-When Sixto was a boy growing up in San Cristobal, he played shortstop because he was deemed too small to pitch. The Philadelphia Phillies organized a workout at their old complex in Boca Chica for a Cuban catcher. The team wanted the catcher to see some live pitching to better evaluate him, and Sanchez, who had always wanted to pitch, volunteered for the tryout. After seeing Sanchez pitch at the tryout, instead of signing the Cuban catcher, the Phillies inked the 16-year-old ringer on March 2, 2015 to a \$35,000 deal.

-One of eight children in the Sanchez family, Sixto was working towards his high school diploma while with the Phillies. He graduated eighth grade in January of 2017.

-Ranked as the No. 13 prospect in baseball by Baseball America, No. 23 by Baseball Prospectus and No. 27 by MLB.com, Sanchez was traded by Philadelphia to Miami on February 7, 2019 along with catcher Jorge Alfaro, left-handed pitcher Will Stewart and international bonus slot money in exchange for catcher J.T. Realmuto.

2019 SEASON

-Over his last three starts, Sanchez has surrendered just three runs, all earned, on 16 hits in 20.0 innings for a 1.35 ERA. During this run, he has struck out 23 against three walks.

-Sanchez was assigned to Jacksonville on May 14 from High-A Jupiter.

2018 SEASON

-Sanchez only threw 46.2 innings during the 2018 season because of right elbow inflammation. He did not appear in the Arizona Fall League because of left collarbone concerns

Among the 141 pitchers in the Florida State League who tossed at least 40.0 innings, Sanchez finished 22nd in ERA (2.51). He posted the circuit's 19th-highest ground ball rate (52.3 percent) and 27th-lowest fly ball rate (29.7 percent).

2017 SEASON

-Sanchez was promoted from Low-A Lakewood on August 5 to High-A Clearwater. Among the 119 pitchers who hurled at least 60.0 innings in the Low-A South Atlantic League, Sanchez ranked third in FIP (2.35), eighth in xFIP (2.93) and 19th in ERA (2.41). He had the seventhlowest walk rate (3.5 percent) and 10th-best K-BB% (21.5 percent)

-While with Lakewood, Sanchez limited right-handed hitters to a .189 batting average. Lefties registered just a .193 mark against him

2016 SEASON

-Sanchez did not allow more than one run in any of his 11 starts. In five starts from July 18 through August 12, the right-hander ceded just 14 hits with three walks against 14 strikeouts in 25.0 scoreless innings.

2015 SEASON

-Before the All-Star Break, Sanchez went 1-1 with a 3.63 ERA (17.1 IP, 19 H, 5 BB, 15 K). However following the All-Star Break, the San Cristobal native registered an 0-1 record and 6.48 ERA (8.1 IP, 13 H, BB, 3 K).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Sanchez's favorite player growing up was Hall of Fame right-handed pitcher Pedro Martinez. Sanchez has worn No. 45 at past stops in the minor leagues in Martinez's honor.
