LAST TIME OUT: Dunedin split a doubleheader with the Fort Myers miracle thanks to a dominant outing from Maximo Castillo, going 5.0 IP with 0 runs. Cal Stevenson drove in the only runs of the game with a single into center field, and the Blue Jays won their 2,500 regular season game 2-0 over the Miracle.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Blue Jays will play the final series against the Palm Beach Cardinals this year. In the last series Dunedin took two of three from the Cardinals at Jack Russell Memorial Stadium. Cal Stevenson enters the game with a six game hit streak, after having a 22- game hit streak ended early in the month.

THE STREAK THAT WAS: When the Blue Jays went on an 11 game win streak started on June 28th with a win against the Daytona Tortugas the Blue Jays have led the league in multiple categories. The team had combined for a .287 BA, 93 runs, 22 doubles, 7 triples, 87 RBI, .385 OBP, and a .834 OPS. All of these led the Florida State League in the 11 day stretch. During the streak, Kacy Clemens lead the league in HR at 4, and had a .647 SLG percentage and 1.033 2nd behind Travis Swaggerty of Bradenton. The top five run leaders were Dunedin Blue Jays lead by Cal Stevenson with 16 runs scored. Since the streak has ended however, the Blue Jays are 4-10 in their last 14 games.

VIEW FROM THE TOP: After June 19th's postponement and Clearwater's win, the Blue Jays dropped down to second place in the FSL North Division standings for the first time all season. The Blue Jays spent a total of 67 games and 76 days in first place in the North Division. Dating back to 2005, it marks the most games and the longest amount of days in a row the D-Jays have occupied the top spot in their respective division. Dunedin spent just 12 days in second place regaining their lead on July 2nd. Over the last 30 days, the Blue Jays have been issued the most walks (112), scored the most runs (140), produced the best batting average (.260), driven in the most runs (129), and have the most extra-base hits (71). The Blue Jays were the first team to reach 60 wins in the Florida State League, behind only the Down East Wood Ducks and Visalia Rawhide (62) to reach the 60 win mark faster in High-A.

PUSH FOR 2,500: The Blue Jays won their 2,500 regular season game on July 23 at the Bobby Mattick Complex in a 2-0 victory over the Fort Myers Miracles, the winning goes back to the founding of the organization in 1978. Since the genesis of the organization, Dunedin has compiled 20 winning seasons-including 10 of the last 12 seasons, 15 half division titles, 16 playoff appearances, and the organization's first Florida State League Co-Championship in 2017.

CHAMPIONS OF THE FIRST HALF: With their victory in game one of a doubleheader with the Fire Frogs on June 11th, Dunedin clinched the first half FSL North Division title and punched their ticket to the Florida State League playoffs in September. The clincher marks the sixth first half title and 15th half title overall in franchise history. The first half title also marks the first time the D-Jays have clinched in the first half since 2014. In the first half the Blue Jays compiled the best run differential at +82 and scored 299 runs with the next closest team having 286. Dunedin also gave up the 2nd fewest runs with 217 in the half.

KINGS OF THE HILL: Dunedin pitching have been dominate all season long with the third best ERA at 3.20, 299 ER in 841.1 IP (2nd). The starters have walked 115 batters while striking out 470 batters. Since coming back from the All-Star break Joey Murray has been lights out on the mound. He has a 0.86 WHIP, .158 Opp. BA, 36 K, and a 2.03 ERA. Out of the bullpen Jackson Rees has a 1.10 WHIP and a .215 Opp. BA.

ORIMOLOY-YAY: Demi Orimoloye was named June's Player of the Month for the Florida State League by Minor League Baseball. The Canadian hit a league leading .342 with 21 RBI, 5 HR, .407 OBP, 47 TB, and a 1.051 OPS. His RBI total was tied for the most in the league, and his 47 total bases were good for second. His 1.051 OPS blew away the rest of the field in the month with the next closest player being Trey Harris of the Florida Fire Frogs at .907.

CAL KEEPS HITTING: Cal Stevenson had a career high 22 game hitting streak ended on July 11th against Tampa. During his hitting streak, he has six extra base hits, 25 runs, and has only struck out 12 times in 87 AB. Since June 8th, Stevenson has hit at a .361 AVG with a .462 OBP both lead the FSL, and a .888 OPS (2nd), behind teammate Demi Orimoloye (.962). His 29 runs scored are second best the league with Demi Orimoloye leading at 30, and he is tied for 4th most hits with Brock Deahtage of the Flying Tigers (44). Stevenson has the best average among leadoff hitters with more than 200 AB at .287. He has driven in the most runs (36), walked the most (40), and is tied for the most hits with Bradenton's Travis Swaggerty (74).

WRECK-IT RYAN: Ryan Noda is currently the league leader in RBI with 57 ahead of Bradenton's Cal Mitchell who has 56. He is currently just off his 2018 pace in RBI when he had 1.55 RBI per game average (80 RBI/ 124 G), and right now he has a 1.46 average (57 RBI/ 83 G). Noda is second in walks at 48 with teammate Cal Stevenson in first, and he leads the team with 10 home runs. The 1B/OF also ranks 5th in OPS (.780), and 5th in OBP (.363).
