**TODAY'S GAME:** The Quakes continue a three game series on the road against the Inland Empire 66ers (Los Angeles Angels affiliate). Friday's game is the second of a short three-game road trip for the Quakes and the first trip to San Manuel Stadium this season.

**VS INLAND EMPIRE:** This is the sixth of 30 overall meetings between the two clubs and the second of 14 games at San Manuel Stadium. The Quakes last played the 66ers in a four-game series at LoanMart Field and won three of four against the South Division opponents. Leo Crawford, Sven Schueller and Nolan Long all earned wins out of the bullpen during the series. Following an 8-1 victory for the Quakes in game one on Friday, Rancho currently leads the season series four-games-to-one.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Dustin May fired six scoreless innings and Cody Thomas and Gavin Lux both went deep, as Rancho Cucamonga pulled to within three games of first-place Inland Empire with an 8-1 victory over the 66ers at San Manuel Stadium. May, who retired the first 12 hitters he faced, earned his first career win in the California League, allowing just two hits, while striking out six batters, while not surrendering a walk. In the seventh, Rancho busted it open, as Thomas delivered an RBI single with the bases loaded to make it 2-0. Lux followed two batters later with a grand slam, his third long-ball of the year to open it up at 6-0.

**CONQUERING THE EMPIRE:** On the offensive end against the 66ers, Rylan Bannon and Connor Wong have shown the most success against Inland Empire pitching this season. Bannon is batting .409 (9-for-22) with two doubles and a triple against the 66ers to go along with five RBI's. Wong is batting .368 (7-for-19) and has a team-high .478 OBP with three home runs and seven RBI's vs. Inland Empire.

**ONE RUN NO FUN:** The Quakes have struggled in one-run games this season. Of the 47 total games played, 16 of those contests have been decided by a run, where the Quakes have just a 4-12 record. The Quakes have dropped the last four one-run games and have battled in a one-run affair over five of their last ten games played.

**2013:** The worst first half record for the Quakes in the Dodger era was in 2013 when the club finished 31-39, eight games below the five-hundred mark. The Quakes currently sit six games below the five-hundred mark with 22 games left to play on the first half schedule.

**THREE HUNDRED CLUB:** Entering Saturday's game, the Quakes are collectively batting .311 against the 66ers over the first five games of the season series. Rancho has totaled 55 hits across 177 at-bats and has driven in 35 total runs against 66ers pitching.

**CURRENT STREAKS:** Jeren Kendall had a season-high seven game hitting streak come to a close after going 0-for-3 on Thursday against Stockton. Connor Wong saw a season-high hitting streak of eight games come to a close on Wednesday going 0-for-4 against the Ports. Cristian Santana also lost a short four-game hitting streak yesterday but following a walk, has reached safely in five straight games.

**RECENT ROSTER MOVES:** Friday, catcher Steve Berman was placed on the Disabled List. Catcher Hamlet Marte was transferred to Rancho Cucamonga from Double-A Tulsa of the Texas League. Marte started the 2018 season with Rancho and played in 19 games (.286, 2 HR, 10 RBI).

**GONSOLIN GOES:** Tony Gonsolin (2-1) will make his tenth start of the season for the Quakes and second start against the 66ers. Gonsolin last pitched against Inland Empire at LoanMart Field on 4/13 and allowed one lone run over 3.1 innings while striking out four in a no-decision. Last time out, Gonsolin tossed a season-high seven innings and struck out five in a win against Lake Elsinore. Gonsolin was drafted by the Dodgers in the ninth round of the 2016 draft out of the University of Saint Mary's in the West Coast Conference.

**OPPOSING PITCHER:** Sean Isaac (1-0) is scheduled to make his first start of the year for the 66ers and fifth overall appearance on the hill. Isaac was transferred to Inland Empire from Triple-A Salt Lake on the Pacific Coast League on May 18 after making three appearances with the Bees (1-0, 7.88 ERA). He has since recorded four appearances out of the 66ers bullpen and last pitched 4.1 hitless innings against Lancaster on 5/19. The Torrance, CA native has also spent time this season at Low-A Burlington in the Midwest League (1-1, 3.38 ERA) and Double-A Mobile of the Southern League (0-0, 9.00 ERA). Isaac was drafted in the 35th round by the Angels in the 2016 draft out of Vanguard University in Vanguard, CA.

Monday's game marks the beginning of a seven-game home stand, as we welcome both the Storm and the Lancaster JetHawks. **REHABBERS:** The Quakes have had three different Dodgers join the club as apart of major league rehab assignment this season .Dodgers INF Justin Turner joined the Quakes along with INF Logan Forsythe in a weekend series vs. Visalia. Turner was 0-for-6 at the plate while Forsythe finished 1-for-10 with a double during their time in Rancho. Yasiel Puig joined the club on rehab assignment Tuesday (5/8) in Lake Elsinore. Puig was 0-for-4 at the plate and was removed from the game in the seventh inning.

