**Tonight's Game:** The San Jose Giants continue their road trip with the opener of a three-game series against the Visalia Rawhide (Diamondbacks affiliate) this evening. Casey Meisner (0-0, 2.89 ERA) is the Giants' scheduled starting pitcher. San Jose began their trip by winning two of three games from the Modesto Nuts.

**Winning Ways:** The Giants enter tonight's contest having won seven out of their last eight games. Since falling a season-high 10 games below .500 on May 4 (10-20), San Jose has posted an 11-4 record. A victory this evening would move the Giants (21-24) to within two games of the .500 mark for the first time since April 22 (8-10 record).

**Inside The Season Series:** Tonight marks the ninth of 28 meetings this season between San Jose and Visalia. The Giants are 2-6 versus the Rawhide this year. San Jose opened the season at Recreation Park and dropped three of four to Visalia. Two of the losses were in extra innings.

**Pitching Shines:** The Giants have fashioned a 1.59 team ERA over their last eight games (7-1 record). San Jose relievers have thrown 35 1/3 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run spanning the last 11 games. The last earned run given up by a Giants reliever came on May 10 at Lake Elsinore (Carlos Sano).

**April Showers Bring May Flowers:** After posting a league-worst 9-17 record in April, the Giants are 12-7 in May. San Jose owns a 3.15 team ERA this month after compiling a 4.23 mark in April.

**At The Plate:** The Giants knocked out 13 hits in last night's 6-1 win over Modesto – one off their season-high (14 hits, April 11 vs. Visalia – home opener). San Jose is seventh in the eight-team California League in batting average (.218), fifth in runs scored (4.0 per game) and sixth in on-base percentage (.303).

**Maris Makes Impact:** Peter Maris has made an immediate impact since joining the Giants on May 13. In seven games played, Maris is 9-for-21 (.429 AVG) with one double, two triples, one home run, four RBI's and two stolen bases. Maris has also drawn eight walks and only struck out twice. He boasts a .586 on-base percentage. Maris was picked-up by the San Francisco Giants from the Tampa Bay Rays in the minor league phase of the Rule 5 draft last December. Prior to joining San Jose last week, Maris had yet to play in a game this season as he recovered from Tommy John surgery.

**Late Innings:** The Giants are a perfect 19-0 this season when leading after seven innings. Conversely, San Jose has yet to win a game this year when trailing after seven (0-19).

**Injured List:** Eight San Jose players are currently on the injured list, including the #1 and #2 prospects in the San Francisco organization: Joey Bart and Heliot Ramos. Bart (broken hand) last played on April 15 while Ramos' (sprained knee) most recent action came on April 24.

**Tonight's Start:** 24-year old right-hander is slated to make his third start with the San Jose Giants this season in tonight's game at Visalia.

**As a Giant:** Is 0-0 with a 2.89 ERA in two starts for San Jose ... Has pitched 9 1/3 innings with six walks, five strikeouts and a .242 opponents batting average ... Joined the Giants on May 9.

**Last Time Out:** Tossed five scoreless innings in his most recent start on May 17 against Lake Elsinore ... Gave up two hits, walked a season-high four batters and struck out four ... Threw 69 pitches ... Received a no-decision (Giants won game 1-0 in 10 innings).

**Fourth Organization:** Signed a minor league deal with the San Francisco Giants on May 9 ... Was released by the St. Louis Cardinals organization on May 4 ... Has pitched in the New York Mets (2013-15), Oakland Athletics (2015-17), St. Louis Cardinals (2018-19) and now San Francisco Giants (2019) organizations ... Is in his seventh professional season.

**2019 With Springfield:** Began the year with Cardinals Double-A affiliate Springfield ... Was 0-2 with a 9.78 ERA in six games (four starts) before his release ... Allowed 10 home runs in 19 1/3 innings pitched ... Gave up 33 hits, walked six and struck out 20 ... Had a .367 opponents batting average.

**Double-A Stints:** Has spent parts of the last three seasons (2017-19) in Double-A ... Has made 22 career starts (25 appearances) in Double-A.

**Cal League Experience:** Has previously pitched in the California League with the Stockton Ports (A's affiliate) during the 2015, 2016 and 2017 seasons ... Made 51 appearances (38 starts) with Stockton combining for a 10-20 record and a 4.26 ERA ... Struck out 204 batters in 224 innings.

**Two-Time All-Star:** Has made two All-Star teams during his professional career ... Was a 2015 South Atlantic League All-Star with the Savannah Sand Gnats ... Also earned midseason California League All-Star honors with Stockton in 2017.

**Traded Twice:** Has been traded twice in his career ... Was traded from the Mets to the Athletics on July 27, 2015 in exchange for pitcher Tyler Clippard ... Was traded again on March 31, 2018 from the Athletics to the Cardinals in exchange for pitcher Josh Lucas.

**Draft Day:** Originally a third round selection of the Mets (84th overall pick) in 2013 out of Cypress Woods High School (Cypress, TX).

- \* Spent 2015-16 and most of 2017 in Double-A ... Was released by White Sox in April 2018 ... .209 career AVG in Double-A.
- \* Played for the Sugar Land Skeeters of the independent Atlantic League in 2018 (.285 AVG, 18 HR, 72 RBI).
- \* Signed with Cincinnati in August 2018 ... Hit .167 in 15 games with Louisville (AAA) this season ... Released by Reds on May 3.
- \* Drafted out of Mary Carroll High School (Corpus Christi, TX) ... Was the 2012 Texas Gatorade High School Player of the Year.
