Southpaw Dalton Lehnen was superb in his five shutout innings on Tuesday, striking out nine Tourists and giving up two hits, improving his record to 2-1. The bullpen didn't let up as Brian Trieglaff threw three no-hit innings with a pair of strikeouts before Matt Wivinis struck out the side to end the ballgame.

Center fielder Pablo Olivares led the offensive charge for the Holy City going 3-for-4 with a pair of two-baggers and an RBI. Olivares now has nine hits in his first six home games with Charleston this season.

Designated hitter Ricardo Ferreira was one of eight different RiverDogs batters to collect a knock. Ferreira recorded a triple to go along with an RBI sacrifice fly and a run scored in the nine hole.

DOGGIE BITES:

- **Hangin' All Zeroes:** Charleston pitchers recorded their second combined shutout of the season on Wednesday, striking out 14 Tourists, the second-best total this season. The Dogs also shutout West Virginia, 1-0, on April 17th.
- **Supporting Cast:** Dalton Lehnen got four runs of support in his Tuesday start. Previously, the RiverDogs had only scored 11 total runs in four games for the lefty starter. Charleston is now 2-3 in Lehnen's five starts, despite his 1.95 ERA, scoring an average of three runs per game that the lefty starts in.
- **Something Had to Give:** Charleston entered Wednesday's contest with a league-low 79 runs scored, trailing next lowest Lakewood by 11 runs. Meanwhile, despite their dominant performance Tuesday, the Asheville pitching staff had a league-worst 5.75 ERA. Asheville was able to lower its team ERA to 5.70, and Charleston raised its runs per game total to 3.19 in the victory.
- **One, Two Punch:** The RiverDogs primary top-two hitters in the lineup had a strong final week of April. Wilkerman Garcia and Oswaldo Cabrera batted a combined .325 (25-for-77) while reaching base at an over .400 clip over the last ten games of April with the Dogs offense following suit. The Venezuelan duo each had a base hit and an RBI, and Garcia scored a run of his own in the win on Wednesday.
- **Home Sweet Home:** Pablo Olivares went 3-for-4 in Wednesday's victory. The outfielder has nine hits in his first six home games with the RiverDogs this season, hitting safely in five with three multi-hit games. Olivares also hit safely in three of four games in Greensboro and has a .344 batting average entering Thursday's series finale.
- **Situational Hitting:** Charleston has struggled with runners in scoring position this season but delivered with three hits in such situations on Wednesday. Meanwhile, RiverDogs pitchers held Asheville to a 0-for-6 total in the shutout.
- **You Mess with the Bull(pen), you get the Horns:** After allowing multiple runs six times in the final eight games of April, the RiverDogs bullpen has gone 6 2/3 innings without allowing an unearned run to start May. After allowing no more than a run just once in the first 18 games of the season, the Charleston pen has started off the season on a dominant run, allowing just 16 earned runs in 87.1 innings to start the year (good for a 1.65 ERA).
- **Narrow Margins:** 14 of the RiverDogs' first 26 games this season have been decided by just one run, the most of any team in the SAL. The RiverDogs have gone 5-9 in these contests after Friday night's walk-off loss to Greenville. Nine of Charleston's last 15 games have all been decided by just one tally. Charleston's 7-2 win over Greenville on Saturday was just the RiverDogs' second win of the season by a margin of more than two runs.
- **Pinstriped Prospects:** Once again, the RiverDogs tap into one of the premier farm systems in baseball with the New York Yankees. Recently rated the second-best farm system by *Baseball America* pre-season and the sixth-best by MLB.com, the Bronx Bombers boast five of MLB.com's Preseason Top-100 prospects. Charleston's current roster features four of the Yankees' Top-30 prospects (MLB.com, BA): RHP Glen Otto (#20, #19), RHP Nick Nelson (#29, --), INF Oswaldo Cabrera (--, #26) and RHP Rony Garcia (--, #29). In 2017, the Yankees led all of baseball in organizational winning percentage (.602) between the Major and minor leagues and featured seven of their eight domestic affiliates in the postseason.

 - Split season between Class A Clinton and Short Season Everett, logging a 1-2 record with a 0.65 ERA and three saves (51 SO, 12 BB, 27.2 IP) in 17 relief appearances
 - Recorded a 16.6 SO per nine innings and held opponents to a .138 average (13-for-94) while recording a scoreless outing in 16 of 17 appearances
 - Did not allow a run in ten outings with Class A Clinton over 17.0 innings after a promotion on 7/21
- Traded to the Yankees along with RHP Juan Then for RHP Nick Rumbelow