**FAMILIAR FACES ON THE FARM:** A total of 16 former Quakes returned to Rancho Cucamonga to start the 2018 campaign, including 12 of the 14 original pitchers on the roster. Jordan Sheffield and Tony Gonsolin, ranked 18th and 24th in the Dodgers' system, by MLB Pipeline.com, return to the Quakes to help anchor the rotation. Former Quakes Dean Kremer, Issac Anderson and Andrew Sopko will also pitch out of the rotation. The bullpen began the year made up entirely of former Quakes, with Stetson Allie, Chris Matthewson, Parker Curry, Andrew Istler, Nolan Long, Ryan Moseley and Jason Richman making up the relief core. California League 2017 All-Star Ibandel Isabel, who mashed 28 home runs for last year's club, returned to the Quakes for a second year but was traded to the Cincinnati Reds. He was joined by returning infielder Omar Estevez and outfielder Logan Landon.

**SAME SKIPPER, NEW STAFF:** The skipper of the Quakes for a third consecutive year is Manager Drew Saylor, who has led the team to the Cal League Playoffs in each of the last two seasons. Saylor, whose team went 76-64 last season, is just the third manager in team history to lead the team for three seasons (Mike Basso 1996-1998, Bobby Meacham 2002-2004). The hitting coach is Justin Viele, a Fullerton native who enters his second year with the Dodgers. In 2017, the former Santa Clara Bronco was the hitting coach for the Ogden Raptors of the Pioneer League. Taking over pitching coach duties is Connor McGuiness who also enters his second year in the Dodgers' system. Last season, the Arlington, Virginia native worked in the same role for the Great Lakes Loons of the Midwest League, after spending three of the four previous years working for his alma mater, Emory University. The final member of Saylor's staff is assistant coach Petie Montero, another second-year member of the Dodgers' system, who coached in the DSL last year.

**NINE & ON TIME:** The Quakes are the only team in the California League that have yet to play an extra-inning game under the new MiLB rules this season. As a result, Rancho has completed all games in under four hours with the longest contest clocking in at 3:49 vs. Inland Empire on April 14th. April 14th marked the closest the Quakes have come to playing extras, tied at 6-6 in the ninth inning, Rancho scored the game-winning run in the bottom half and secured their first walk-off win of the season.

## BY THE NUMBERS

Gavin Lux's 12-game hitting streak was the longest by any Quake this season. Lux passed Rylan Bannon who held the previous season long streak of eleven games. Over the stretch (Apr 26-5/11), Lux was 23-for-51 at the plate with six-multi hit games during the streak.

Out of the bullpen, Parker Curry has added stability to the Quakes in the middle and late innings, allowing only a run over his last eight appearances. Curry's only run allowed in the month of May was on 5/11 vs. Visalia. Curry also has compiled two wins out of the bullpen over his last eight games.

The Quakes RBI-Leader Cristian Santana has been one of the most effective hitters with runner in scoring position this season. 24 of his 32 RBI's have come with RISP and he is batting at a .264 clip over those situations. With the bases loaded, Santana's average sky rockets to .375 where he is 3-for-8 with 9 RBI's.

## 3 Jeren Kendall OF \ L/R \ 6-0 \ 190 \ Clearwater, FL \ Round 1 (2017, LAD) \ Vanderbilt \ @JerenKendall

-Playing in his second season in the Dodgers organization, batted .221 over 35 games with Low-A Great Lakes in 2017  
 -Started as a freshman at Vanderbilt on the 2015 NCAA national runner-up team, was a .309 career hitter with 32 HR's and 152 RBI's  
 -Hit only Grand-Slam of the season for the Quakes on 5/10 at Lake Elsinore...grand slam was also Kendall's first home run of the season.  
 -Picked with the 23rd overall pick by the Dodgers in 2017 and is ranked as the #7 prospect in the Dodgers system by MLB Pipeline.com  
 -Father, Jeremy Kendall played minor league baseball in the Phillies organization.

## 5 Cristian Santana INF \ R/R \ 6-2 \ 175 \ San Cristobal, DR \ International Free Agent, 2014

-Playing in his fourth season in the Dodgers organization, split time in 2017 between short-season Ogden (.537, 10 G) and Great Lakes (.322, 44G)  
 -After being signed, spent three seasons in rookie ball before breakout 2017 earned him offseason promotion to Rancho Cucamonga  
 -Ranked as the #16 overall pre-season prospect in Dodgers system by Baseball America  
 -Season high ten-game hit streak 4/19-29.

## 6 Logan Landon OF \ R/R \ 6-2 \ 180 \ Lansing, MI \ Round 10 (2015, LAD) \ Texas-Pan American \ @Logan\_Landon

-Started the 2018 season with the Quakes...promoted to Double-A Tulsa on 4/30 (played 1 games)...promoted to Triple-A OKC on 5/3 (played four games)...transferred back to Rancho Cucamonga on 5/10  
 -Playing in his fourth professional season in the Dodgers system...in 2017 played in 20 games for the Quakes (.276, 16H, 3HR, 7RBI, 13R)  
 -Hit the Quakes first walk-off home run of the season (2-run HR) on 5/13 to beat Visalia 3-2 in the ninth inning.

 -Was a career .302 hitter over three seasons at the University of Pittsburgh...was named Third-Team All-ACC as a Junior

 -Added to the Quakes temporary inactive list on Friday, April 27 then reactivated on April 30th.  
 -Was a .319 career hitter at Virginia Tech...started in all but two games during his time with the Hokies...drafted by Red Sox in 27th round in 2015, did not sign.
