers (1995-96) and Houston Astros (1997-2000) organizations. He tallied 690 hits and 338 RBIs in 909 professional games. Lopez not only coached in the South Atlantic League (Savannah, 2010 and 2001), but played in the league as well in 1990 as a 21-year-old for the Charleston Rainbows.

Before joining the Mets organization, Lopez spent seven seasons (2001-07) managing and coaching in the Texas Rangers organization.

Lopez and his wife, Gladys, have twins: Leslian Marie and Laney Marie. They live in Puerto Rico during the winter.

PEDRO LOPEZ'S MANAGERIAL HISTORY

## **Coaching Staff**

Jonathan Hurst (Pitching Coach), a native of Spartanburg, South Carolina, is back for his third season with the Fireflies and 13th overall in the Mets organization. Hurst spent six prior seasons (2010-2015) as the pitching coach of the Kingsport Mets, New York's advanced-rookie affiliate in the Appalachian League. The former big leaguer previously coached in the South Atlantic League in 2007 and 2008 with the former Mets affiliate, the Savannah Sand Gnats. Hurst appeared in seven games for the Mets in 1994 and made his Major League debut with the Montreal Expos in 1992. After a standout career at Spartanburg Methodist, Hurst signed with the Texas Rangers after being selected in the fourth round of the 1987 draft.

**Ender Chavez (Hitting Coach)** begins his 8th year in the Mets organization and his first in Columbia. He spent the last two seasons (2016-2017) as the hitting coach for New York's Appalachian League affiliate, the Kingsport Mets. Chavez also spent three seasons in the same role with the GCL Mets (2013-15) and two with the Dominican Summer League Mets (2011-12). The Venezuelan played professionally in the Colorado Rockies (1998-2001), Mets (2002-03, 2008) and Montreal Expos (2004-07) minor league systems. Chavez is the brother of former New York Met, Endy Chavez.
