**LAST ONE IN RICHMOND**: Portland looks to salvage the final game of a three-game set with the Richmond Flying Squirrels (Giants affiliate) on Thursday night at the Diamond...Portland has scored only one run in the two games, a second-inning RBI groundout by Jhon Nunez in the series opener...Righty Mike Shawaryn (2-5, 3.41) makes his 12th start of the season...Shawaryn has made eight of his 11 previous starts on the road (1-5, 4.17).

ALL IN THE FIRST: Richmond's Miguel Gomez and Jerry Sands hit back-to-back homers in the first inning, accounting for all the runs in a 3-0 win over Portland... Former UMaine standout Mike Connolly (3-2) worked two scoreless frames of relief to earn the win...**Teddy Stankiewicz** did not yield a run in his final 5.2 innings pitched but took the loss...Jhon Nunez paced Portland's offense by going 3-for-3, and Daniel McGrath pitched two scoreless.

WELCOME TO AFFILIATED BALL: Johnny Bladel made his debut with an affiliated club last night, going 1-for-3...Bladel spent 2014-18 in the Independent Leagues, most recently with the Southern Maine Blue Crabs of the Atlantic League...The Ashburn, Virginia native grew up 130 miles north of Richmond.

**BACK WITH A BANG**: Josh Ockimey returned to the lineup last night after missing four games and went 2-for-4 with a double...Ockimey is hitting .362 (25-for-69) 4 HR, 14 RBI, 6 2B in his last 20 games.

TIED A CAREER HIGH: Nunez tied a career-high with three hits last night, the firstyear Sea Dog has reached base safely in 21 of 26 games since his promotion from High-A Salem.

**SWING ENDS THIS WEEKEND**: The Sea Dogs are 4-7 during a 15-game stretch against the Western Division, which ends this weekend in Bowie.

**AGAINST THE OPPONENT:** Portland and Richmond play two series this season, totaling six games...The two teams will meet at Hadlock Field on August 3-5...Dating back to 2016, the 'Dogs had a seven-game winning streak in Richmond snapped last night, but have won 10 of the last 13 overall from the Squirrels.
