The RiverDogs used a pair of RBI groundouts to take a first-inning lead over Augusta on their way to a series victory. Pablo Olivares and Wilkerman Garcia each singled to start the home half of the first before Oswaldo Cabrera and Dermis Garcia drove home the runners with back-to-back groundballs.

Charleston added a run in the second on a Mitchell Hansen RBI triple, already his second three-bagger in five games with the Dogs, to score right fielder Leonardo Molina. Dermis Garcia collected his second RBI with a third-inning single to plate Wilkerman Garcia for his second run of the night. Wilkerman Garcia walked, stole second, and advanced to third on a Cabrera fly out before Dermis Garcia drove him in with his knock down the left field line.

Daniel Ramos (6-2) and Braden Bristo combined for five scoreless innings in the victory. Ramos threw three innings and allowed one hit out of the pen. Bristo shut the door with a two-inning save, ending the game with a double play ball to wipe out a one-out single.

## DOGGIE BITES:

- Bullpen on Parade:** Friday marked the second time that the RiverDogs bullpen has combined for five or more shutout innings, and the first time that it has happened in a victory. Chad Martin and Anderson Severino combined for six scoreless frames in an April 16th loss to West Virginia.
- Wiki-Speed-ia:** Middle infielder Wilkerman Garcia stole a base in all three games of Charleston's series victory over Augusta. It was the first time this season that a RiverDog has stolen a base in three consecutive contests. The Holy City still does not have a player who has swiped multiple bases in the same game this season.
- Second-Half Surge:** The RiverDogs are out to a league-best 10-4 start to the second-half, tied with Asheville at the top of the Southern Division standings. The Dogs surged out of the gates with an 8-2 start, their best 10-game stretch of the season. The Dogs are second in the league in run differential since the All-Star break, outscoring their opponents 76-47 (+29) and ranking tops in run prevention and third in runs scored over that span.
- Solo: A RiverDogs Story:** Chris Hess and Dermis Garcia each hit solo home runs on Wednesday, making it 40 of Charleston's 58 big flies (69%) that have gone for one run. The Dogs have hit a three-run dinger (5) or a grand slam (1) on just six occasions this season. For Garcia, five of his six home runs have been single-tally four-baggers. All-Star Steven Sensley had 10 home runs, all solo shots, when he was promoted to Advanced-A Tampa on June 27th. Charleston enters Thursday's contest in the top half of the league in home runs but tied for the second-fewest runs (319).
- Jason Down the Block:** Catcher Jason Lopez continued to showcase flashes of middle of the order pop, belting two more home runs on Tuesday for his first career multi-home run game. The 20-year-old backstop now owns a career-best seven on the season and three in the last five games after having collected just one homer in each of his first three pro seasons. Among SAL catchers (min. 150 PA), Lopez ranks third in slugging percentage (.494) and isolated power (.210). His .835 OPS ranks third among all RiverDogs that have accrued at least 100 plate appearances, trailing only recently called up OF Steven Sensley and OF Pablo Olivares.
- Olivares Going the Farthest:** After a four-day span in which he went 9-for-19 with 3 HR and 11 RBI, RiverDogs outfielder Pablo Olivares was named the SAL Player of the Week last Monday. The 20-year-old's 11-game hitting streak came to an end after going 0-for-4 Tuesday, a stretch in which he went (.404), but went 4-for-12 against Augusta. Since the month of May, Olivares is hitting .357 (60-for-168), the best mark in the league over that span. He is currently 5 plate appearances shy of qualifying for the league leaderboards in which he would rank second in batting (.344), first in OBP (.412), and fourth in OPS (.876).
- Narrow Margins:** Following Wednesday's 2-1 defeat, the RiverDogs have played 37 one-run games this season, the most in the South Atlantic League and contests in which they have gone 17-20. The Holy City has fared better at home, going 10-10 in games decided by one-run at The Joe versus a 7-10 mark on the road. 49 of the Holy City's first 82 games have been decided by two runs or fewer, also the most in the league.
- Pinstriped Prospects:** Once again, the RiverDogs tap into one of the premier farm systems in baseball with the New York Yankees. Recently rated the second-best farm system by *Baseball America* pre-season and the sixth-best by MLB.com, the Bronx Bombers boast five of MLB.com's Preseason Top-100 prospects. Charleston's current roster features five of the Yankees' Top-30 prospects (MLB.com, BA): RHP Deivi Garcia (#16, #24), INF Dermis Garcia (#22, #20), INF Oswaldo Cabrera (--, #26), RHP Alexander Vargas (--, #28), and RHP Rony Garcia (--, #29). In 2017, the Yankees led all of baseball in organizational winning percentage (.602) between the Major and minor leagues and featured seven of their eight domestic affiliates in the postseason.

### Career Notes...

- Made his pro debut in 2017, splitting time between the GCL Yankees East and West squads
  - Made 11 appearances, all in relief, going 1-2 with a 0.71 ERA (10 SO, 6 BB, 12.2 IP)
  - Produced a 1.80 WHIP, allowing 16 total hits
- Prior to his pro career, spent three seasons at Seattle University (2015-17), going 12-11 with a 4.92 ERA in 57 career games (23 starts)
  - As a junior, went 6-7 with a career-high 5.92 ERA while appearing in 21 games, 12 starts
    - Struck out career-low 7.2 per nine while his walk rate spiked to 3.55 per nine
    - Tossed 8 2/3 scoreless frames to finish the year
- Is the fourth Seattle Redhawk drafted by the Yankees and the first since 1972
  - Seattle U has not produced a player in the Major Leagues
- Works out at Driveline Baseball in Seattle in the offseason with Major Leaguers Trevor Bauer and Adam Ottavino
