**TODAY'S GAME:** Finale of a four-game series against the Palm Beach Cardinals (STL) from Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (2-1)...Clearwater is coming off a three-game series victory over the Dunedin Blue Jays (TOR) at Spectrum Field, in which the Threshers dropped the series opener, 6-2, but took the next two contests, 5-1 and 3-1...Second, and final series between the two clubs in 2019...The squads split a four-game set at Spectrum Field from July 8-11.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** 21-year-old Jack Perkins makes his second start of the season at the Advanced-A level in the series finale of the four-game set against the Palm Beach Cardinals on Sunday afternoon at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium...The 6-foot-4 hurler suffered the loss in a 6-2 defeat at the hands of the Dunedin Blue Jays on Aug. 5 at Spectrum Field...The right-hander allowed four runs on five hits, needing 41 pitches - 27 strikes - to work through two innings...Sunday will be the Ocala, Fla. native's first career start against the St. Louis Cardinals affiliate.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Clearwater Threshers' offense erupted for 11 runs against the Palm Beach Cardinals on Saturday night in an 11-4 victory at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium...Nine of the visitor's runs came across in the first three innings with four in the first, two in the second and three in the third...Kyle Glogoski earned his first career quality start with six shutout innings in the winning effort...Dalton Guthrie tied a team-high with four hits in the contest...Guthrie (4-for-5) and Matt Kroon (3-for-4) combined for seven hits out of the bottom two spots of the lineup, and contributed three runs scored and four RBIs.

**PLAYING ALL THE HITS:** All but one batter had at least one hit for the Threshers on Saturday night...Five hitters (Muzziotti, Rivas, Stokes, Guthrie and Kroon) had multi-hit performances...Four Clearwater batters were hit by a pitch (Stokes [twice], Vierling and Kroon)...The visitors collected six extra-base hits with doubles from Aklinski, Stokes, Guthrie and Muzziotti, and a triple and a homer from Kroon.

**NOT-SO-SHEEPISH STARTER:** Kyle Glogoski worked six shutout innings for his second win at the Advanced-A level on Saturday...The New Zealand native scattered three hits, walked only one and struck out five on 75 pitches for his first career quality start...The 20-year-old has yet to allow more than two earned runs in any of his 16 games - 11 starts - helping to lead to a 1.58 ERA with Lakewood and Clearwater in 2019.

**COWBOY UP!:** Matt Kroon continued his impressive series against the Cardinals with three more hits on Saturday, and fell a double shy of the cycle...The Oklahoma State product drove home three more runs, and has six RBIs through two games...The 22-year-old has been on a tear in the August, hitting at a .323 clip in 10 contests with a .963 OPS.

**SIMÓN SAYS:** Simón Muzziotti extended his hitting streak to seven games with two more hits in the win on Saturday...The 20-year-old continues to hit .333 (10-for-30) since the streak began on Aug. 4...The left-handed hitter is batting .341 in 11 games in August.

**GATOR CHOMP:** After seeing his four-game hitting streak come to a close with a hitless Friday, Dalton Guthrie exploded for four hits on Saturday, including an RBI double in the two-run eighth...The Florida product has been ripping up the second half with a .326 batting average, which would lead the Florida State League if he had enough at-bats to qualify...If the six at-bats Guthrie is missing were plugged into his stats, the 23-year-old would still be hitting .312, which would still lead the league by 11 points.

**PILE UP THE PUNCH OUTS:** Kyle Glogoski (5) and Óscar Marcelino (1) contributed six strikeouts on the mound for the Threshers on Saturday night, lifting the pitching staff's total to 1,057...The Threshers continue to pace the Florida State League in the punch out category, leading the Fort Myers Miracle (MIN) by 27.
