**Today's Preview:** The Grasshoppers (A, Marlins) look to bounce back after suffered an 18-run defeat in Wednesday's 20-2 loss to the Shorebirds (A, Orioles) with Game 2 of this 3-game series. The blowout came almost 10 years to the day since the last time Greensboro allowed 20 runs in a game. Greensboro is sending Brandon Miller to the mound against Delmarva's Brennan Hanifée in today's pitching match-up of right-handers. The Grasshoppers are tied for second in the Northern Division Second Half, sitting 1.0 game back of 5-1 West Virginia.

**Hoppers Hurler:** Brandon Miller, 22, makes his 15th start of the season and first against the Shorebirds this season. He is coming off a no decision on June 21 at Hagerstown, working 5.2 innings and allowing three runs on seven hits. Miller has fanned six or more batters in four of his last six starts, including a season-high eight strikeouts in 7.0 innings on May 29 at Lakewood. In two starts against Delmarva in 2017, Miller went 0-0 with a 16.19 ERA (12 ER/6.2 IP) and six strikeouts in two starts. His last win came June 3 vs. West Virginia, striking out seven while limiting the Power to a run on three hits over 6.0 innings. Miller ended 2017 with Greensboro after joining the Marlins organization as part of a mid-season trade from the Mariners in a July 20, 2017, deal that sent RHP David Phelps to Seattle in exchange for Miller, outfielder Brayan Hernandez, RHP Lukas Schiraldi, and RHP Pablo Lopez. In five starts for Greensboro in 2017, Miller went 0-3 with a 8.86 ERA, finishing his 2017 season 9-7 and 4.56 ERA (71 ER/122.1 IP) and 106 strikeouts in 23 games (23 starts) between Clinton and Greensboro. The Mariners drafted Miller in the sixth round of the June 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Millersville University of Pennsylvania.

**About Last Night:** The Shorebirds ran away from the Grasshoppers in a 20-2 blowout on Wednesday. Delmarva scored in six different innings, including an 8-run seventh, while out-hitting Greensboro 22-6. The Shorebirds set the tone early when Kirvin Moesquit led off the game with a home run (4) to left field as part of a 3-run first inning. The Grasshoppers appeared to be up for the fight in the second inning before a twice-reversed call went against Greensboro. Will Allen led off the bottom of the second by a drive to right field that stopped underneath the pad of the outfield wall. Delmarva right-fielder Will Robertson refused to play the ball, throwing his hands up calling for time from base umpire Harley Acosta, who appeared to grant time while Allen rounded the bases. When Acosta removed the ball without ostensible effort from the base of the wall, Allen was awarded a home run. Shorebirds manager Buck Britton protested the call, and after umpires conferred, the call was reversed again, with Allen have to return to second base with a ground rule double. Despite Allen eventually scoring on a Marcos Rivera sacrifice fly, the Hoppers offense failed to recover as the Shorebirds piled on in the ensuing innings. Delmarva scored three in the third, four in the fourth, and one in the fifth before matching that entire total with an 8-run seventh inning. Robertson paced the Shorebirds offense with a 5-hit game, finishing 5-for-6 with two doubles, two RBI, and two runs scored. Delmarva's Cameron Bishop (7-4) earned the win with 6.0 innings of work, allowing a run on three hits while walking two and striking out three. Scott Sebald (0-1) took the loss in his Class A debut, allowing six runs on seven hits over 3.0 innings.

**Record Runs:** Wednesday night's run total matched the Grasshoppers' franchise record for runs allowed when Greensboro gave up 20 runs for the second time since the team's inaugural 2005 season. The only other 20-run game for a Hoppers opponent came nearly 10 years ago to the day, on June 28, 2008, in a 20-6 loss to Kannapolis. That night, Greensboro allowed 23 hits, one more than Wednesday's 22-hit night by Delmarva.

**Off On The Wrong Foot:** Wednesday's loss began with Greensboro giving up a home run to the first batter of the game for the second time this season. Delmarva's Kirvin Moesquit set the tone early when he launched Scott Sebald's third pitch over the left field wall. On April 9, Augusta's Malique Ziegler hit the first pitch of the game by Taylor Braley out of the park.

**Give Me Five:** Delmarva's Will Robertson became the first Grasshopper opponent to collect five hits in a game this season and first since August 24, 2017, when Kannapolis' Jake Burger went 5-for-5, hitting for the cycle and driving in three runs.

**Making Moves:** Greensboro made a bevy of roster moves prior to Wednesday's game with four new faces coming in while four others earned promotions. Chris Reed was promoted to Double-A Jacksonville as pitchers Ryan Lillie and Dustin Beggs joined first baseman Lazarro Alonso in heading to A-Advanced Jupiter. In corresponding moves, Greensboro received LHP Sean Guenther and OF Harrison Dinicola from Jupiter, LHP Daniel Castano from the GCL Marlins, and RHP Jeremy Ovalle from Batavia.

**ERA on the Rise:** With 20 runs (19 earned) allowed in Wednesday's loss to Delmarva, Greensboro's team ERA rose from 3.83 to 4.04. The Grasshoppers now own the ninth-lowest ERA in the 14-team South Atlantic League. Lakewood, which plays in pitcher-friendly FirstEnergy Park, owns the league's lowest ERA at 2.60 while Asheville, which plays in the hitters haven of McCormick Field sits at the other end of the spectrum with a 4.98 ERA.

