**TODAY'S GAME:** Game one of a three-game series against the Charlotte Stone Crabs (TB) at Charlotte Sports Park...Game nine of an 11-game, 11-day road trip against the Daytona Tortugas (CIN), Jupiter Hammerheads (MIA) and Stone Crabs (6-2)...Clearwater is coming off a four-game sweep over the Hammerheads from Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium...Second of four series (17 games) between the two clubs in 2019...The dropped a three-game set against Charlotte May 17-19 at Spectrum Field.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** 22-year-old Alejandro Requena makes his ninth start of the season in game one of the three-game series against the Charlotte Stone Crabs at Charlotte Sports Park...The 6-foot-2 hurler picked up his third win of the season in a 2-1 victory over the Daytona Tortugas on May 21 at Jackie Robinson Ballpark...The right-hander limited the Cincinnati Reds affiliate to one run on two hits, two walks and three strikeouts across six quality innings...Tuesday will be Requena's second career start against the Stone Crabs...The native of Venezuela faced off against Charlotte on Aug. 24, 2018 at Spectrum Field and earned a win with one run allowed through seven frames...Requena scattered four hits in the outing, and struck out five.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Clearwater Threshers took the finale of the four-game series against the Jupiter Hammerheads at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, 5-0...The victory gave the Threshers their second series sweep of the season...Jhailyn Ortiz pushed across the winning run with a two-run double in the three-run third, and the visitors added two more runs for safe measure in the sixth...Colton Eastman took a no-hit bid into the seventh inning, and finished the day with a career-high, 11 strikeouts.

**THE MAD TITAN:** Colton Eastman started Sunday's contest with four consecutive strikeouts, setting up a career-high 11 through seven innings...The output matched a team-high by a single pitcher, tying with Spencer Howard's outing against the April 23 against the Florida Fire Frogs...The Cal State Fullerton product also set a team-high for the longest no-hit bid with 6.2 innings, before allowing a double by Nick Fortes.

**COWBOY UP!:** Matt Kroon delivered another hit against the Hammerheads on Sunday afternoon, giving the Oklahoma State product five hits in three games to begin his Advanced-A career...The 22-year-old hit .268 in 37 games with the Lakewood BlueClaws in 2019, producing 12 RBI on six doubles, a triple and a homer.

**EXTRA! EXTRA!:** With another double on Sunday, Clearwater has collected at least one extra-base hit in all 25 games in May...Through the second month of the season, the Philadelphia Phillies affiliate has posted a .421 slugging percentage due to 47 doubles, six triples and 19 home runs.

**LEADERS OF THE PACK:** Clearwater kept its team batting average at .259 with 11 hits on Sunday - two points higher than the Palm Beach Cardinals for first in the Florida State League...The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate paces the league with in slugging (.392). The Threshers are the only team in the league with an OPS over .700 (.714).

**STRIKEOUT KINGS:** Colton Eastman (11), Zach Warren (2) and Grant Dyer (1) contributed to Clearwater's 11 strikeouts on the mound on Sunday, boosting the staff's total to 484 - 10 more than the Fort Myers Miracle for the top spot in the Florida State League...Damon Jones paces the league with 69 punch outs.

**HEY, NOW! YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR:** The Florida State League announced the rosters for the 2019 All-Star teams, and the Clearwater Threshers will send five players to Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium for the Mid-Summer Classic on June 15...LHPs Jonathan Hennigan and Damon Jones will represent the Philadelphia Phillies affiliate on the mound, while INF Nick Maton and OFs Simón Muzziotti and Matt Vierling will take the field.

**HOME COOKING:** The Clearwater Threshers played 13 of their first 18 games of May at home at Spectrum Field, with only two games outside the city of Clearwater in Fort Myers at the start of the month...The Threshers went 5-7 at Spectrum Field in April (one official "road" game against Dunedin), and are off to a 6-6 start in the second month of the season...After a seven-game homestand from May 13-19, Clearwater will not see its home stadium again until May 31 against the Dunedin Blue Jays following an 11-game road trip...Clearwater has picked up the pace at the plate at home compared to on the road in 2019 (.270 average and 106 runs through 23 games compared to .250 average and 104 runs through 27 games on the road), but have pitched better away from Spectrum Field, having allowed 87 runs on the road compared to 98.

**MONTHLY RECOGNITION:** The Philadelphia Phillies announced their Players of the Month for April on May 6, and INF Alec Bohm was named Player of the Month and INF Jose Gomez was named Defender of the Month...Bohm, 22, hit .373 (31-for-83) with nine doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and posted a 1.039 OPS in 22 games with single-A Lakewood and one game with Advanced-A Clearwater...He Omaha, Neb. native hit .429 with a .671 slugging percentage over his final 19 games of the month, with multi-hit performances in 11 of those contests...Gomez started 14 games for Clearwater before being promoted to Double-A Reading to start May...The 22-year-old started at three infield positions (Second - nine games; Third - three games; Shortstop - two games), and was a perfect 50-for-50 in total chances.

**PHILLIES PHARM PROSPECTS:** The Opening Day roster for the Clearwater Threshers features six top-30 prospects (MLB.com) in the Philadelphia Phillies organization: RHP Spencer Howard (5), OF Simon Muzziotti (12), LHP Kyle Young (17), INF Nick Maton (18), C Rodolfo Duran (19), INF Daniel Brito (20)...Muzziotti will be the youngest player on the team at just 20-years-old...RHP Austin Ross is the oldest player on the roster at 24-years-old...Three countries are represented on the Threshers roster: United States, Venezuela and the Dominican Republic...12 different states are represented on the Opening Day roster, with five players residing in California, two each in Illinois and Texas, and one each in Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Missouri, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, South Carolina and Tennessee...The Threshers have added two more top-30 prospects since the start of the season, with Alec Bohm (1) and Jhailyn Ortiz (11) joining the club.
