Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds head to Las Vegas to begin a three-game series with the 51s tonight at Cashman Field. It's the first and only meeting between the two teams this year. Tonight, right-hander Chris Bassitt starts for the Sounds against right-hander Nabil Crismatt for the 51s.

Chris Bassitt: 29-year-old Chris Bassitt starts for the Sounds in tonight's game. The right-hander is 2-4 with a 5.36 ERA in 11 games (eight starts) with Nashville. He has also started six games for Oakland where he's 2-3 with a 3.38 ERA. Bassitt last pitched on July 18 in a start against the Omaha Storm Chasers. He allowed one run earned run on four hits in seven innings. In his career, he's 30-24 with a 3.54 ERA in 144 games (71 starts) in MiLB, and 4-14 with a 4.00 ERA in 35 games (29 starts) in MLB. The Athletics acquired Bassitt in a six-player trade with the Chicago White Sox on December 9, 2014. He was originally drafted by Chicago (AL) in the 16th round of the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Akron.

Nabil Crismatt: 23-year-old Nabil Crismatt starts for the 51s in tonight's series opener. The right-hander is 2-1 with a 6.59 ERA in three starts for Las Vegas in 2018. He began the season with Double-A Binghamton and posted an 8-5 record with a 3.58 ERA in 16 starts including eight quality starts. He allowed one or fewer runs in seven of his starts with Binghamton. In 13.2 innings for Las Vegas, the Colombia native has allowed 20 hits and 6 walks to go along with 8 strikeouts. Crismatt originally signed with the New York Mets as a non-drafted free agent on August 3, 2011.

2018 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following amount of days in the American Southern Division standings in 2018: First: 1, Second: 69, Third: 39, Fourth: 3.

History in Sin City: The Sounds lead the all-time series against Las Vegas 50-45 but the majority of that success has come in Music City. In Sin City the 51s lead the series 25-19. The last time the Sounds were in Sin City, however, the Sounds swept the 51s in four games. In 2016 they outscored the 51s 35-13 and outhit them 59-34. The Sounds batted .355 while holding Las Vegas to a .238 average.

Hitting at Cashman Field: Cashman Field has been one of the most hitter friendly parks in the PCL this year. There have been 142 home runs hit and 622 runs scored at Cashman Field this season, which are second and third in the PCL respectively. Nashville's First Tennessee Park has been one of the most pitcher friendly parks with only 54 home runs hit and 403 runs scored in Music City this season, which are 16th and 14th respectively. In total teams are hitting .287 (1,483-for-5,168) at Cashman Field this season.

Vs. the Pacific Conference: Since 2014 the Sounds are 77-65 against the Pacific Conference but are just 4-10 this season. In that time Nashville is 41-30 on the road against the Pacific Conference including 4-4 at Cashman Field.

Bassitt's Reverse Splits: Tonight's starter for Nashville is Chris Bassitt. The right-hander has a noticeable reverse split as fellow right-handers are batting .340 (35-for-103) while he's holding left-handers to a .228 batting average (18-for-79). Righties have a slash line of .340/.430/.456 and OPS of .866 while lefties have a slash line of .228/.274/.304 and an OPS of .578.

On the Road Again: The Sounds are playing their 49th road game of the season. All 15 other teams in the Pacific Coast League have already played at least 49 games and as many as 52 games. The Sounds are 20-28 on the road this season.

Tennessee Ties: A number of players and members of the 51s staff have ties to the state of Tennessee. Outfielder Bryce Brentz was born in Knoxville and attended Middle Tennessee State from 2008-10 where he was an All-American and he currently resides in Murfreesboro. Pitcher Bobby Wahl played for the Sounds from 2016-18 and was traded to the Mets and assigned to Las Vegas on Sunday. Pitcher Eric Hanhold, currently on the disabled list, was born in Bartlett, Tennessee before his family moved to Florida. Manager Tony DeFrancesco was a catcher for the Sounds in 1988 and '90-91. The strength coach for the 51s, Josh Fields, makes his offseason home in Johnson City.

Getting Louder: Third baseman Sheldon Neuse collected two hits and a season-high 4 RBI Sunday night to extend his hitting streak to eight games. In those eight games he is batting .300 (12-for-40) with 5 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, and 6 RBI. His season-long hitting streak is nine games, which he achieved from June 21-July 1. His batting average has risen from .230 to .245 during the eight-game streak.

Second Half Sounds: In recent years, Nashville has been a second half team. Since 2010, the Sounds have had a losing record after the All-Star break just once. That came in 2015 when they went 25-28. Their best second half performance since 2010 came in 2016 when they went 34-17 en route to a playoff berth. Since 2010, Nashville's overall second-half record is 228-191, including 7-6 this season.

Last Outing: Bassitt last pitched on July 18 against Omaha at First Tennessee Park. He suffered the loss despite tossing his second quality start of the season with the Sounds. All four hits allowed were singles and he walked one while striking out five. He threw 95 pitches, 64 for strikes, which matched a season-high.

Against Opponent: Bassitt has faced Las Vegas twice in his career, both with Nashville. On May 29, 2015 he started and earned the win as he allowed just one run on four hits. Bassitt walked one and struck out four in 5.2 innings. On July 26, 2017 he came out of the bullpen and tossed two shutout innings.

2018 Season Highlights:

- Bassitt began the season on Nashville's Opening Day roster.
- He was recalled by Oakland on April 20 and optioned on April 26...did not pitch for Oakland.
- Recalled by Oakland on June 27 and made six starts before being optioned to Nashville on July 12.
- Two of his six starts with Oakland were quality starts...he walked at least one batter in all six starts with the A's.

Career Notes:

- Began the 2017 season on Oakland's disabled list as he continued to recover from May 6, 2016 Tommy John surgery.
- Spent his first full season in the Oakland organization in 2015 and split time between Nashville and Oakland.
- Made his MLB debut on August 30, 2014 vs. Detroit.

College/Prep Notes:

- Attended the University of Akron from 2008-2011.
- Named second-team All-Mid American Conference as a junior in 2011.
- Had a career ERA of 2.29 at Akron with 14 saves - 2nd-most all-time in school history
- Graduated from Genoa Area (Ohio) High School in 2007 where he helped earn back-to-back league titles in 2006 and 2007.
