SATURDAY IN THE PAKR: The Portland Sea Dogs and Akron RubberDucks (Indians affiliate) continue their three-game series on Saturday night at Hadlock Field... Portland is 1-3 on their current homestand, and 3-4 during a 15-game stretch against the Western Division...Right-hander **Mike Shawaryn** returns to the hill tonight, making his 11th start of the season...Following the homestand, the 'Dogs travel to Richmond and Bowie next week.

BIG THIRD FOR AKRON: Akron scored five times in the third inning, sending 10 men to the plate, defeating the Sea Dogs, 8-2 in the series opener...**Chad De La Guerra** knocked in both runs for the 'Dogs with a groundout and fielder's choice...Akron DH **Connor Marabell** went 2-for-5 with 3 RBI and **Bobby Bradley** went 2-for-4 with a solo homer...RHP **Dominic DeMasi** worked four innings of relief to earn his fifth win of the season.

THAT WAS NUMBER ONE: Righty **Durin O'Linger** made his Double-A debut last night, lasting 2.1 innings on seven hits, seven runs (six earned), three walks and a strikeout...O'Linger made the spot-start with **Teddy Stankiewicz** promoted to Triple-A Pawwtucket.

SAME AS THURSDAY: For the second straight night, **Danny Mars** went 2-for-3...Last night, Mars tripled and scored in the sixth inning...The second-year Sea Dog is hitting .261, HR, 3 RBI, 3B and 2B in seven games this month.

THAT'S A SEASON HIGH: **Luke Tandler** went 1-for-4 last night to extend his hitting streak to a season-high six straight games....Tandler is hitting .282, 4 HR, 15 RBI in 22 games at Hadlock Field.

TURN THE BEAT AROUND: **Josh Ockimey** is hitting .292 (38-for-130) with 7 HR, 23 RBI, 10 2B and 27 BB since May 1st...The Philadelphia native has a two-hit game in four of his previous six starts.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland and Akron play two series this season, totaling six games...The two teams will meet at Canal Park on August 10-12...Since 2013, Akron has won 21 of 29 from the Sea Dogs, including five straight season series.

LOOK BACK AT 2017: Went 8-7 with a 3.81 ERA (57 ER/134.2 IP) in 26 starts between Low-A Greenville and High-A Salem, the 7th-lowest ERA among Red Sox minor leaguers...Led the organization with 169 SO, the 4th-most in Class-A...Struck out a career-high 12 on May 6th vs. Augusta and 11 on May 24th at Kannapolis...Named Boston's Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Month for May (5 GS, 3.30 ERA, 11 ER/30.0 IP, 46 SO)...Promoted to High-A Salem on June 4th...Went 5-3 with a 3.07 ERA (24 ER/70.1 IP), a .202 opponent AVG (51-for-252), 80 SO, and 30 BB in his final 13 High-A starts.

CAREER/PERSONAL NOTES: Left the University of Maryland holding career records in wins (30), strikeouts (307), and innings (307.1)...As a junior in 2016, set the program's single season records in wins (13) and strikeouts (138)...Named to the 2016 Big Ten All-Tournament Team...Struck out 16 batters in his postseason outing vs. Indiana, including each of the first six he faced, both records for TD Ameritrade Park in Omaha, NE.
