**TODAY'S GAME:** The M-Braves continue their 10-game road trip today with the first game of a five-game series against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp at The Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville.

• The M-Braves are 6-5 against the Jumbo Shrimp this season and 83-85 all-time, 44-44 all-time in Jacksonville. This is the first series between the clubs at The Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville since a five-game set, August 10-14, 2017. The M-Braves were 8-12 against Jacksonville last season, including 3-7 in Jacksonville.

• This series marks an end to 20-straight games playing AL-style baseball. This is the first NL-style baseball series since facing Pensacola, July 12-15.

• The Braves are coming off a 3-2 series loss at Chattanooga in the first-leg of the 10-game road trip.

**LAST TIME OUT:** The M-Braves won the series finale at Chattanooga on Monday 9-4, earning their second win in the series. LHP Kyle Muller made his Double-A debut and earned the win, striking out four and walking just one over 5.1 innings of two runs baseball. Muller scattered three hits. Five M-Braves had multi-hit games including RF Tyler Neslon, 2-for-4 with a home run, 2B Alejandro Salazar, 3-for-4 with a run scored, SS Luis Valenzuela, 2-for-4, double, two runs and two RBI, 3B Daniel Lockhart, 2-for-4, three RBI, a run scored and C Carlos Martinez, 2-for-4, a double, run and RBI.

**STARTING PITCHING:** M-Braves starters have a 2.83 ERA (89 ER/283.0 IP) with 293 strikeouts and just 97 walks over the past 52 games (26-26 record) with 27 quality starts dating back to June 10. Starters have recorded a 10+ strikeout game in four of those outings with a 9.32/9IP ratio.

**ROSTER MOVE:** Atlanta Braves No. 3 overall prospect RHP Ian Anderson was added to Mississippi's roster on Wednesday. Anderson was the Braves' first round pick (3rd overall) in 2016 out of Shenendehowa (NY) HS. Anderson is 2-6 with a 2.52 ERA, 40 walks and 118 strikeouts in 20 starts this season for Florida.

**FRANCO NAMED SL PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** The Southern League announced on Monday that M-Braves RHP **Enderson Franco** had been named Pitcher of the Week. The 25-year-old made two starts this past week going 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA, surrendering just two earned runs over 14.0 innings. The Anaco, VZ native struck out 13 and walked just one over the two starts, earning a 0.50 WHIP and .130 opponents batting average. Franco is the second M-Braves pitcher to receive the honor this season (Bryce Wilson, July 2-8).

**REACHING RAY-PATRICK DIDDER:** INF Ray-Patrick Didder has reached base safely in 22 of 24 games since being promoted to Double-A on July 9. Didder is batting .329 (24-for-73) with a .424 on-base percentage. Didder had a 15-game on-base streak snapped in game two of Wednesday's doubleheader with Birmingham.

**M-BRAVES AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** INF Luis Valenzuela ranks 9th in the SL with a .273 batting average. RHP **Enderson Franco** ranks 7th with a 3.49 ERA. LHP **Corbin Clouse** is 3rd in appearances (38) and 2nd among SL relievers with an 11.94 SO/9IP ratio.

**THE YOUNGEST PLAYER IN THE SOUTHERN LEAGUE:** 19-year-old OF **Cristian Pache**, the Atlanta Braves No. 5 prospect and No. 58 prospect in baseball according to MLB Pipeline has had multi-hit games in three of his first six Mississippi games. He is batting .308 (8-for-26) with a triple, two RBI and two runs scored. Pache will not turn 20 until November 19.

**HAPPY TRAILS:** RHP **Touki Toussaint**, LHP **Bruce Zimmermann**, RHP **Kyle Wright** and RHP **Bryce Wilson** were all in Mississippi's rotation to start the second half. All have since been promoted or traded. In 21 starts, they combined for a 2.23 ERA (29 ER/117.2 IP), 41 walks and 129 strikeouts, 9.83 SO/9IP.

**17 WINS IN JULY:** After an 8-18 June, Mississippi finished 17-12 in July. The 17 wins are the most in a single month during the 2018 season and most since finishing 18-11 in July, 2016. The M-Braves hit .231 for the month and posted a team 3.10 ERA, outscoring the opposition 107-101.

**NEW MLB PIPELINE PROSPECT RANKING FEATURES SEVEN M-BRAVES:** The Mississippi Braves feature seven of the Atlanta Braves Top 30 prospects and two Top 100 MLB Prospects according to MLB Pipeline's July 26 update. RHP **Ian Anderson** (#3 and #39 in all of MLB), OF **Cristian Pache** (#5 and #58 in all of MLB), LHP **Kyle Muller** (#11), LHP **Thomas Burrows** (#20), OF **Travis Demeritte** (#23), LHP **Ricardo Sanchez** (#27) and RHP **Josh Graham** (#29) are among Atlanta's Top 30 prospects.

