Right-hander Alexander Vizcaino led the charge for a game two bounce back, fanning seven and scattering three hits in his season debut, before the Tourists rallied behind a six-run, sixth inning to hand the RiverDogs an 8-3 defeat and a sweep of a Tuesday evening doubleheader at McCormick Field. The Rockies affiliate opened the early evening twin bill with a 17-3 rout of Charleston in game one. The Tourists batted around in the sixth inning, tagging Aaron McGarity (0-1) for six runs on six hits, including a game-tying home run by designated hitter Willie MacIver to open the inning. Left fielder Daniel Montano plated the game winner on an opposite field single to right to put the Rockies affiliate in front for good.

In game one, the Tourists lineup showcased their depth, pounding out 13 hits and six home runs, including a pair of grand slams by left fielder Will Golsan and shortstop Tanner Vavra. Charleston second baseman Kyle Gray clubbed his first home run of the season, a three-run shot to center. Yankees prospect Luis Medina (0-1) was shaken up for ten runs on 10 hits in two-plus innings of work to take the loss.

DOGGIE BITES:

- **Stowers Impressing First Week on the Job:** Brand-new Yankee farmhand Josh Stowers continued his hot start to the season on Tuesday, going 3-for-5 with a pair of walks between the two games of the doubleheader. The former Mariners farmhand has now reached base in 14 of his 25 plate appearances (6 BB) with his new organization, leading the South Atlantic League with a .560 OBP while riding a five-game hitting streak. The Louisville product was acquired by the Yankees this offseason in the three-team deal that sent Sonny Gray to Cincinnati.
- **Lord of Grayreach:** Charleston second baseman Kyle Gray provided one of the few highlights in Tuesday's opener for the RiverDogs, popping a three-run home to dead center to put the Dogs on the board in the fourth. The West Virginia University product's longball marked the second of the season hit by the RiverDogs and the eighth of his professional career after tying for the team-lead with seven homers with Staten Island last year. His current 1.233 OPS is 4th in the SAL.
- **There's Always Tomorrow:** The RiverDogs had an evening to forget in Asheville on Tuesday as they were swept by the Tourists in a pair of seven-inning games, including a 17-3 rout in game one. The 14-run margin of defeat in the opener was the biggest Charleston loss since April 12, 2011 when the RiverDogs were blanked 15-0 by the Greenville Drive at Fluor Field. It was the most runs Charleston has conceded since an 18-1 drubbing by the Rome Braves on July 22, 2004 at The Joe. Asheville's potent lineup also cracked six home runs, the most allowed the RiverDogs pitching staff in their history as a Yankees affiliate (circa 2005). Asheville's one and two spot hitters Will Golsan and Tanner Vavra each blasted grand slams while enjoying 6 RBI nights. No opposing batter had driven in six against the Dogs since Asheville's Jordan Ribera on June 15, 2012, also at McCormick Field.
- **It's Still Early, but...:** RiverDogs pitching entered the series in Asheville with a league-leading 1.54 staff ERA that ballooned up to a league-worst 5.74 mark after Tuesday's doubleheader. Charleston's hurlers gave up over three times as many runs as they did in the four-game series in Columbia in 12 innings against the Tourists lineup yesterday (25:7) and almost as many hits (23:26). The RiverDogs pitching staff has tapped into New York's impressive development pipeline of young arms and has finished in the top-2 in the league in ERA each of the past three seasons, including leading the league and setting the franchises strikeout record in back-to-back season from 2016-17.
- **Pinstriped Prospects:** The RiverDogs will again tap into a deep farm system in the New York Yankees. Losing some of their organizational talent due to promotions and trades in the last year, the Yankees' farm system fell from the second-best system in the game to 20th on the *Baseball America* rankings. Despite this, the Bronx Bombers are stocked with intriguing talent at the lower levels of the farm system, including seven of the Yanks' pre-season Top-30 prospects set to open the season with the RiverDogs (MLB.com/BA): RHP Roansy Contreras (10/7), RHP Luis Medina (14/11), RHP Luis Gil (13/25), C Josh Breau (15/30), RHP Matt Sauer (17/10), OF Josh Stowers (25/--), and RHP Tanner Myatt (29/--).
- **Fresh Meat:** Eight members of last year's 64-72 squad return to open the season, but only three that spent more than 10 games in a RiverDogs uniform last year: OF Frederick Cuevas (55), C Eduardo Navas (54), and RHP Dalton Higgins (24). The Yankees' 2018 Draft Class is well represented on Charleston's initial roster with nine members of the class set to begin the season with the Dogs, including second-round selection Josh Breau. 14 RiverDogs have collegiate baseball experience, ranging as far as Spokane, WA (Daniel Bies, Gonzaga) to as nearby as Florence, S.C. (Tanner Myatt, Florence-Darlington Tech). The RiverDogs roster represents 13 different U.S. states and is also highlighted by 9 international players from either the D.R. or Venezuela.
