Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (0-2) fell to the Jackson Generals (2-0) by a 14-6 score in the second game of a five-game series at The Ballpark at Jackson on Friday night. Jacksonville right-handed relief pitcher Kolton Mahoney (0-1) took the loss, allowing two runs (both unearned) on two hits with a walk and four strikeouts. Jackson relief pitcher Joel Payamps (1-0) earned the win, allowing a run in his three innings of relief work. The early innings were back and forth between the clubs. Jacksonville's Colby Lusignan gave the Jumbo Shrimp a first inning lead with an RBI double to put the lead at 1-0. The Generals responded with a two-run second to lead 2-1. Jacksonville starting pitcher Nick Neidert in his first professional at bat tied the game at 2-2 in the top of the second inning with an RBI single. With two outs in the top of the second, John Norwood gave Jacksonville a 4-2 lead with his two-run double. The Generals got a run back off Neidert in the bottom of the third with a solo home run by Matt Jones to cut the lead to 4-3. Jackson tied the game an inning later, with Jamie Westbrook bringing in a run on a groundout to second base to even the score at 4-4. Jackson broke the tie in the bottom of the fifth, as Galli Cribbs hit a two-run homer to put the Generals ahead 6-4. An error by Jackson left fielder Jay Gonzalez on a ball hit by Isan Diaz in the top of the sixth scored a run to make it a 6-5 score. The Generals responded with a four-run bottom of the sixth off Jacksonville reliever Jorgan Cavaniero, highlighted by RBI singles from Marty Herum and Cribbs, then a Gonzalez two-run triple put Jackson's lead at 10-5. With the bases loaded for Jacksonville in the top of the eighth, a catcher's interference call on Jones with the bases loaded allowed Norwood to reach safely to score Austin Dean from third base to cut the lead to 10-6. The Generals had another four run inning in the bottom of the eighth off Jacksonville reliever Jose Pena, with Jones hitting his second homer of the night, then Westbrook's two-run double capped the scoring at 14-6. Barrett shined at the plate for Jacksonville, going 4-for-5 in the leadoff spot of Jacksonville's order. Norwood also drove in three runs, and has four RBI through the first two games of the year. The game featured the first Double-A hits for Lusignan, Davis, Brain Schales, and Neidert, the Marlins No. 10 prospect according to MLB.com, pitched three and two-thirds innings in his Marlins organization debut, allowing four runs (three earned) on seven hits with three walks and four strikeouts.

NEWS AND NOTES

Brigham Makes Double-A Debut: Tonight right-handed pitcher Jeff Brigham makes his Double-A debut as he starts for the Jumbo Shrimp against the Jackson Generals. Brigham is coming off a season where he was 4-2 with a 2.90 ERA in 11 starts for High-A Jupiter.

Grin and Barrett: Last night left fielder Kyle Barrett put together a career performance against the Jackson Generals. Batting in the leadoff spot in the order, Barrett went 4-for-5 at the plate, tying a career high with four hits in the game. The last time Barrett had four hits was on April 21, 2017 for the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads at the Bradenton Marauders in a game where he was 4-for-7.

John Norwood, Run Producer: Now that sounds familiar, doesn't it? Through the first two games of the year, John Norwood leads the Jumbo Shrimp with four runs batted in. Last season Norwood led Jacksonville with 62 runs batted in. Norwood is responsible for four of Jacksonville's nine runs batted in, and is hitting .375 with hits in the first two games.

It's Not How You Start: The Jumbo Shrimp are 0-2 to begin the season, and the only other time that Jacksonville lost the first two games in the Marlins era (2009-present) was in 2010, when Jacksonville lost the first two games to West Tenn (now Jackson). Jacksonville would go on to win the 2010 Southern League title.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the Opening Day roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who are listed by [MLB.com](#) as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (2), Isan Diaz (8), RHP Nick Neidert (10), RHP Merandy Gonzalez (16), and RHP Pablo Lopez (24), who is currently on Jacksonville's disabled list. All five of these prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.

Generally Speaking: This is the first of two series between the Jumbo Shrimp and Generals in 2018. This is the only trip to Jackson for the Jumbo Shrimp this season, while the Generals will make their only trip to Jacksonville from June 13 to 17 to close out the first half of the season. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp and Generals split their five meetings, with Jacksonville winning three of five games in Jacksonville in late May, while the Generals won three of five in late June. The reason for so few meetings? The Jumbo Shrimp and Generals are separated by 713 miles, with typical bus rides lasting between 11 and 13 hours between North Florida and West Tennessee.

TONIGHT-DOUBLE-A DEBUT: Tonight right-handed pitcher Jeff Brigham makes his Double-A debut as he starts for the Jumbo Shrimp against the Jackson Generals. Brigham is coming off a season where he was 4-2 with a 2.90 ERA in 11 starts for High-A Jupiter.