**FROM PEARL TO ATLANTA:** LHP **Colby Allard** made his Major League debut for the Braves on July 31, and became the 135th M-Braves player and sixth this season to move on and make their MLB debut. Allard joins C **Williams Astudillo** (June 30, Twins) OF **Dustin Peterson** (May 28), RHP **Mike Soroka** (May 1), OF **Ronald Acuña Jr.** (April 25) and LHP **Jesse Biddle** (April 21) to have debuted this season. In total, 134 players, have gone on to make their MLB debuts after playing in Pearl since 2005. OF **Michael Reed** has previously made his MLB debut for Milwaukee, but made his debut with Atlanta after opening the 2018 season in Mississippi on July 23 at Miami.

### TODAY'S GAME

- RHP Elian Leyva is set to make his 18th M-Braves appearance and third start today in the series opener at Jacksonville.
- Leyva is 2-0 with a 2.83 ERA (11 ER/35 IP), 11 walks, 32 strikeouts in 15 relief outings this season and 0-1 with a 4.00 ERA (4 ER/9 IP), five walks, 13 strikeouts in two starts.
- Leyva is 1-1 with a 4.32 ERA (8 ER/16.2 IP), six walks, 15 strikeouts in six road games and 1-0 with a 2.30 ERA (7 ER, 27.1 IP), six walks, 30 strikeouts in 11 home games.
- Leyva's first start for Mississippi came on May 27 vs. Jacksonville, settling for a no-decision, pitching the first 4.0 innings in a 10-2 win.
- This will be Leyva's third career start in professional baseball, making one start for Gwinnett on June 12 at Norfolk.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Leyva started the series opener in Chattanooga on August 2 and gave up four runs (two runs in the first and two runs in the second) on eight hits with one walk and six strikeouts over 5.0 innings and 94 pitches. The M-Braves dropped the series opener to the Lookouts, 12-3.

### 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

- Leyva is currently on his fifth stint with the M-Braves this season. He was added to the M-Braves roster for the first time on April 8 from Rookie Danville...sent to Triple-A Gwinnett on April 13...returned to M-Braves from Gwinnett on April 17...sent back to Gwinnett on April 21 and then returned again on April 30. Leyva went back to Gwinnett on June 11 and returned to Mississippi on June 13...His next stint with Gwinnett began on June 26 and he was last returned to Mississippi on July 19.
- With Gwinnett this season: 12 G, 1 GS, 1-1, 2.70 ERA (8 ER/26.2 IP), eight walks, 20 strikeouts and 1.16 WHIP.

### PRIOR TO 2018

- Leyva pitched for nine seasons with the Serie Nacional (Cuban National Series) between 2007 and 2014, almost entirely as a reliever, compiling a 14-8 record and 5.68 ERA with 90 strikeouts and 100 walks.
- Leyva went from the Serie Nacional to the baseball league in Spain, where he played for CB Barcelona. His performance there may have been what caught the Braves' eye: he put up an ERA of 0.70 in ten outings (64 innings) for Barcelona, including an 82/17 K/BB ratio.

## ACQUIRED

- Signed by the Atlanta Braves to a minor-league contract on February 3, 2017.
- Originally selected by the Rockies in the first round (34th overall) in 2009 out of Lipscomb University

## 2018 NOTES

- Began the season on the Major League roster and appeared in one game for the Braves...was optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett on March 31 and was outrighted to Gwinnett on April 25....Brothers was 2-4 with a 7.24 ERA (22 ER/27.2 IP) for the Stripers this season with 33 walks and 37 strikeouts in 32 games. The lefty converted one of two save opportunities.

## 2017 NOTES

- In his first season with the Braves organization, appeared in 27 games out of the bullpen with Atlanta, while also spending time with Triple-A Gwinnett and Double-A Mississippi...Began the season on the minor league disabled list before joining Double-A Mississippi on 5/20...Appeared in 10 games before transferring to Triple-A Gwinnett on 6/18...Atlanta selected his contract from the G-Braves on 6/29...He made his Braves debut that evening with a scoreless inning at SD...Returned to the G-Braves on 8/21 before the Braves recalled him on 9/1 for the remainder of the season...Struck out 33 batters over 23.2 major league innings (12.55 K/9), and fanned at least one batter in 20 of his 27 MLB appearances...Was the only pitcher in the majors with at least 30 strikeouts and fewer than 25.0 IP...His 27 games were his most since appearing in 74 with Colorado in 2014...All four of his wins came at SunTrust Park...All three of his losses came on the road.

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- 20-14 record with a 3.79 ERA and 20 saves in 314 MLB games from 2011-2018...Made his Major League debut on June 6, 2011 at San Diego, allowing two hits and no runs in 0.2 innings...In 2012, recorded a team-high and career-most eight wins as he made 75 appearances out of the bullpen for Colorado...Struck out 83 batters, most among Rockies relievers...In 2013, set career highs with 19 saves and a 1.74 ERA (13 ER/67.1 IP) as he made 72 relief appearances with the Rockies...His ERA was the fourth lowest among N.L. relievers and a Rockies franchise record by a reliever. Recorded 32 straight scoreless outings (30.0 IP) from 4/10-6/28, the second-longest streak in Rockies history.
