LHP DAMON JONES (0-1, 0.96) vs. LHP Bryan Sammons (3-0, 0.42)



TODAY'S GAME: Game one of a three-game series against the Fort Myers Miracle (MIN) from CenturyLink Sports Complex...Second of four series between the two clubs in 2019, and first in Fort Myers...First of six road games against the Minnesota Twins affiliate...Clearwater dropped all three games against the Miracle from April 12-14 at Spectrum Field.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 24-year-old Damon Jones makes his fifth start of the season in game one of the three-game series against the Fort Myers Miracle on Tuesday night...The 6-foot-5 hurler did not factor into the decision of a 13-1 victory over the Florida Fire Frogs on April 24...The southpaw allowed a run on three hits, three walks and six strikeouts across 4.2 innings before being lifted after 91 pitches (57 strikes)...Tuesday will be Jones' first career start against the Minnesota Twins affiliate.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Clearwater Threshers gave Julian Garcia a 3-0 lead through five innings, but the bullpen yielded six runs in the sixth and one more in the seventh in the 7-6 loss to the Tampa Tarpons on Sunday afternoon at George M. Steinbrenner Field...The Threshers rallied with a three-run ninth, but came up just shy by stranding the tying run on base at the end of the contest.

GO-GO GOMEZ: Jose Gomez finished a perfect 3-for-3 in the finale against the Tarpons on Sunday, extending the infielder's hitting streak to nine games...The 22-year-old is batting .484 by going 15-for-31 at the dish over that span...Since the streak began, the native of Venezuela has seen his season average rocket up from .067 to .348...Gomez is also in the midst of a 10-game on-base streak, hitting .455 (15-for-33) since April 11.

MAD DOG'S BITE: Madison Stokes stretched his on-base streak to 10 games with a 2-for-4 day at the plate against the Tarpons on Sunday...The product of South Carolina has collected 12 hits since April 16, helping to piece together a .300 average during that span...The 23-year-old has been held hitless just once since the streak began in an 0-for-3 night on April 20 against Tampa, but drew a walk to keep the streak alive at five.

GARCIA'S GRACE: Julian Garcia tossed five scoreless frames on Sunday, and left the game with a 3-0 lead in the no-decision...The right-hander has gone at least five innings in each of his last three starts, and has tallied six or more strikeouts in all four starts in 2019...The native of Broomfield, Colo. has allowed just two runs over his last 16 innings after allowing three in just 3.2 stanzas against the Lakeland Flying Tigers in his season debut on April 9.

KINGS OF THE K: Julian Garcia (6) and Zach Warren (3) combined for nine strikeouts on the mound for Clearwater on Sunday...The Threshers' pitching staff has collected 262 punch outs through the first 24 games of the season, 33 more than the Tampa Tarpons for the top spot in the Florida State League.

ROSTER MOVES: The Philadelphia Phillies announced the following roster moves prior to Tuesday's game against the Fort Myers Miracle: INF Alec Bohm has been transferred from Lakewood to Clearwater...LHP Damon Jones has been added from Extended Spring Training, along with RHPs Seth McGarry and Grant Dyer...To make room for the four players, INF Jose Gomez has been transferred to Double-A Reading, and RHPs Gustavo Armas, Julian Garcia and Luis Carrasco have been assigned to Extended Spring Training...Bohm appeared in just 22 games for Lakewood, piecing together a .367 average with an OPS of 1.036, including nine doubles, three home runs and 11 RBI.

PHILLIES PHARM PROSPECTS: The Opening Day roster for the Clearwater Threshers features six top-30 prospects (MLB.com) in the Philadelphia Phillies organization: RHP Spencer Howard (5), OF Simon Muzziotti (12), LHP Kyle Young (17), INF Nick Maton (18), C Rodolfo Duran (19), INF Daniel Brito (20)...Muzziotti will be the youngest player on the team at just 20-years-old...RHP Austin Ross is the oldest player on the roster at 24-years-old...Three countries are represented on the Threshers roster: United States, Venezuela and the Dominican Republic...12 different states are represented on the Opening Day roster, with five players residing in California, two each in Illinois and Texas, and one each in Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Missouri, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, South Carolina and Tennessee.

MEET THE NEW SKIPPER.... The Clearwater Threshers have a new manager for the 2019 season, Marty Malloy...The Trenton, Fla. native spent two years in the same role for Lakewood (A, 2017-18)...Spent the previous four years (2013-16) with the Houston Astros, including three years as the manager for their Gulf Coast League (R) team, one year as the GCL hitting coach and one year as the Florida Instructional League coordinator...Also coached at the amateur level as head coach (two years) and volunteer assistant (six years) for Trenton High School and six years as an infield instructor at Gatorball Baseball Academy in Gainesville, FL...Played 12 years (1992-2003), including his first eight in the Atlanta Braves minor league system.

...AND HIS MATES: Joining Malloy from Lakewood is pitching coach Brad Bergesen...The Auburn, Ala. native pitched in the major leagues for four years for the Baltimore Orioles (2009-11) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2012), going 19-25 with four complete games and a 4.61 ERA in 102 games (59 starts).

Chris Heintz takes over as the hitting coach in 2019...The Tampa, Fla. native was previously an assistant coach for the University of South Florida for five years (2010-14)...Prior to his time with USF, spent two years in the Minnesota Twins minor league system as manager for the Gulf Coast League (R) team and coach for single-A Beloit...Appeared in 34 major league games for the Twins over three seasons (2005-07) after being selected by the Chicago White Sox in the 19th round of the 1996 draft...In 2013, was inducted into the USF Hall of Fame.

Harold Garcia is the third coach on the staff...The Kissimmee, Fla. resident originally signed by the Phillies as an amateur free agent in 2005, he is in his first year on the organization's player development staff...Played eight of his nine minor league seasons with the Phillies. In 2010, with Clearwater (A), broke a 59-year-old record by hitting safely in 37 consecutive games.
