MODESTO NUTS (0-0) vs. LANCASTER JETHAWKS (0-0)

RHP LJAY NEWSOME (0-0, -.-- ERA) vs. RHP RICO GARCIA (0-0, -.-- ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The JetHawks welcome the Nuts (Seattle) to The Hangar to open the 2018 regular season...tonight's game is the 1st of 13 in the season series and the 1st of 9 games between the teams in Lancaster...RHP Rico Garcia makes his High-A debut on the mound against RHP LJay Newsome (0-0).

ALOHA, 2018: RHP Rico Garcia makes the first Opening Night start of his professional career tonight...native of Kapolei, HI went 2-2 with a 2.57 ERA in 8 games (4 starts) for Low-A Asheville in 2017...struck out a career-high 10 batter over 6.0 IP in his final start.

HEALTHY START: Lancaster beat Visalia, 13-2, on Opening Night at The Hangar last year...the JetHawks are 5-0 when opening the season at home since 2008...last loss on Opening Night at home was to Bakersfield in 2007...Lancaster is 7-3 in its last 10 home openers overall.

CRACKING THE NUTS: This opening series is a rematch of the 2017 Championship Series...the Nuts swept Lancaster in the best-of-5 series to win Modesto's first title since 2004...IF Joe Rizzo, who was named series MVP just after being promoted to High-A, is one of four returning players from the title-winning roster.

THANKS FOR THE MEMORIES: The 2017 JetHawks fell short of a title but experienced plenty of successes ... the team won the franchise's 5th South Division title, finished with the league's best regular season record (79-61) and won both the 1st and 2nd halves...also tied the league record with a .308 team batting average (1977

Lodi Dodgers) and led all of the minors with a franchise-record 313 stolen bases.

WELCOME BACK: Seven players who played for Lancaster in 2017 will begin 2018 with the club...they are: IF Roberto Ramos (13 HR in 122 games), OF Forrest Wall, RHP Trey Killian (11 wins in 153.1 IP), RHP Heath Holder, RHP Salvador Justo, RHP Alexander Guillen (11 saves) and RHP Brandon Gold.

READY FREDDIE: Fred Ocasio returns for his 2nd season as Lancaster's manager and his 4th-overall as the Rockies' High-A skipper...the 2018 season is his 22nd in the Rockies organization and his 13th as a manager.

ROCKIE TOPS: Lancaster starts the season with five of Colorado's top-30 prospects according to *Baseball America...*IF Colton Welker (#4) is followed by IF Tyler Kevin (#10), OF Forrest Wall (#18), RHP Reid Humphreys (#26) and OF Vince Fernandez (#27).

ALL-STAR SEASON: The Hangar is set to host the California League All-Star Game in 2018...the festivities begin with a *38 Special* concert at The Hangar on Monday, June 18...the All-Star Game and home run derby will take place on Tuesday, June 19...it will mark the 3rd All-Star Game in Lancaster and the first since 2001.

TUNE IN: Tonight's JetHawks game can be heard live via the Tuneln radio app on your smart phones and tablets and at jethawks.com...the game can also be heard in-park on FM 90.9 with Jason Schwartz and Brandon Liebhaber.

ABOUT GARCIA:

ALOHA, 2018: Garcia was named the club's Opening Night starter in 2018...the 3rd-year pro will be making the first Opening Night start of his career...has not started the season with a full-season club in his career...his teammate, RHP Trey Killian, was Lancaster's Opening Night starter in 2017...he allowed 1 run on 3 hits over 6.0 IP and earned the win in the 13-2 victory.

LAST SEASON: Began season with Short-Season Boise...went 0-4 with a 3.95 ERA over 8 starts...was promoted to Low-A Asheville and made full-season debut out of the bullpen on July 30...made 8 appearances overall with Tourists and went 2-2 with a 2.57 ERA...started his final 4 appearances...struck out 30 batters and walked 7 over 28.0 IP in South Atlantic League.

HOW YOU FINISH: Ended the 2017 season with his two best starts...did not allow a run over a career-high 6.1 IP in his second-to-last start on Aug. 26 against Lexington...struck out a career-high 10 batters over 6.0 innings in final start on Sept. 1 against Greenville...combined to allow just 2 runs on 9 hits over 12.1 IP in final two outings...struck out 15 and issued 1 walk.

PERSONAL: Drafted by the Rockies in the 30th round in 2016 out of Hawaii Pacific Univ. in Honolulu, HI...named HPU Male Athlete of the Year in 2015...set school records for single-season strikeouts (74) and single-game strikeouts (16) in 2014...the 16-strikeout performance came in a 12-inning complete game...attended Saint Louis High School in Honolulu...full name is Joshua Rico Garcia.
