<u>Today's Preview:</u> The LumberKings (A, Marlins) return home to open a six-game homestand with the first game of a three-game series with the Kane County Cougars (A, Diamondbacks). This will be the second time in 2019 that the teams meeting after they opened the year with a four-game set that was split between Kane County and Clinton. The LumberKings split the series two games apiece. The two teams have been playing each other since 1991 with the Cougars leading the all-time series 163-to-178

LumberKings Starter: Humberto Mejia, 22, makes his 11<sup>th</sup> appearance and eighth start of the year with the LumberKings. The Panama native earned the win in his third straight start for a seven-inning outing against the Burlington Bees in Clinton. Mejia allowed two runs on five hits while walking none and striking out nine. He comes into the start with Kane County having not allowed a walk since May 15<sup>th</sup>, over 15 innings of work. This will be his second appearance of the year against Kane County. He faced the Cougars in his season debut on April 6<sup>th</sup> and earned the win for a five-inning outing, allowing one run on two hits, while walking two and striking out two. Mejia's only run he allowed against Kane County came on a home runs from Jorge Perez. The Miami Marlins signed him as an international free agent on September 16th, 2013 out of Panama who he then pitched for in the World Baseball Classic (WBC) in 2016. Mejia's WBC memories are still his favorite of his professional baseball career.

Cougars Starter: Levi Kelly, 20, makes his sixth appearance and start of the season for the Kane County Cougars. The St. Albans, West Virginia native was given a no decision for a three inning outing, his shortest outing of the year, against the Beloit Snappers in Kane County. He allowed one run on one hit while walking three and striking out five, Kelly was not with Kane County when the LumberKings last played the Cougars. Originally expected to spend the first half of the year in extend spring training, Kelly changed minds by allowing just one run before he earned a promotion to the Cougars on May 4<sup>th</sup>. He left home at 15 to pitch for IMG Academy and was drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 8<sup>th</sup> round of the 2018 draft out of high school and signed for \$350,000. MLB.com ranks him as the Diamondbacks 27<sup>th</sup> best prospect and works with a fastball that ranges from 92-93 MPH.

Swept Aside: The Clinton LumberKings are coming off a rough road trip where they dropped all three of their meetings with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers to suffer their first road series sweep of the year. The sweep was just the second time this season they've failed to win a game in a series with the first coming in four straight loses to the River Bandits April 8 through the 11.

Big Innings Big Trouble: An unfortunate theme of the three-game sweep in Wisconsin was big innings that doomed the LumberKings in all three of their meeting with the Timber Rattlers. In the series opener on Tuesday night, a six-run second innings decided the game, the following night Clinton allowed a pair of five-run rallies in an 11-13 loss, and in the series finale LumberKings pitching surrender seven runs in the first inning to fall 5-7. The LumberKings are now 2-9 when allowing four runs or more in an inning. The seven run outburst on Thursday night was tied for the second largest rally in an inning allowed this year.

Well Deserved: Chris Vallimont was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for May 20<sup>th</sup> through May 28<sup>th</sup> for a dominant two start stretched in which he worked 13 innings and allowed just one hit. Over the run, Vallimont was 1-0 allowing just one unearned over his time out – walking three and striking out 18. He is the first LumberKing to win Weekly honors from the Midwest League since Keegan McGovern in July of 2018. Vallimont is the Clinton Pitcher of the Week since the 2016 season.

Bubba Returns: The Clinton LumberKings had their third promotion of the season with middle infielder Demetrius Sims called up to the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. He joins former LumberKings Michael Donadio and Sean Guenther as the other callups of the season. In a corresponding move the LumberKings activated Bubba Hollins from the injured list. Hollins spent 28 days on the IL and was batting .358 at the time of his injury. In his return to action on Thursday he went 1-for-4 with the longest at-bat of the night - collecting a double in the fourth inning on the 13<sup>th</sup> pitch.

This Date in Baseball History: On this date in 1948, Tommy Lasorda, best known as the Dodgers' Hall of Fame skipper, strikes out 25 batters and collects the game-winning hit when the Schenectady Blue Jays defeat the Amsterdam Rugmakers, 6-5, in 15 innings. The promising southpaw, who goes the distance in the CanAm minor-league contest played in McNearney Stadium, believes he probably threw more than 300 pitches during the game.
