**THAT'S A WRAP FOR 2019:** The Portland Sea Dogs end the 2019 regular season, taking on the New Hampshire Fisher Cats (Blue Jays affiliate) on Monday afternoon at Hadlock Field...With a win today, the 'Dogs take three of four in the series from the 'Cats and finish the second half at .500...LHP **Matthew Kent** makes his 22nd appearance of the season and his 18th start...Kent is making his 49th Double-A appearance.

**NETZER SNAPS THE NO-HITTER:** 2B **Brett Netzer** provided Portland's lone hit, a two-out single in the seventh inning to plate RF **Marcus Wilson**, as the 'Dogs suffered a 7-1 loss on Sunday afternoon to New Hampshire...RHP **Yennsy Diaz** (W, 11-9) worked seven innings on one hit, one run, two walks, and fanned eight to earn the win...LF **Brock Lundquist** went 2-for-4 with a bases-clearing triple and a solo-homer.

**SETTING NEW MARKS:** LHP **Daniel McGrath** is leading the Eastern League with a 1.68 ERA, which is currently the best single-season ERA in team history, and the lowest in the Eastern League since **Brad Arnsberg's** (Albany) 1.59 ERA in 1995...McGrath tossed seven innings with Pawtucket on Sunday, allowing just three runs.

**THEY NEED 11:** Portland pitchers fanned 16 batters on Sunday and need 12 set to the franchise record held by the 2001 team (1141)...RHP **Matthew Gorst** fanned six batters over 3+ innings, making his third career start on Sunday.

**ACTUALLY NOT BAD:** Portland has been one-hit four times this season but 2-2 in those contests...On August 17th, they beat New Hampshire 2-1 with SS **Jeremy Rivera** picking up the lone hit.

**CLOSE CALL:** The Sea Dogs have been involved in 47 one-run games this season, with 10 of 14 wins in August by one run...Portland has a shutout win in four of their last eight games.

**AGAINST THE OPPONENT:** Portland has clinched the season series from the Fisher Cats after last night's win...The Sea Dogs split ten games at Delta Dental Stadium earlier this season.
