**STUCK IN THE MIDDLE IN HARTFORD:** The Portland Sea Dogs and Hartford Yard Goats (Rockies affiliate) play the middle game of their three-game series on Wednesday night at Dunkin' Donuts Park...Portland has dropped 12 of 13 this month away from Maine but went 8-8 at Hadlock Field in May...Righty **Denyi Reyes** secunds his second consecutive win, making his 10th start of the season...The two teams conclude the series on Thursday morning with a 10:35 a.m. first pitch.

**GOATSTAKE THE OPENER:** 2B **Josh Tobias** hit a two-run homer in the fourth inning, but Portland dropped the opener, 4-2 to the Yard Goats on Tuesday night...RHP **Rico Garcia** (6-1) earned his third win against the Sea Dogs, working five innings on two runs and seven strikeouts...The Yard Goats scored three runs off losing pitcher **Darwinzon Hernandez** (1-4) in the third inning...Hartford fanned 17 batters, a season-high for the 'Dogs' offense.

**GRAND FINALE:** CF **Tate Matheny's** grand slam on Monday was the second of his career (three Double-A homers overall) and the first for the Sea Dogs since his slam on June 25, 2018...Portland's last grand slam at Hadlock Field previous to Monday's was **Chad De La Guerra** on May 15, 2018, in game two of a doubleheader.

**WELCOME TO PORTLAND:** Former Hartford Yard Goat RHP **Konner Wade** made his debut in the Red Sox system on Sunday afternoon...Wade followed Johnson and worked 3.2 innings on three hits, two runs, two walks, and four strikeouts.

**NICE HAVING YOU BACK:** Since his return to Portland from Triple-A Pawtucket, Tobias is hitting .270 (10-for-37), HR, 6 RBI, and 5 BB in 11 games...Last night was his first homer of the season.

**TWO FOR BRETT:** 2B **Brett Netzer** went 2-for-4 with two runs scored on Monday afternoon...Netzer still holds the team's longest hitting streak, hitting in 11 straight to open the season.

**AGAINST THE OPPONENT:** Portland has lost all three series to Hartford this season, dropping two of three at Dunkin' Donuts Park on April 29-May 1...The two teams meet 19 times this season.
