Omaha won the 2017 series between the two ball clubs 9-6. Tonight, left-hander Erik Jokisch starts for the Sounds against right-hander Scott Barlow for the Storm Chasers.

Day Games:	0-2	<b>Eric Jokisch:</b> 28-year-old Eric Jokisch starts for Nashville in tonight's game. The left-hander is making his second start of the 2018 campaign. He allowed four runs on eight hits in five innings at New Orleans on April 8. Jokisch signed a minor-league free agent contract with Oakland on December 6, 2017 and was a non-roster invitee to Oakland's big league spring training. He spent all but one game with the Triple-A Reno Aces in 2017 and went 8-8 with a 4.21 ERA. Jokisch tossed at least five innings in 20 of his 22 starts. The Illinois native has a career minor league record of 59-51 with a 3.67 ERA.
Night Games:	3-3	The southpaw appeared in four games with the Chicago Cubs in 2014 for his only big league action. Jokisch was originally drafted by the Chicago Cubs in the 11th round of the 2010 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Northwestern University.

April:	3-5	<b>Scott Barlow:</b> 25-year-old Scott Barlow starts for the Storm Chasers in tonight's series opener. It's Barlow's second appearance of 2018 after starting on April 7 against Colorado Springs. The right-hander allowed one earned run over 4.1 innings while walking five and striking out seven in the no-decision.
May:		Barlow has a career minor league mark of 29-30 with a 4.14 ERA in 110 games (104 starts). He split the 2017 season between Double-A Tulsa and Triple-A Oklahoma City in the Dodgers organization.
June:		He was 7-6 with a 3.29 ERA in 26 games (26 starts). He fanned 160 hitters in 139.2 innings and held opposing batters to a .192 batting average. Kansas City signed Barlow to a minor-league contract on December 7, 2017. The New London, Connecticut native was drafted by the Dodgers in the 6th round of the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Golden Valley (CA) High School.
