Last Game: Kyle Barrett hit a pinch-hit, walk-off single in the ninth inning to score catcher Sharif Othman from lift the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp over the Pensacola Blue Wahoos, 10-9, for a third straight victory in the opener of a five-game series in front of 5,640 on Budweiser Thirsty Thursday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. In a rematch of the 2017 Southern League South Division Championship Series, the Jumbo Shrimp (9-11) tallied 16 total hits – led by four from second baseman Isan Diaz and three by center fielder Monte Harrison, who both came within a triple of the cycle – in the first walk-off win for Jacksonville this season. Both teams scored in each of the first three innings. The Blue Wahoos (9-12) took the lead with a three-run first inning against Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Brandon Barker, but Jacksonville (9-11) answered against right-hander Daniel Wright, with two runs in the bottom of the inning, including Harrison's first Double-A home run out of the ballpark to left field. After Pensacola extended the lead to 4-2 in the second inning, Jacksonville rallied for three runs, including third baseman Brian Schales's first Double-A home run, and left fielder Austin Dean's RBI double for a 5-4 lead. Jacksonville right-hander Esmerling De La Rosa allowed three third-inning runs, including two on a two-out error by shortstop Mason Davis for a 7-5 Blue Wahoos lead. In the bottom of the inning, Davis hit an RBI triple, and Diaz hit a game-tying double. A 7-7 tie remained until the bottom of the sixth inning, when Diaz homered to left field off Pensacola right-hander Evan Mitchell. In the next half inning, Blue Wahoos left fielder Brian O'Grady hit a game-tying home run – the only run in three innings against Jacksonville right-hander Jose Pena. Diaz gave Jacksonville another lead with a seventh-inning, two-out RBI single off left-hander Victor Payano. In the ninth inning, Jacksonville left-hander Jeff Kinley (1-0) threw a two-out wild pitch to score the tying run. In the bottom half, Pensacola right-hander Alex Powers (0-1) hit catcher Sharif Othman, Schales put down a sacrifice bunt, Davis was intentionally walked, and Barrett lined the game-winning single to left field.

NEWS AND NOTES

Riddle Joins Shrimp on MLB Rehab Assignment: Miami Marlins shortstop JT Riddle joins the Jumbo Shrimp on a transfer of a major league rehab assignment from High-A Jupiter. Riddle played in two games for the Hammerheads on Tuesday and Wednesday, going 1-for-6 (.167) with his lone hit being a double Wednesday night against the Palm Beach Cardinals. Riddle started the season on Miami's disabled list with right shoulder tendinitis. Riddle first made it to the majors last season with Miami, hitting .250 with three homers and 31 RBI in 70 games before his season was cut short due to injury. Riddle starred for Jacksonville in 2015 and 2016, and was a 2016 Southern League Midseason All-Star, hitting .278 with three home runs and 51 RBI in 101 games played.

Dean Southern League Hitter of the Week, Leads MiLB in Avg: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp outfielder Austin Dean has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for April 16-22, announced by the league office on Monday morning. Over the past week in seven games, Dean hit .520 (13-for-25) with two home runs, six runs batted in, three doubles, and six runs scored. Dean in 20 games is hitting .466 (34-for-73), which is the best batting average in all of Minor League Baseball entering Thursday's games, and he also is tied for the MiLB lead with Triple-A Albuquerque's Daniel Castro with 34 hits. In 20 games played, Dean has hits in 18 of them (one game no official at-bat), with 11 of those games being multi-hit games.

Florida's AA Baseball Rivalry Resumes: This is the first of four series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and their in-state rivals, the Pensacola Blue Wahoos. The Shrimp will also host the Wahoos at the Baseball Grounds from May 29 to June 2. The Jumbo Shrimp will make two trips to Pensacola in the second half, facing the Blue Wahoos from July 18-22, and August 14-18 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. Last year the Jumbo Shrimp went 7-13 against the Wahoos, yet split the 10 meetings 5-5 at the Baseball Grounds. Pensacola won the first half South Division title, while Jacksonville took the second half South Division crown, and the clubs met in the Southern League playoffs, with all games played in Pensacola due to Hurricane Irma. The Wahoos swept the South Division Championship Series 3-0 to earn a share of the Southern League championship with Chattanooga.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the Opening Day roster, the Jumbo Shrimp had five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (2), Isan Diaz (8), RHP Nick Neidert (10), RHP Merandy Gonzalez (16) (recalled April 19 by the Marlins to Miami), and RHP Pablo Lopez (24), who began the year on Jacksonville's disabled list. All five of these prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.