2017 WITH JUPITER: After missing time from April to early June of last year on the disabled list with a right shoulder impingement, Brigham made 11 starts for High-A Jupiter, going 4-2 with a 2.90 ERA, striking out 53 batters in 59 innings of work. On June 18, 2017 he was named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week after a start on June 12 where he worked six scoreless innings against the St. Lucie Mets, allowing only one hit, walking two and striking out four. His year came to an early end on July 27 when he was placed on the disabled list with a right oblique strain and missed the rest of the season.

HOW HE GOT HERE: Brigham has had a long journey to the Double-A level in the Marlins organization. He was originally elected in the fourth round (129th overall) by the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2014, and made it as high as High-A in the Dodgers system in 2015. Acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 30, 2015 with RHP Victor Araujo and RHP Kevin Guzman in exchange for RHP Mat Latos, 1B Michael Morse, and cash. After finishing 2015 with High-A Jupiter, he spent all of the 2016 campaign with the Hammerheads, then injuries cut his 2017 season short, with only 11 starts for Jupiter.

2017 Highlights: After missing time from April to early June of last year on the disabled list with a right shoulder impingement, Brigham made 11 starts for High-A Jupiter, going 4-2 with a 2.90 ERA, striking out 53 batters in 59 innings of work. On June 18, 2017 he was named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week after a start on June 12 where he worked six scoreless innings against the St. Lucie Mets, allowing only one hit, walking two and striking out four. His year came to an early end on July 27 when he was placed on the disabled list with a right oblique strain and missed the rest of the season.

2016 Highlights: Brigham spent his first full season in the Marlins organization pitching for High-A Jupiter in the Florida State League. With the Hammerheads he was 7-8 with a 4.04 ERA in 27 games and 23 starts, striking out 112 batters in 122 and two-thirds innings of work. As a starter he was 7-8 with a 3.94 ERA in 23 starts, compared to no record with a 4.85 ERA in four relief outings with one save.

2015 Highlights: Brigham started the 2015 campaign with Single-A Great Lakes Loons in the Midwest League, where he was 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA in two relief outings in mid-April. Joined High-A Rancho Cucamonga on April 23, and was 4-5 with a 5.96 ERA in 17 appearances and 14 starts, striking out 64 batters in 68 innings of work. He was acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 30, 2015 with RHP Victor Araujo and RHP Kevin Guzman in exchange for RHP Mat Latos, 1B Michael Morse, and cash. He finished the season with High-A Jupiter, going 2-2 with a 1.87 ERA in six outings and five starts.

2014 Highlights: With rookie level Ogden, Brigham was 0-3 with a 3.58 ERA in 11 outings and 10 starts, striking out 33 batters in 32 and a third innings of work.

College: Attended the University of Washington just like both of his parents. Selected in the fourth round (129th overall) by the Los Angeles Dodgers. In 2014 was honorable Mention All-Pac-12 and First Team All-Academic ... tied for the team high with 16 starts ... was 7-4 with 2.90 ERA, giving up 79 hits, 33 runs (29 earned) in 90.0 innings pitched ... gave up 1 run or less in each of his first 6 starts, 9 of 16 total ... eight quality starts. In 2013 granted a medical redshirt after undergoing arm surgery. 2012: Appeared in 11 games, starting seven, during his sophomore season ... earned Academic All-Pac-12 honorable mention ... was limited by injury early in the year, but ended up as a regular in the starting rotation down the stretch as all seven starts came in Pac-12 play. 2011: Appeared in 23 games (tied for second-most on the team) and started five as a true freshman. Also played for the Bend (Ore.) Elks during the summer ... earned second-team All-West Coast League honors for the Elks ... over 22 innings, posted a 0.82 ERA with six saves, a 2-1 record and 17 strikeouts.

Personal: Earned two varsity letters under coach Mike Church ... captain as a senior ... Jefferson High School athlete of the year as a senior ... also the Federal Way Mirror's athlete of the year for 2009-10 ... hit. 447 with 18 RBI and 24 runs while posting a 0.76 ERA as a senior ... second-team All-South Puget Sound League (North) as both a pitcher and second baseman as a senior ... first-team All-SPSL 4A North as a junior ... pitched a no-hitter in a win over Kentwood as a junior ... also an honorable mention all-league basketball player as a senior ... once made eight three-pointers in a game, scoring 30 points in a win over Beamer ... also played golf and ran cross country in high school ... second-team All-SPSL North in golf in 2010 and offensive team MVP in basketball in 2010 ... graduated from Jefferson with a 3.98 grade point average.
