**Today's Preview:** The LumberKings (A, Marlins) are on the road for a five-game series with the Burlington Bees (A, Angels). This is the third meeting of the season between the two teams and will feature a doubleheader on Sunday in order to make up a postponement on May 27<sup>th</sup>. The LumberKings have won both of the series. Burlington took the first meeting of the current series with a 2-1 win. The two teams have been playing since 1962 with Burlington leading the head-to-head meetings 418 games to 432.

**LumberKings Starter:** Alberto Guerrero, 21, makes his 11<sup>th</sup> appearance and ninth start of the year with the Clinton LumberKings. The Panama native, turned in his strongest start of the season his last time. He threw seven innings against the Kane County Cougars in Clinton and was given a no decision but did not allow a run on three hits while walking four and striking out seven. The start was Guerrero's longest of the season in both innings pitched, seven, and pitches thrown, 107. This season he has dramatic splits between his day and night game assignments. At night Guerrero is 1-1 with a 3.94 ERA over 29.2 innings while during the day he is 1-0 with a 0.50 ERA over 18 innings or work. He was signed on July 3rd, 2014 as an international free agent and began his professional career a year later in 2015 with the DSL Marlins.

**Bees Starter:** Jose Soriano, 20, makes his 12<sup>th</sup> appearance and 11<sup>th</sup> start of the year for the Burlington Bees. The Dominican native earned the win his last time out for a seven-inning outing against the Quad Cities River Bandits at Community Field. He allowed one run on two hits while walking two and striking out six. The start was his longest of the season in both innings pitched, seven, and pitches thrown, 91. This will be Soriano's third appearance of the season against the LumberKings he was given the loss when he faced them last on May 15<sup>th</sup> in Burlington. He allowed three runs on three hits while walking three and striking out six. Sean Reynolds hit a fourth inning home run off Soriano that was his first road homer of the year. He then faced Clinton at NelsonCorp Field and was hung with the loss a 6.1 inning outing he allowed three runs on three hits while walking three and striking out a professional career high ten batters. The Los Angeles Angels signed Soriano as an international free agent on March 4th, 2016.

**Offensive Slump:** One hit was all that Clinton managed in their 2-1 loss to the Bees on Friday night. Over the last three games, the LumberKings have scored just three runs. Zach Scott's third inning home run brought to an end a streak of 15.1 scoreless innings – the longest scoreless stretch by Clinton this season.

**LumberKing All-Stars:** Prior to Wednesday's game the Clinton LumberKings learned of three of their players being named to the 55<sup>th</sup> annual Midwest League All-Star Game at Four Winds Field in South Bend Indiana. Jerar Encarnacion will be the only starter among those going as pitchers Chris Vallimont and Humberto Mejia will round out Clinton's all-star representation. Last season the LumberKings had one starter, Jack Larsen, but he did not play due to an injury that had landed him on the Disabled List.

**The First Time:** Zach Scott began his professional career in 2018 after being drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the 32<sup>nd</sup> round out of the University of St. Leo. He played in 54 games in the Mariners organization, 52 in Clinton, and did not hit a home run. After being cut and then signed by the Marlins in April of 2019, he hit his first home run of his professional career with an opposite field home run. Scott received the baseball and was given the silent treatment when he came back to the dugout by his teammate before they then joined him in celebration.

**Walks and Lots of Them:** Clinton allowed just five hits in their loss to the Bees on Friday night but the real issue on the pitching side of things were the walks. Three LumberKings pitchers, Chris Vallimont, Alex Vesia, and Elkin Alcalá, combined to issue 10 walks – the second most in a game this season.

**Nearly a No -Hitter:** The LumberKings only hit of the night on Friday came from Zach Scott in the third inning and gave Clinton a brief 1-0 lead. The hit would turn out to be the only of the game for Clinton – their lowest hit total in a game this season. In total, Clinton had just four base runners, two walks, a hit-batter, and Scott's home run.

**This Date in Baseball History:** On this date in 1934, the Reds become the first team to travel in an airplane when Cincinnati GM Larry MacPhail flies 19 of his players to Chicago for a series against the Cubs. In 1946, New York will be the first team to fly on a regular basis, using a chartered a Douglas DC-4 that will become known as the 'Yankee Mainliner.'

Still, he received a no decision for his time out in an eventual 2-1 LumberKings win over the Kane County Cougars.

**AGAINST THE BEES:** This will be the first start and appearance of Alberto Guerrero's professional career against the Burlington Bees and his first against an affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels.
