### LAST GAME

The Senators turned a 5-1 deficit into an 8-5 win over the Portland Sea Dogs with a strong offense and solid bullpen work. Portland took a 5-1 lead into the bottom of the third when the Sens scored twice to cut into the Dogs lead. The Sens pushed five runs across the plate in the sixth thanks to four consecutive run scoring hits. The Sens bullpen retired 12 of the 14 batters they faced as the Sens evened the series with the win.

### CAPITAL BEAT

- The Senators and Portland Sea Dogs play game three of a four-game series tonight at FNB Field. It's the only meeting of the season between the teams at FNB Field. They play again next weekend at Hadlock Field in Portland.
- Tonight's Senators starting pitcher is **Bryan Bonnell**. Bonnell is 25-years-old and is making his fourth career start and his first since 2017 with Modesto. His longest outing with the Sens this season has been 2 innings and he hasn't thrown more than 29 pitches in a game this year. He's 1-1 with a 0.87 ERA in 14 outings with Harrisburg. At FNB Field he's 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA. He's had 13 consecutive scoreless outings with the Sens.

### PORTRLAND

- The Sea Dogs are the AA affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. They're 40-56 overall this season. In July they're 10-8, hitting .236 with 12 HR and 84 Runs with a 3.20 ERA.
- Portland has eight MLB.com Top 30 prospects on their active roster. They've used 54 players this season. The Sea Dogs have 19 players originally signed or drafted by the Red Sox and 9 AA rookies.
