**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds continue their five-game homestand tonight against the New Orleans Baby Cakes. The Sounds scored a thrilling come-from-behind 7-6 win in 10 innings last night to take the first two games of the set. Tonight, right-hander James Naile starts for the Sounds against left-hander Adam Conley for the Baby Cakes.

**James Naile:** 25-year-old James Naile starts for the Sounds in tonight's game. The right-hander is 3-1 with a 1.19 ERA in four starts in 2018. Naile dropped his first decision of the season against Omaha on April 21. He allowed three earned runs in five innings in Nashville's 6-2 loss. He went 2-3 with a 3.30 ERA in 18 games (14 starts) across three levels in 2017. Naile spent the majority of 2017 with Double-A Midland, going 2-3 with a 3.21 ERA in 14 games (10 starts). Naile made two starts for Nashville in 2016 and went 1-1 with an ERA of 5.73. The right-hander has a career minor league record of 17-15 with a 3.04 ERA. The Cape Girardeau, Missouri native was drafted by the Oakland Athletics in 20th round of the 2015 MLB Draft.

**Adam Conley:** 27-year-old Adam Conley starts for New Orleans in tonight's game. Conley is making his fifth start of the season and is 0-3 with a 13.14 ERA. In 12.1 innings, the southpaw has allowed 18 runs on 25 hits and 9 walks. He pitched against Nashville on Opening Day and allowed seven earned runs in New Orleans' 11-0 loss. The left-hander went 3-3 with a 5.49 ERA in 12 games (12 starts) with the Baby Cakes in 2017. He posted an 8-8 record with a 6.14 ERA in 22 games (20 starts) with Miami. The Redmond, Washington native has a career minor league record of 37-27 with a 3.99 ERA in 102 games (97 starts). Conley was drafted by the Florida Marlins in 2nd round of the 2011 MLB Draft out of Washington State University.

**2018 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following amount of days in the American Southern Division standings in 2018: First: 1, Second: 12, Third: 8, Fourth: 0.

**Two Over and Looking for Three:** At 11-9, and for the second time this season, the Sounds are a season-high two games over .500. The last time a Nashville team was at least three games over .500 was on June 19, 2017 when they were 35-32.

**Fowler's 500:** Dustin Fowler's 3-for-5 game last night put him at 500 career hits. The Georgia native is hitting .295 (23-for-78) on the season and is a career .282 (500-for-1772) hitter. 172 of Fowler's hits have been for extra bases (93 doubles, 40 home runs, 39 triples).

**One-Run Success:** With last night's 7-6 win, Nashville improved to 6-1 in one-run games. The six wins are tied for the most in the Pacific Coast League with Oklahoma City.

**Three for Two:** Franklin Barreto and Dustin Fowler had three hits each in last night's win. It's the first time this season two teammates have had a three-hit game in the same game.

**Drive 'Em In:** Josh Phegley drove in a run for the third straight game last night. He became the first Sounds player to collect at least one RBI in three consecutive games.

**Home is Where the Heart is:** The Sounds are in their second homestand of the season with a 7-2 record at First Tennessee Park as compared to 4-7 on the road. The team is hitting .251 at home and just .206 on the road.

**Low Scores:** The Sounds and Baby Cakes have struggled to produce offense in the first month of the season. Both teams are ranked among the bottom four teams in the Pacific Coast League in batting average, on-base percentage, slugging percentage, hits, doubles, total bases, runs, and home runs. The Sounds are 14th in the PCL with a .227 batting average, and of their 12 active position players, five are batting below the Mendoza Line. New Orleans has the lowest team batting average in the league at .222, and of their 13 active position players, five are batting below the Mendoza Line.

**First and Foremost:** The key to victory for the Sounds thus far in 2018 has been scoring first. In 10 of Nashville's 11 wins, the Sounds have been the first team to score, and have lost just twice while doing so. The Sounds have come-from-behind to win a game when trailing in the fifth inning or later just once this season.

**Get Low:** Nashville's lowest ERA in a single month since 2005 came in April 2006 when the pitching staff posted a 2.79 mark. Currently Nashville boasts a PCL-best 2.62 ERA.

**Bullish 'Pen:** Nashville's bullpen has been dominant to begin 2018. Through the first 19 games of the season, the 'pen has a 2.36 ERA (80.0 IP/21 ER). The relievers have allowed 61 hits and 26 walks while recording 80 strikeouts.

**Last Outing:** Naile last worked on April 21 against the Omaha Storm Chasers. He extended his scoreless innings streak to 18.1 innings before allowing his first runs of the season with two outs in the first inning. He suffered his first setback of the season after allowing five runs (three earned) on six hits, including a solo home run, to Salvador Perez. Naile matched a career-high by throwing 101 pitches.

**Against Opponent:** Naile is facing New Orleans for the second time in his career. He squared off against the Baby Cakes on Opening Day and hurled five shutout innings in Nashville's 11-0 win.

- Naile made his first career Opening Day start on April 5 and tossed five shutout innings in Nashville's 11-0 win against New Orleans.
