**Today's Preview**: The Grasshoppers (A, Marlins) continue this 3-game home stand wit Game 2 against the BlueClaws (A, Phillies) at First National Bank Field. Greensboro scored a 4-3 win on Independence Day in the series opener to pull within 1.0 game of first place in the South Atlantic League Northern Division Second Half as Lakewood now sits tied with West Virginia atop the

Hoppers Hurlers: Edward Cabrera, 20, makes his 15th start of the season and fifth against the BlueClaws. In four starts against Lakewood, he is 1-2 with a 1.05 ERA (3 ER/25.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts compared to five walks. The BlueClaws at batting .198 (18-91) against him. He is coming off a rain-shortened start at Hickory on June 30, working 3.0 innings and allowing two runs before play was suspended in the middle of the fourth. Cabrera is coming off a strong month of June in which he went 2-1 with a 2.81 ERA (8 ER/25.2 IP) and 26 strikeouts, his best numbers in any month in 2018. He last win came in his First Half finale at Kannapolis on June 15, limiting the Intimidators to a run on six hits over 7.0 innings while striking out a season-high eight. He is tough to beat at home, going 1-3 with a 1.98 ERA (10 ER/27.1 IP) in five home starts compared to 2-3 with a 4.50 ERA (22 ER/44.0 IP) in nine road starts. Last season with Short-Season Batavia, he went 1-3 with a 5.30 ERA (21 ER/35.2 IP) and 32 strikeouts in 13 games (six starts).

About Last Night: With the game tied in the bottom of the seventh, Garvis Lara's leadoff triple set the stage for the go-ahead run in the Grasshoppers' 4-3 win over the Lakewood BlueClaws in front of a season-high 9,063 fans at First National Bank Field. Greensboro (41-41, 7-6 Second Half) overcame a pair of Lakewood home runs to secure the Independence Day victory in the series opener. Daniel Castano (2-0) worked around one rough inning to earn the win in a 7.0inning outing, striking out seven and walking none. Michael Mertz tossed a perfect eighth, setting up Vincenzo Aiello's 1-2-3 ninth inning for the save (6). In the bottom of the seventh with the game even, 3-3, Lara's triple rattled around the right field corner. Thomas Jones followed with a sacrifice fly to left field, and Lara slid head-first across the plate just under the tag of catcher Colby Fitch for what proved to be the winning run. Greensboro took the game's first lead with a 3-run fifth inning, jump-started by Micah Brown's lead-off home run (6). Harrison Dinicola followed with a double to center field, and Michael Hernandez walked behind him. Lara laid down a sacrifice-bunt to move both men into scoring position. Dinicola sprinted home on a wild pitch for a 2-0 lead, and Jose Devers added an RBI-single to cap the frame. All three runs Castano allowed came in the sixth when he surrendered back-to-back home runs to Lakewood's Jake Scheiner, a 2-run shot, and Jhailyn Ortiz for the BlueClaws' only runs of the night. BlueClaws reliever Ismael Cabrera (0-1) took the loss, allowing a run on one run while walking three and striking out two over 2.0 innings.

**Independence Day:** The Grasshoppers earned another win on the Fourth of July on Wednesday, the 12th time in 14 seasons the team has played at home on Independence Day since moving downtown in 2005. Greensboro is now 6-8 record in games played on Independence Day, including a 6-6 mark at home. The Hoppers will spend July 4 on the road next season following the SAL's adoption of a new rule where teams will alternate being home and away on the Fourth of July every other year.

Hock On Top: Greensboro reliever Colton Hock (8-3, 2.90 ERA) is tied atop the SAL with eight wins, equaling Joe Cavallaro from Columbia. The right-handed reliever last suffered a loss on May 11 in a road appearance at Asheville and has allowed more than one earned run in only three of his 20 games this season. In 13 of this outings, he has given up no earned runs. He is holding right-handed hitters to a .185 (17-92) average compared to a .246 (45-183) against all hitters.

### IN THE WEEDS: GRASSHOPPERS NOTES

### **RECORD RUNS ALLOWED**

The June 27 run total against the Shorebirds matched the Grasshoppers' franchise record for runs allowed when Greensboro gave up 20 runs for the second time since the team's inaugural 2005 season. The only other 20-run game for a Hoppers opponent came nearly 10 years ago to the day, on June 28, 2008, in a 20-6 loss to Kannapolis. That night, Greensboro allowed 23 hits, one more than the June 27 loss, 20-2, which was a 22-hit night by Delmarva.

