TODAY'S GAME: Game one of a four-game series against the Palm Beach Cardinals (STL) from Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium...Clearwater is coming off a three-game series victory over the Dunedin Blue Jays (TOR) at Spectrum Field, in which the Threshers dropped the series opener, 6-2, but took the next two contests, 5-1 and 3-1...Second, and final series between the two clubs in 2019...The squads split a four-game set at Spectrum Field from July 8-11.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 22-year-old James McArthur makes his fourth start with the Clearwater Threshers in the series opener against the Palm Beach Cardinals on Thursday night at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium...The 6-foot-7 hurler suffered his seventh loss of the season on Aug. 2 against the Tampa Tarpons (NYY)...The right-hander allowed only one run on four hit, two walks and three strikeouts across five frames on 84 pitches - 56 strikes...Thursday will be the Mississippi product's first career start against the St. Louis Cardinals affiliate.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Clearwater Threshers took the rubber match of the three-game series, 3-1, over the Dunedin Blue Jays at Spectrum Field on Wednesday afternoon...All of the offense came in the first two innings against 18-year-old Simeon Woods Richardson...Madison Stokes pushed across Simón Muzzietti with a two-out single in the first, and Nick Matera blasted a two-run shot onto the berm with two outs in the second inning...Andrew Brown picked up his third win of the season with his second quality start, allowing just one run across six frames...Michael Gomez struck out two of the three batters in the ninth to lock down his first save in his first try at the Advanced-A level.

SUPERCHARGED BATTERY: The battery of Andrew Brown and Nick Matera did it all for the Clearwater Threshers in the rubber match against the Dunedin Blue Jays on Wednesday afternoon...Brown earned his third victory of the season, and first since May 9 which also came against the Blue Jays...The Alpine, Calif. native faced the minimum through the first three innings, but allowed his only run on an RBI ground out by Reggie Pruitt in the fifth inning...The right-hander is 2-0 against Dunedin in 2019 with an ERA of just 1.50 (2er/12ip)...Not only have two of the starter's three wins come against the Toronto Blue Jays affiliate this season, but so have both of his quality starts.

Nick Matera slugged a two-run homer in the second inning to extend the Threshers' lead to 3-0...The 22-year-old has just three hits in nine games with Clearwater, but two have gone for extra bases, and both have resulted in runs scoring...The New Jersey native clubbed a two-run double against the Charlotte Stone Crabs (TB) in his only plate appearance on July 25.

SIMÓN SAYS: Simón Muzzietti finished 1-for-4 with a run scored against Dunedin on Wednesday afternoon... The left-handed batter is hitting .342 in nine games against the Toronto Blue Jays affiliate in 2019, with a .390 OBP and a .943 OPS...The native of Venezuela has hit .310 over his past 16 games dating back to July 22, helping to lift his average from .277 to .285.

GATOR CHOMP: Dalton Guthrie continued to swing a hot bat in the second half with a 2-for-4 day in the win over Dunedin...The 23-year-old is hitting .320 since the start of the second half after posting a .193 mark prior to the All-Star break...The right-handed hitter has 12 multi-hit performances in the second half, helping to raise his season average to .258...Guthrie has 17 more hits (39-22), an one more double (7-6), one more triple (2-1), two more home runs (3-1), and four more RBIs (12-8) in the second half compared to the first.

MAD DOG BITES BACK: Madison Stokes had a good week at the plate for the Clearwater Threshers, collecting at least one hit in all four games at Spectrum Field against the Tampa Tarpons and Dunedin Blue Jays... The right-handed hitter picked up five knocks in 14 at-bats, including a double and two RBI.

PILING ON THE PUNCH OUTS: Three pitchers contributed to the Threshers' strikeout total on the mound in Wednesday's matinee...Andrew Brown (3), Tyler Carr (1) and Michael Gomez (2) tacked on six punch outs to help raise the staff's total to 1,040...Clearwater remains the only team in the Florida State League with at least 1,000 Ks, and leads the Fort Myers Miracle (MIN) by 42 for the top-spot heading into the weekend.
