**Today's Preview:** The LumberKings (A, Marlins) return home for the final time in the month of July for a three-game set with the Kane County Cougars (A, Diamondbacks). Both teams enter the series in a battle for first place in the Western Division. This will be the fourth meetings between the two teams with Clinton having won six of the first 10 meetings. The LumberKings took two of three in their last meetings which was the first of the second half. The two teams have been playing each other since 1991 with the Cougars leading the all-time head-to-head meetings 167 games to 180.

**LumberKings Starter:** Tanner Andrews, 23, makes his 15<sup>th</sup> appearance and 11<sup>th</sup> start of the season for the Clinton LumberKings. The Rochester Indiana native was given a no decision his last time out for a 5.2 inning outing against the Great Lakes Loons at Dow Diamond. He allowed four runs on five hits while walking two and striking out eight. Andrews had begun his time with the LumberKings in a piggy back role with Jake Walters and then was moved into his own rotation spot for the start of the second half. Still very close with his small town back in Indiana, Andrews has and still does umpire Little League when he is back in town. The Miami Marlins selected him in the 10th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of the University of Purdue.

**Cougars Starter:** Ryan Weiss, 22, makes his 19<sup>th</sup> start and appearance of the season for the Kane County Cougars. The South Eglin, Illinois native earned the win in his third straight start his last time out, the winning streak began with a win over Clinton. He allowed no runs on five hits at home against the Bowling Green Hot Rods. Weiss walked two and striking out seven. This will be his third assignment of the season against the LumberKings, he has combined to go 1-1 with a 2.00 ERA over nine innings of work, striking out 10 and walking five. The Wright State University product was taken in the fourth round of the 2018 MLB Draft and made his professional debut on June 24th with the AZL Diamondbacks. He earned a promotion to Hillsboro on June 25th and ended his year going 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA. Weiss missed his entire first season at Wright State after herniating a disc and fracturing a vertebrae in his back while overdoing weightlifting.

**We're Going Streaking:** Connor Scott went 2-for-4 for the LumberKings on Monday night in Lansing to extend his hitting streak to 13 games. The streak passes Jerar Encarnacion's 12-game streak - that started the season - for the longest of the season by a LumberKing. Over the stretch, he has also gone 23-for-54. The stretch coincides with an 21 game-run of reaching base safely – also, the longest by a Clinton player in 2019.

**Just the West:** The LumberKings enter their series with the Kane County Cougars following a six-game road trip with the Eastern Division. The stretch against the east went back another six games and ended with Clinton going 9-3 over the 12 meetings. The LumberKings won all of their series against the East in the second half which included a three-game series sweep of Fort Wayne that occurred at NelsonCorp Field. Clinton will play of their remaining 39 games against the West.

**Just Add Another:** The first run of the game on Sunday came on a Peyton Burdick sacrifice fly to right that brought home Chris Torres for an early lead. The Burdick RBI has been a theme to most LumberKings as of late. Assigned to Clinton during the second half, he has registered 22 RBIs over his 26 games with the LumberKings. The last 10 games for Burdick have been exceptionally productive with Burdick collecting 14 RBIs!

**Double Trouble:** Connor Scott has been red hot for the LumberKings of late and during his current hitting streak he has had a noise for doubles. During the second half Scott has found his power stroke to the gaps. Over just 27 games in the second half, thus far, he has collected 14 doubles, while in 61 games in the first half he registered just nine doubles. Over his last nine games he has picked up his pace and has collected a double in seven of his last nine games – for a season total of 23 doubles to lead the team.

**Quiet the Turn Around:** A 2-for-4 night by Christopher Torres on Monday night against the Lugnuts in Lansing added to his longest hitting streak of the year. The hit stretched his hitting streak to 11-games. The stretch is the second current active hitting streak on the LumberKings and the third longest of the year. Th run of success comes on the heels of an eight-game skid in which he went 0-for-26 at the plate from June 30<sup>th</sup> through July 7<sup>th</sup>.

**This Date in Baseball History:** On this date in 1983, George Brett's ninth-inning homer putting the Royals ahead is disallowed when the umpires rule the third baseman used too much pine tar on his bat, a Marv Throneberry model. American League president Lee MacPhail will overrule the decision, and on August 18th, the game resumes with the Royals beating the Yankees, 4-3.
