Today's Preview: The LumberKings (A, Marlins) conclude their six-game homestand with the third game of a three-game set with the Cedar Rapids Kernels (A, Twins). This is the second time in 2019 that the teams have met with both teams playing just two weeks ago in Clinton. The LumberKings avoided the sweep in the series with their largest come from behind win of the season – trailing 6-0 and winning 8-7. The current series has been split through the first two meetings with LumberKings coming back from a 6-8 loss on Tuesday night to capture a 2-1 win on Wednesday night. The two teams have been playing each other since 1962 with the Kernels leading the all-time series 439-to-475.

LumberKings Starter: Humberto Mejia, 22, makes his 11th appearance and eighth start of the year with the Clinton LumberKings. The Panama native, was given a no decision for 6.1 innings against the Kane County Cougars. He allowed three runs, two earned, on nine hits and walking one while striking out four. Mejia will be one of the three Clinton All-Stars this year when the Midwest League's best talent meets in South Bend on June 18th. The Miami Marlins signed him as an international free agent on September 16th, 2013 out of Panama who he then pitched for in the World Baseball Classic (WBC) in 2016. Mejia's WBC memories are still his favorite of his professional baseball career.

Kernels Starter: Cody Funderburk, 22, makes his second appearance and start of the year for the Cedar Rapids Kernels. The Mesa, Arizona native is coming off his season debut which came on the road at Community Field against the Burlington Bees. He worked four innings and did not allow a run on just one hit while walking one and striking out four. Funderburk began his season in the Florida State League with Fort Myers Miracles making a 3.1 inning relief appearance before being assigned to Cedar Rapids on May 27th. The Minnesota Twins drafted him in the 15th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist University where he was a two-way player hitting 13 home runs his senior year.

Strikeout Totals: Tanner Andrews and Jake Walters were the only pitchers used for the Clinton LumberKings in their Wednesday night win over the Cedar Rapids Kernels. Both arms combined to strikeout out 13 Kernels to bring the strikeout total for the series to 28. Wednesday's performance was the 22nd time this year that LumberKings pitching has struck out 10 or more batters in a game.

LumberKing All-Stars: Prior to Wednesday's game the Clinton LumberKings learned of three of their players being named to the 55th annual Midwest League All-Star Game at Four Winds Field in South Bend Indiana. Jerar Encarnacion will be the only starter among those going as pitchers Chris Vallimont and Humberto Mejia will round out Clinton's all-star representation. Last season the LumberKings had one starter, Jack Larsen, but he did not play due to an injury that has landed him on the Disabled List.

On the Moves Like the Lease is Up: Connor Scott was one of just two LumberKings with a multi-hit game on Wednesday night joining teammate Bubba Hollins. Scott ended his game going 2-for-4 and was active on the base paths. He stole two bases in the contest to up his team leading total to 13 on the season.

Kicking the Ball Around: A big reason for the comeback loss for the LumberKings was poor defense. The team combined to commit five errors in the game to tie a season high for defensive miscues – the third time they have been charged with five errors in a game. The 85 errors this season by LumberKings fielders are the most in the Midwest League.

Just the One: The first inning on Wednesday night was the inning of offense for Cedar Rapids. They collected half of their four hits in the inning, scored their only run of the night, and drew their only walk. Clinton has been stingy as a pitching staff when in comes to free passes and the first inning walk was the 178th walk issued this season. The total is the second fewest in the Midwest League – behind only the Fort Wayne TinCaps who have allowed 162 walks.

This Date in Baseball History: On this date in 1944, baseball cancels today's scheduled eight-game slate due to the Allied invasion of Normandy known as D-Day. The military operation has 60,000 Allied troops, including six minor leaguers who will be killed in action, landing along a heavily protected 50-mile stretch of the coastline in France to fight Germany to begin an offensive assault against Hitler and the Nazi party.
