**YESTERDAY:** The Captains edged the West Michigan Whitecaps, 1-0. **Elvis Perez** scored the game's only run in the fifth inning. With runners on first and second with two outs, **Richie Palacios** worked the count full on Whitecaps starter **Dane Myers**. The runners took off on the 3-2 pitch and Palacios hit a broken-bat flare to the right of second base. Shortstop **Cam Warner** cut across the bag, fielded the ball on a hop, bobbled it and fired late to first. As Palacios reached on the error, Perez busted it around third and slid in ahead of the throw from first baseman **Rey Rivera**. The Captains sealed the game in the ninth thanks to a laser throw by left fielder **Oscar Gonzalez**. With men on first and second with two outs, **Joey Morgan** singled through the shortstop hole. **Brady Pollicelli** rounded third and tried to score, but **Gonzalez** threw a strike to catcher **Josh Rolette** who tagged out Pollicelli to end the game. Captains starter **Jean Carlos Mejia** struck out a career-high 10 batters over seven shutout innings to earn the win and **Kyle Nelson** pitched a scoreless ninth to pick up the save. **Myers** suffered the loss.

**WELCOME BACK:** **Austen Wade** returns to the Captains today following over two months on the Disabled List. The centerfielder collided with SS **Ernie Clement** on a flare to left-center on May 20 at West Michigan.

**PLAYOFF PUSH:** The Captains enter today tied with Fort Wayne for the Wild Card and trailing South Bend by 1.5 games for the top playoff position in the Eastern Division. The Captains own the head-to-head tiebreaker against Fort Wayne (6-2) and West Michigan (7-5), but not against South Bend (4-6) or Dayton (6-9).

**2018 DRAFTEES:** The Captains now have three of the Indians' 2018 draft picks on their roster. Cleveland has sent RHP **Nick Sandlin** (2<sup>nd</sup> round), INF **Richie Palacios** (3<sup>rd</sup> round) and RHP **Robert Broom** (10<sup>th</sup> round) to Lake County.

**STARTING STRONG:** Over the last 24 games, Captains starters have posted a 2.94 ERA (45 ER, 137.2 IP) with 137 strikeouts against 33 walks.

**MOVING PARTS:** The Indians dealt former Captain and #1 prospect **Francisco Mejia** to the San Diego Padres on Thursday in exchange for a pair of Major League relievers, LHP **Brad Hand** and RHP **Adam Cimber**. Mejia was with Lake County in 2015 and 2016. During the 2016 season, the switch-hitting catcher put together a 50-game hitting streak between Lake County and High-A Lynchburg. On July 6, the Indians traded 2018 Captains RHP **Tommy DeJunes** to the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP **James Hoyt**. DeJunes was a Midwest League All-Star for the Captains this season and posted a 3.38 ERA across 20 relief appearances for Lake County.

**DÉJÀ VU:** The DeJunes trade marks the second straight season that the Indians traded a player on the Captains' roster. Last year, RHP **Ryder Ryan** was traded to the New York Mets in exchange for Major League OF **Jay Bruce**. Like DeJunes this season, Ryan was also a MWL All-Star the year he was dealt.

**HOME COOKING:** The Captains have posted a 26-24 record at Classic Park, but are 18-33 on the road this season. Lake County has a run differential of -7 at home and a -57 run differential on the road.

**HOME RUN KINGS:** The Captains lead the Midwest League in home runs with 86. Clinton is in second with 81 homers. Lake County, however, is 11<sup>th</sup> in runs scored with 421.

#### WHO'S HOT?

- Miguel Eladio:** Has gone 11-for-27 (.407) in his last eight games with two doubles and five RBIs.
- Jose Vicente:** Is 7-for-16 (.438) in his last four games with a home run, two doubles, three RBIs and three multi-hit performances.
- Nolan Jones:** Has homered twice in his last six games and is 19-for-54 (.352) in his last 17 games with four homers, 16 walks and 11 strikeouts.
- Richie Palacios:** Left Mahoning Valley on a 17-game hitting streak and slashed .411/.477/.589 with the Scrappers.

