DAY BASEBALL ON WEDNESDAY: The Portland Sea Dogs and Hartford Yard Goats (Rockies affiliate) wrap-up their three-game series with a noon contest on Wednesday at Hadlock Field...Portland has won six of their last nine games and seek their second series sweep at home - their first was July 1-3 vs. Trenton (four games in three days)...RHP **Bryan Mata** makes his fifth Double-A start and his third at Hadlock Field (1-1, 2.25).

BROOMS WERE OUT: Portland began the three-game set with Hartford by sweeping a twinbill on Tuesday night, 7-2 and 1-0...In the opener, the 'Dogs scored five runs in the fifth inning to put the game away...**Tate Matheny** smacked his eighth homer, a three-run shot over the Maine Monster...In the second game, **Denyi Reyes** hurled six scoreless frames to earn his fourth straight win...**Kevin Lenik** retired all three batters to earn his first save in the Red Sox system.

WHAT A RUN: LHP **Daniel McGrath** has not allowed an earned run in his last 38.0 innings pitched with Portland...He yielded an unearned run on July 6th at New Hampshire, and his last earned run allowed was a solo-homer to SS **Alan Trejo** on May 28th at Hartford...He is 2-0, 0.66 ERA in eight starts.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Portland's starters have posted a 2.37 ERA (44 ER/167.0 IP) in their last 27 starts...On the last trip, the starters went 2-1, 1.63 ERA (7 ER/38.2 IP), and went scoreless in five of seven appearances.

HEY, IT WORKED OUT: The lone run for the 'Dogs in the second game occurred in the fourth inning when Matheny hit into a double play with the bases loaded...Portland has seven hits in the second game.

GLAD TO HAVE YOU BACK: OF **Marcus Wilson** is 8-for-26 (.308), 2 HR, 6 RBI in nine games since his return from High-A Salem...Wilson was named the Uncle Ray's Player of the Month for June.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland and Hartford are meeting for the final time at Hadlock Field this season...The two teams have one more series on August 13-15, playing four games in three days.
