**NICE TO BE BACK HOME:** The Portland Sea Dogs open up a seven-day, eight-game homestand, taking on the Hartford Yard Goats (Rockies affiliate) on Tuesday night at Hadlock Field...Portland returns home after a 4-4 road trip, but won four of seven games as the road team...The 'Dogs were the home team in Game 2 of May 15th's doubleheader at Reading...Lefty **Kyle Hart** seeks his second straight win, he beat Hartford on April 17th in Maine.

**RIVERA HOMERS IN TRIP FINALE:** Altoona set a season-high with 12 runs and 17 hits, defeating the Sea Dogs, 12-3 on Sunday afternoon at Peoples Natural Gas Field...Portland took a 1-0 lead in the first on a run-scoring double by **Josh Ockimey**...**Jeremy Rivera** finished 2-for-4 with a two-out homer in the seventh...**Will Craig** led Altoona's offense, going 3-for-4, HR and 4 RBI...Pirates Top Prospect **Mitch Keller** (5-2) earned the win and **Dedgar Jimenez** took the loss.

**BATS ARE SIZZLING:** On May 8th, the Sea Dogs were ninth in the Eastern League in team batting average at .231...They enter tonight's game hitting .260 (T-2nd in the E.L.) and rank fifth in the league in runs scored at 191...Portland is hitting .313 (151-for-482) with 14 homers and 90 runs scored over their last 14 games - at least eight runs in five of their last seven games and at least seven scored in 10 of their previous 14.

**UP TO A LUCKY 13:** **Chad De La Guerra** has hit safely in all 13 games since joining Portland on May 9th from Triple-A Pawtucket...De La Guerra hit 3 homers and knocked in 11 runs on the trip, including a career-high 5 RBI on May 15th in Reading, connecting on his first career grand slam.

**NOW, THAT'S A WEEK:** **Jantzen Witte** hit .452 (14-for-31) with 2 HR and 10 RBI...His 14 hits was tied with Binghamton's **Jeff McNeil** for the second most...New Hampshire's **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** had 16 hits.

**AGAINST THE OPPONENT:** Portland dropped 12 of 21 to the Yard Goats in 2017, including seven of 10 in Maine...The two clubs will meet 23 times this season, and play a five-game series on July 4-8 at Hartford...Portland has lost seven straight games to the Yard Goats.