In the process of June 27's 20-2 loss, Delmarva set or tied 11 season high marks for offense against Greensboro, including the following:

### OFF ON THE WRONG FOOT

June 27's loss began with Greensboro giving up a home run to the first batter of the game for the second time this season. Delmarva's Kirvin Moesquit set the tone early when he launched Scott Sebald's third pitch over the left field wall. On April 9, Augusta's Malique Ziegler hit the first pitch of the game by Taylor Braley out of the park in a 7-4 loss to the GreenJackets.

### **GIVE ME FIVE**

Delmarva's Will Robertson became the first Grasshopper opponent to collect five hits in a game this season when he went 5-for-6 as part of the Shorebirds' 22-hit, 20-2 win in Greensboro on June 27. It was the first 5-hit game by a Hoppers opponent since August 24, 2017, Jake Burger went 5-for-5, hitting for the cycle and driving in three runs for Kannapolis.

### STREAKING TO JUPITER

Cameron Baranek, who was promoted to Class-A Advanced Jupiter to being the Second Half, finished the first half on a 13-game hitting streak (since June 1) and 21-game on-base streak (since May 24) with Greensboro. Both are the longest by a Hoppers hitter this season. He surpassed an 11-game hitting streak by Jose Devers and a 20-game on-base streak by Jhonny Santos earlier this season. Baranek is batting .420 (21-50) with two home runs, two doubles, and eight RBI over his 13-game hit streak, the longest active streak the SAL and tied for the 10th-longest in 2018. His 21-game on-base streak is the longest by a Grasshopper since James Nelson reached base safely in 37 straight games from April 28-June 9, 2017.

### **AIN'T IT GRAND**

Cameron Baranek hit the Grasshoppers' first grand slam of the 2018 season and the 13th in the South Atlantic League this season. The last Greensboro slam came July 3, 2017, when Luis Pinto went yard against Asheville's Jared Gesell. Only three times in the SAL –Asheville, Lexington, and Rome – have not hit a grand slam this season.

### **BEGGS BETTER THAN BATTERS**

Dustin Beggs set a new season-high by a Hoppers pitcher when he struck out 10 batters over 5.0 innings in Tuesday's spot-start. He surpassed Taylor Braley's nine strikeouts April 20 against Charleston. Beggs has now fanned 45 batters in 33.2 innings while walking only six. In addition to having the highest-strikeout performance as a starter with 10 on Tuesday, he also holds the season mark for most K's out of the bullpen after fanning eight batters over 3.0 relief innings on April 27 at Asheville.

### **HOPPIN' THEIVES**

Greensboro stole a season-high five bases on June 11 against Hickory, with a season-high two players recording multiple swiped bags in a game. Both Cameron Baranek and Thomas Jones stole two bases while Jose Devers added one. The highlight of the game came on a well-executed double-steal as Devers broke for second base, inducing a throw from Crawdads catcher Sam Huff, allowing Jones to break from third and slide head first across the plate. The Grasshoppers' previous season-high was three stolen bases, accomplished three times in 2018.

### **DOUBLE THE TRIPLES**

Jose Devers became the first Grasshopper to triple twice in a game this season on June 8 against the BlueClaws. He finished 3-for-5 with a pair of RBI-triples, two of the team's season-high three triples in the game. In the first inning, he scored Cameron Baranek from first base with a drive to the right-field corner, and in a fit of déjà vu, hit a similar ball in the third that also brought Baranek across the plate.

### **NO FREE PASSES**

Greensboro pitchers have put together 15 games in 2018 without walking a batter, most recently on July 2 at Hickory.

# JONES DEBUTS WITH PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

Thomas Jones was named the first weekly award winner for the Grasshoppers this season, winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors for April 30-May 6, his first week with the team. He hit .350 (7-20) with a double, four home runs, six RBI, and eight runs scored in five games with Greensboro, starting with his debut on May 2.

#### JONESING FOR OFFENSE

When it comes to first impressions, no Hopper has made a bigger or better one than outfielder Thomas Jones, who joined the team May 2. In his first three games with Greensboro (May 2-4), he went 2-for-4 in each game with at least one home run in all contests. In total, he hit four home runs in three games while batting .500 (6-12) with a double and six RBI. The Marlins selected Jones, now 20 years old, in the third round of the June 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Laurens (S.C.) High School.

### WALKING OFF THE SUNS

Michael Hernandez gave the Grasshoppers their first walk-off home run of the season on May 2 as part of his career day, driving in four runs in an 10-8 win over the Hagerstown Suns. Hernandez finished 3-for-5 with a pair of RBI-singles to go along with his gamewinning 2-run home run off Jared Brasher with no outs in the bottom of the ninth. It was the Grasshoppers second walk-off win of the season and seventh win in the final at-bats during the 2018 season.
