LANCASTER JETHAWKS (13-11) vs. STOCKTON PORTS (15-9)

RHP TREY KILLIAN (0-2, 11.74 ERA) vs. RHP PARKER DUNSHEE (2-0, 1.66 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The JetHawks visit the Ports (Athletics) for the opening game of a 4-game series...RHP Trey Killian (0-2) takes the mound in search of his 1st win against Stockton RHP Parker Dunshee (2-0).

YESTERDAY: The JetHawks came from behind to beat the Quakes for the 2nd straight day, 7-6...Lancaster scored 4 runs in the 7th to take a 6-5 lead...after Rancho tied the game in the 8th, Max George delivered a go-ahead double in the bottom half of the inning.

MASH MAX: IF Max George's go-ahead double on Sunday was his 6th of the season...tied him with IF Colton Welker for the team lead...extended his hitting streak to 5 games...has an extra-base hit in all 5 games (2 2B, 3 HR)...batting .368 (7x19) with 7 RBI during the streak.

HUMP DAY: RHP Reid Humphreys has recorded saves in each of the last 2 games and in Lancaster's last 3 wins...is tied for the league lead with 6 saves...has a 0.00 ERA (0ER/7.1IP) with 7 strikeouts, 2 walks and only 4 hits allowed in his save opportunities.

M&M: After starting the season 2x26, OF Manny Melendez is 14x35 (.420) over his last 8 games, including 5 doubles and a triple...his 8-game hit streak is the 3rd-longest for the JetHawks this season and the club's longest active streak.

RUN, FORREST, RUN: OF Forrest Wall leads the Cal League with 5 triples and ranks 2nd with 10 stolen bases...ranks 1st among teammates with a 29 hits and 10 multi-hit games.

STREAKERS: IF Colton Welker has hit safely in 7-straight (10x28) while IF Tyler Nevin has a 6-game streak (9x25).

RICO SUAVE: RHP Rico Garcia leads the league with 34 strikeouts and 29.0 IP...his 2.79 ERA is the lowest among JetHawks starters...allowed 1 run on 4 hits over 7.0 IP with a season-high tying 8 strikeouts in last start Thursday at Visalia.

KEEP YOUR ENEMIES CLOSER: Lancaster is 7-2 in games decided by 2-or-fewer runs this season (4-1 in 1-run games)...has come from behind in 8 of 13 wins this season.

DOCKED: Today's game is the 1st of 28 against Stockton and 1st of 12 at Banner Island Ballpark...the Ports visit The Hangar for a 3-game series, 5/25-27.

WE GO WAY BACK: Seven players who played for Lancaster in 2017 begin 2018 with the club: IF Roberto Ramos, OF Forrest Wall, RHP Trey Killian, RHP Heath Holder, RHP Salvador Justo, RHP Alexander Guillen and RHP Brandon Gold.

SEEING STARS: The Hangar is set to host the California League All-Star Game in 2018...the festivities begin with a 38 *Special* concert at The Hangar on Monday, June 18...the All-Star Game and home run derby will take place on Tuesday, June 19...it will mark the 3rd All-Star Game in Lancaster and the first since 2001.

ABOUT KILLIAN:

LAST START (4/25 at VIS): Allowed a season-high tying 6 earned runs on 7 hits over 4.0 IP in a 10-5 loss at Visalia...gave up his 1st home run of the season...walked 4 and struck out 2.

THIS SEASON: Returns to Lancaster after a full season in the Cal League in 2017.

LAST SEASON: Finished 11-9 with a 6.34 ERA in a full season with Lancaster...led the CAL with 28 starts...tied for the league lead with 153.1 IP...tied for 2nd with 11 wins...his 130 strikeouts were 6th in the circuit...was Lancaster's Opening Night starter and allowed 1 run on 3 hits over 6.0 innings to earn the win...was named CAL Pitcher of the Week for July 24-29 after tossing consecutive 7.0-inning scoreless starts...tossed a team season-high 20.2 consecutive scoreless innings from July 24-Aug. 9...in final start, allowed 1 hit over 5.0-shutout innings against IE...did not pitch in the postseason.

PREVIOUSLY: Went 12-6 with a 3.87 ERA in 26 starts for Asheville in 2016...ranked 2nd in SAL with 12 wins...led club with 146.1 IP and 136 strikeouts...made professional debut with Grand Junction in 2015...was 1-4 with a 9.09 ERA in 9 starts.
