## LAST GAME

The Senators were shut out 1-0 by the Hartford Yard Goats Wednesday afternoon at FNB Field. Hartford scored the only run in the game in the eighth inning on a double by Tyler Nevin. Harrisburg had only two runners reach second in the game and no runner to third. Jackson Tetreault started and pitched 5.1 scoreless innings followed by Andrew Lee. Luis Garcia had two hits in the game. Harrisburg had three base runners thrown out on the bases.

## CAPITAL BEAT

- The Senators and Hartford Yard Goats play game three of their three-game series. The Sens have taken 8 of the 11 games played between the teams. The two teams play again later this season in Hartford in a five-game series.
- Harrisburg is 8-2 in their past 10 games. Overall this season they're 60-48 which would put them 1.5 games behind Erie and in second place in the Western Division.
- July is the second winning month the Senators have had this season. The Sens are 13-7 since the all-star break.

## ABOUT THE HARTFORD YARD GOATS

- The Goats are the Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. They play their home games at Dunkin' Donuts Park in Hartford, CT. The franchise was born in New Britain, CT in 1983. They've been an affiliate of the Rockies since 2015. They won two E.L. Championships while in New Britain.
- They're 16-23 and 7 games behind Reading in the second half and 53-53 overall this season. In July they were 11-16, hit .253, 12 HR, 102 Runs and a 4.66 ERA.
