After seeing an early 6-0 lead slip away, left fielder Canaan Smith thumped his ninth home run of the season to put the RiverDogs back in front in an eventual 9-8 victory over the Crawdads on Friday night at L.P. Frans Stadium. Smith raised his league-leading batting average to .319 with a three-hit night, including contributing to a six-run second with an infield hit that drove in a run. Some sloppy play from the Crawdads provided the Holy City an insurance marker that proved the difference; in the ninth, Eric Wagaman singled and advanced on a misplay by left fielder, a wild pitch from Kelvin Gonzalez (L, 5-2), and a balk that made it 9-7 Dogs. Charleston roared out of the gates, smashing seven hits to chase Crawdads starter Ronny Henriquez in the second. Following eight hits over the first two innings, the offensive well dried up as Charleston managed just one hit between the third through seventh innings. Yoendrys Gomez ran into trouble in the fourth when Hickory roped three extra-base hits, capped by Tyreque Reed's 12<sup>th</sup> homer, before finishing five innings. Josh Jung completed the comeback with solo homer to leadoff the seventh.

### DOGGIE BITES

- Comeback Kids:** Friday night's eighth-inning, go-ahead shot from Canaan Smith provided the RiverDogs just their fifth win of the season when trailing after 7 innings this year and their second in the last week after surging past Delmarva in extras on Sunday. The RiverDogs are now 5-39 when trailing after seven this year. Now three of Smith's nine home runs on the season have come in the eighth inning or later, two of them for go-ahead shots. His other two came on June 5 at Greensboro to break a 1-1 tie in the ninth and on May 12 at Hickory in a blowout in the eighth to complete the cycle.
- Land of Canaan:** After leading the South Atlantic League in hitting over the month of July, OF Canaan Smith got back to his torrid pace, going 3-for-4 with a homer on Friday to shake a 1-for-16 slump. The All-Star starter in left field still enters play Saturday leading all qualifying SAL hitters in batting (.319) and on-base percentage (.421) and ranks T-1<sup>st</sup> in OPS (.898). Since July 1, the Texas native has hit .368 (45-for-118) over his last 35 games, a mark that leads the SAL. His .503 OBP is fourth in all of MiLB in that span.
- He's the WagAMAN:** Charleston first baseman Eric Wagaman crushed his fourth home run of the season on Thursday in Hickory, a laser over the left field wall for a fourth-inning, two-run shot. The Orange County, California product drove in all three RiverDogs runs in a series opening win, his second 3 RBI game of the season. The right-handed bat with tremendous power potential has now slugged a pair of homers since July 4 following a near two-month stint on the IL. Wagaman has slugged exactly five home runs each of his first two professional seasons, in 59 games with Pulaski in 2017 and 64 games with Staten Island in 2018.
- He Dunn It Again:** Despite batting just .230 since a call up from Pulaski, Charleston infielder Oliver Dunn has reached base at a consistent clip in his time with the RiverDogs. With a base on balls in three straight and four of his last five, his 15 walks in 24 games with the Dogs are T-5th most in the league since his call up (July 9), fueling a .363 on-base percentage.
- Getting Back on Track:** Despite a rough beginning to the second half offensively for the RiverDogs, Charleston's lineup showcased an impressive turnaround in their last homestand. Since July 28, **the Dogs have won nine of their last 11 contests**, with a team average (.268), OBP (.289), and OPS (.754) and 61 runs scored that all lead the league in that span. Charleston hurlers have also produced a staff ERA (3.42) that is 5th in the SAL during that stretch, having allowed just 44 runs (38 ER) in their last 100.0 innings.
- Slow Going:** Over the first 46 games since the All-Star break, Charleston's offense overall has struggled, ranking 11th in the SAL in hitting (.235), 13th in runs scored (190) and team OPS (.643), and last in slugging percentage (.317) and homers (14). Going back even further to May 26, the Charleston lineup has produced the league's 2<sup>nd</sup>-worst team OPS (.646) over the last 68 games, having scored just 273 runs, an average of 4.0 per game and ranking 11th in the league in that stretch.
- One Base at a Time:** The RiverDogs' maligned offense since early June has particularly been lacking in power production that was a staple of the club early in the season. Charleston's 30 home runs over their last 67 games (dating back to May 26) are the fewest in the league after the RiverDogs lineup produced 41 homers, the fourth-most in the league, over their first 50 games. They have hit just 14 since the break, 39 fewer than the top home run team in that span (Hickory).
- Pinstriped Prospects:** The RiverDogs once again tap into a deep farm system in the New York Yankees in their 14<sup>th</sup> season of affiliation with the 27-time World Champs. Losing some of their organizational talent due to promotions and trades last year, the Yankees' system fell from the 2nd-best in the game to 20<sup>th</sup> on the BA rankings heading into 2019. Despite this, the Bronx Bombers are stocked with intriguing talent at the lower levels, including five of the Yankees' mid-season Top-30 prospects according to the MLB Pipeline: RHP Yoendrys Gomez (#8), RHP Roansy Contreras (#13), RHP Luis Medina (#21), OF Canaan Smith (#26), and SS Oswald Peraza (#30).

### Career Notes...

- Is in his second year as a pro after making 9 appearances (1 start) with the GCL Yankees East in 2018, going 0-1, 2.79 ERA (7 SO, 2 BB, 9.2 IP) while garnering two saves
- As a junior in 2018, put together one of the best seasons in Stevens' program history, going 8-2, 2.58 ERA and setting the school record with 97 strikeouts as the Empire 8 Conference's Pitcher of the Year
  - Struck out 15 against SUNY-Canton on March 30 and was named the Division III National Pitcher of the Week
- When he was selected in the 33<sup>rd</sup> round in 2018, became the first Stevens player drafted in 45 years, just the second in the Ducks' program history since Dave Garcia (3<sup>rd</sup>, 1973, MIN)
- Studied Quantitative Finance at Stevens Institute of Technology
- Grew up as a Mets fan