**So Much Soto:** Isael Soto is currently on a 14-game on-base streak, the longest active streak by a player on the Hoppers roster. He has hit safely in nine of his last 14 games, dating back to June 12, and he has drawn six walks in that span. Soto smacked a 2-run triple on Monday night, his seventh extra-base hit since June 12 (three 2B, one 3B, three HR). With his 4-RBI game last Thursday, Soto posted his most RBI in a game this season while tying his career-high. His last 4-RBI game came during his debut season when he went 2-for-4 with a home run on July 19, 2014, with the GCL Marlins at the GCL Nationals. Both of his 4-RBI games have come against Nationals affiliates.

# IN THE WEEDS: GRASSHOPPERS NOTES

## STREAKING TO JUPITER

Cameron Baranek, who was promoted to Class-A Advanced Jupiter to being the Second Half, finished the first half on a 13-game hitting streak (since June 1) and 21-game on-base streak (since May 24) with Greensboro. Both are the longest by a Hoppers hitter this season. He surpassed an 11-game hitting streak by Jose Devers and a 20-game on-base streak by Jhonny Santos earlier this season. Baranek is batting .420 (21-50) with two home runs, two doubles, and eight RBI over his 13-game hit streak, the longest active streak the SAL and tied for the 10th-longest in 2018. His 21-game on-base streak is the longest by a Grasshopper since James Nelson reached base safely in 37 straight games from April 28-June 9, 2017.

## AIN'T IT GRAND

Cameron Baranek hit the Grasshoppers' first grand slam of the 2018 season and the 13th in the South Atlantic League this season. The last Greensboro slam came July 3, 2017, when Luis Pinto went yard against Asheville's Jared Gesell. Only three times in the SAL – Asheville, Lexington, and Rome – have not hit a grand slam this season.

## BEGGS BETTER THAN BATTERS

Dustin Beggs set a new season-high by a Hoppers pitcher when he struck out 10 batters over 5.0 innings in Tuesday's spot-start. He surpassed Taylor Braley's nine strikeouts April 20 against Charleston. Beggs has now fanned 45 batters in 33.2 innings while walking only six. In addition to having the highest-strikeout performance as a starter with 10 on Tuesday, he also holds the season mark for most K's out of the bullpen after fanning eight batters over 3.0 relief innings on April 27 at Asheville.

## HOPPIN' THEIVES

Greensboro stole a season-high five bases on June 11 against Hickory, with a season-high two players recording multiple swiped bags in a game. Both Cameron Baranek and Thomas Jones stole two bases while Jose Devers added one. The highlight of the game came on a well-executed double-steal as Devers broke for second base, inducing a throw from Crawdads catcher Sam Huff, allowing Jones to break from third and slide head first across the plate. The Grasshoppers' previous season-high was three stolen bases, accomplished three times in 2018.

## DOUBLE THE TRIPLES

Jose Devers became the first Grasshopper to triple twice in a game this season on June 8 against the BlueClaws. He finished 3-for-5 with a pair of RBI-triples, two of the team's season-high three triples in the game. In the first inning, he scored Cameron Baranek from first base with a drive to the right-field corner, and in a fit of déjà vu, hit a similar ball in the third that also brought Baranek across the plate.

## MULTI-HOMER HOPPERS

For the first time since 2016 and the eighth time since the start of the 2008 season, Greensboro had two men with two home runs in the same game as both Micah Brown and Marcos Rivera hit a pair of big flies on June 1 vs. West Virginia, part of a 5-home run game for the Grasshoppers.

Jhonny Santos put on a show for Hoppers fans May 21 against Kannapolis, hitting two home runs in a 5-3 win over the Intimidators in Greensboro. Santos' first career multi-HR game is the 50th by a Hoppers hitter since the start of 2008 and second this year.

Hagerstown eventually caught up to Miller, chasing him from the game after 5.1 innings pitched. The right-hander took no decision that day, allowing four runs on three hits with a walk and five strikeouts in the outing.

## EVERYBODY HITS

All nine batters hit safely for the first time in 2018 when Greensboro fought off Asheville, 11-7 in 10 innings, on April 29. Infielders Jose Devers and Lazaro Alonso led the 16-hit charge with three hits each as the Grasshoppers batted around in the top of the 10th for a 7-run inning. In the big frame, the team collected six hits, including four doubles, to run away from the Tourists after Asheville rallied for two runs in the bottom of the ninth to force the extra inning.

## BEGGS BAFFLES BATTERS

Dustin Beggs dominated out of the bullpen on April 27 at Asheville, striking out eight batters over 3.0 nearly-perfect innings of work. He struck out the first six batters he faced in perfect sixth and seventh innings. After inducing a groundout to open the bottom of the eighth and allowing a base hit – the lone batter to reach against him on the night – the right-hander fanned the final two batters he faced to close his outing. Greensboro fell to Asheville, 3-2.

## SHARP STINGER AGAINST THE GREENJACKETS:

In their first series against the new-look Augusta GreenJackets, Greensboro was stung early as Malique Ziegler led off the game for Augusta with a first-pitch home run off Hoppers starting pitcher Taylor Braley. The GreenJackets hit two home runs in the opening frame, with Ryan Kirby adding a 2-run blast, en route to a 7-4 lead over the Grasshoppers.