**MIDWEST LEAGUE ALL-STARS:** Three Captains were named to the Midwest League Eastern Division All-Star Team for 2018: OF **Will Benson**, LHP **Kyle Nelson** and RHP **Tommy DeJunes** (traded to Houston on July 6). Benson and Nelson played in the 54<sup>th</sup> MWL All-Star Classic in Lansing, while DeJunes could not play due to injury. Benson started in right field and went 1-for-2 with a single. Nelson retired both batters he faced in the seventh inning. He struck out Quad Cities' Bryan De La Cruz looking and got Clinton's Ryan Costello to line out to centerfield.

**HOME RUN DERBY:** **Will Benson** finished second in the 2018 Midwest League Home Run Derby on June 19 in Lansing. Benson hit 23 home runs, but was bested by Bowling Green catcher **Ronaldo Hernandez**. The Hot Rods' backstop won the final round with 13 home runs against Benson's 10.

**LAST TIME OUT:** McCarty earned the win on Thursday against Clinton after allowing one run over 5.2 innings. He allowed five hits, struck out five and walked four. The LumberKings' lone run came in the fourth when McCarty walked Keeegan McGovern with one out, gave up a two-out single to Juan Camacho and then surrendered an RBI single to Zach Scott.

**SWING AND A MISS:** McCarty is tied for second in the Midwest League in strikeouts (109) and sits third in K/9 among starters (9.98).

**LAST SEASON:** Made his professional debut with the Mahoning Valley Scrappers. The southpaw was held to a roughly 50-pitch limit and never pitched more than three innings in a single outing. McCarty made his first seven professional appearances out of the bullpen as the back end of a piggyback tandem, mostly behind RHP **Grant Hockin**. His last six appearances of the season were all starts.

**GROOM TO BE:** McCarty got engaged on October 7, 2017. His wedding date is set for December 8, 2018.

**FAMOUS COACH:** McCarty was the starting QB on a state-title winning Oak Grove football team... His offensive coordinator was Brett Favre.

**HS TO COLLEGE TO MiLB:** McCarty was teammates with RHP Taylor Braley at Oak Grove HS and Southern Mississippi. The Marlins drafted Braley in the 6<sup>th</sup> round last year.

**COLLEGE ACCOLADES:** 2x 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-Conference USA.

**COLLEGE CAREER:** Finished 22-4 in three seasons and led the team in both wins and strikeouts in each of his last two seasons.

Baseball bloodlines: Palacios' dad, Richard, reached Triple-A with the Detroit Tigers... Uncle, Rey, played three Major League seasons for the Kansas City Royals as a catcher, first baseman and pinch runner... Brother, Joshua, was drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 4th round of the 2016 draft out of Auburn. He is currently an outfielder in the Blue Jays' organization at High-A.

Towson History: At 103rd overall, Palacios is the third-highest draft selection in Towson history, behind LHP Chris Nabholz (49th overall, 1988 – Expos) and LHP Chris Russ (94th overall, 2000 – Rangers).

Collegiate Career: Put together an OPS of .895 or higher all three seasons at Towson, including a career-high .972 as a junior. Palacios walked 103 times and struck out just 56 during his career.

 Scouting Report: "Palacios could be a favorite of the analytics set because of his outstanding on-base skills and his fairly consistent performance with the bat. He walked far more often than he has struck out and that, along with his excellent speed, makes him a potential table-setter in the future. There is some raw power to tap into, though it's not a huge part of his game" – [MLB.com](#)

Home-Taught: Per Jones' draft-day video, he's never had a hitting coach, fielding coach or throwing coach (rare in this day and age). Everything he learned, he was taught by his dad in his backyard.

Patience is a Virtue: Led the New York-Penn League in walks last year (43). Also finished second in BB% (16.2%) and 6th in BB/K (0.72). Has led his team in walks in each of his first two years of pro ball.

Hockey Background: Jones played hockey and baseball growing up and played club hockey with the sons of former NHLers Keith Primeau, Daniel Briere and Chris Pronger, among others. Jones' brother, Peyton, is the starting goalie for Penn State University's hockey team and became the program's all-time wins leader this past December.
