



### MISSISSIPPI BRAVES (8-13) VS. JACKSON GENERALS (16-4)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Mississippi Braves will square off with the Jackson Generals for the second consecutive night at Trustmark Park. The M-Braves will look to avenge their Thursday night loss to the Generals when the two teams meet on the diamond at 7:00 p.m. on Friday night. LHP Michael Mader (1-0, 2.84) is scheduled as the M-Braves Friday night starter. Toussaint's counterpart on the mound will be Jackson right-hander, Justin Donatella (1-0, 0.00).

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Mississippi Braves were defeated by the Jackson Generals by a final score of 6-1 in the series opener on Thursday night. The Generals out hit the M-Braves 11-6. The game remained tied 1-1 until the top of the fifth inning when the Generals took advantage of several M-Braves miscues, scoring five runs in the top half of the inning. Jackson starter, Jon Duplantier (2-0, 1.80) earned the win while Mississippi starter, Kyle Wright (1-3, 4.66) suffered the loss.

**THIS DAY IN BRAVES HISTORY:** In 1971, Braves outfielder Hank Aaron joins Babe Ruth and Willie Mays as the only major league player to hit 600 career home runs. His historic homer, a 350-foot drive over the left field wall, comes off Gaylord Perry in the third inning of a 6-5 ten-inning loss to the Giants at Atlanta's Fulton County Stadium.

**M-BRAVES VS. GENERALS:** The M-Braves and Generals will meet ten times in 2018 after the Generals went 6-3 against the Braves last season. The Generals (formerly West Tenn Diamond Jaxx) and Braves met in the 2016 SL Championship Series with the Generals (then a Seattle Mariners affiliate) sweeping the best-of-five series, 3-0.

**HAMMER TIME:** Jackson, MS native **Chris Maloney** enters his first season as the M-Braves manager and is the seventh skipper in franchise history.

- Maloney attended Jackson's St. Joseph High School and graduated from Mississippi State University in 1983.
- Maloney spent the previous six years on the St. Louis Cardinals Major League coaching staff as the team's third base coach (2016-July 2017) and first base coach (2012-15).
- Prior to joining the Cardinals, Maloney was the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) manager for five seasons (2007-11), leading the team to winning records in four of his five seasons.
- Maloney ranks ninth among active minor league managers in wins with 1,350 entering the 2018 season.

**PROSPECTING:** The Atlanta Braves farm system was ranked by MLB Pipeline as No. 2 in Major League Baseball. The M-Braves roster features two of the Top 100 in RHP **Kyle Wright** (No. 30) and INF **Austin Riley** (No. 97). The roster has six of the Top 30 Atlanta prospects in Wright (No. 2), Riley (No. 8), RHP **Touki Toussaint** (No. 11), C **Alex Jackson** (No. 14), OF **Travis Demeritte** (No. 21), LHP **Ricardo Sanchez** (No. 27).

**VIDEO BOARD:** In its second season above the LF wall, at 68 feet wide by 28 feet high (1,904 square feet), the state-of-the-art Panasonic HD video board is approximately four-times larger than the previous video display at Trustmark Park (2005-2016). The board is the largest single display in the Southern League and the largest in Central and South Mississippi.

- LHP Michael Mader will make his seventh appearance with the Mississippi Braves in 2018 when he takes the mound against the Jackson Generals tonight. Normally a relief pitcher, Mader will be making his second start of the 2018 season tonight.

- The last time that Mader took the mound for the M-Braves was April 23 against the Mobile BayBears. Mississippi lost the contest by a score of 5-2. The left-handed mader pitched 3.0 innings of relief, allowed three hits, one run, which was earned, walked one and struck out four.
