## INLAND EMPIRE 66ERS (16-17) vs. LANCASTER JETHAWKS (16-17)

RHP JOE GATTO (3-1, 4.50 ERA) vs. RHP BRANDON GOLD (3-1, 5.51 ERA)

**SETTING THE SCENE:** The JetHawks take on the 66ers (LA Angels) in the final game of a 3-game series and 6-game homestand...Lancaster sends RHP Brandon Gold (3-1) to the mound against RHP Joe Gatto (3-1).

**YESTERDAY:** Lancaster fell a run short of a big comeback for the 2nd-straight day...scored 7 runs to cut an 8-run deficit to 1 but ultimately lost, 9-8...Forrest Wall delivered 3 hits and reached base 5 times out of the leadoff spot while Roberto Ramos and Vince Fernandez each drove in 3 runs...Logan Longwith allowed 6 runs (3 earned) and was handed his 3rd loss.

**MARIACHI MASHER:** IF Roberto Ramos hit a double and picked up 3 RBI on Wednesday to extend his hitting streak to 9 games and up his league-best RBI-total to 31...also leads the league with 10 HR RBI and a 1.100 OPS...was named the Cal League Player of the Week (4/30-5/6) on Monday after batting .556 (15x27) with 5 HR, 14 RBI and a 1.872 OPS last week.

**HOT BAT AT HOT CORNER:** IF Colton Welker pushed his hitting streak to 15 games with a 2x3 performance on Wednesday...marks the club's longest streak of the season...batting .359 (23x64) during the streak...Stockton's Jonah Heim's current 16-game streak is the league's longest in 2018...notched his 11th double yesterday, the 2nd-highest total in the league.

**M&M:** OF Manny Melendez saw his 12-game hitting streak snapped with an 0x4 game Wednesday...batted .388 (19x49) with 5 doubles, 2 triples, a grand slam and 12 RBI during streak...started the season 2x26 before streak.

**LET ME HEAR YOU SAY TREJO:** IF Alan Trejo went hitless Tuesday to end his 12-game hitting streak...raised his batting average to a team-best .359 (2nd in league) during streak...was hitting .239 on 4/21, the day his streak began...had a strong case for Cal League Player of Week last week...hit .556 (15x27) over 6 games last week with 3 2B, 3B, 3 HR, 12 RBI and a 1.674 OPS.

**RICO SUAVE:** RHP Rico Garcia picked up his team leading 4th win of the season Sunday...tossed a career-high 8.0 innings, the most for a JetHawks starter this season...struck out 7 batters to increase his league-leading strikeout total to 49...3.56 ERA leads the club.

**EVIL EMPIRE:** Tonight's game is the 7th of 28 in the season series vs. IE and the 3rd of 14 in Lancaster...the clubs split a 4-game series in San Bernardino in the season's 1st matchup.

**IT'S HOW YOU FINISH:** Lancaster is 2-8 series openers this season...the club is 7-2 in series finales.

**SEEING STARS:** The Hangar is set to host the Cal League All-Star Game in 2018...the festivities begin with a 38 *Special* concert Monday, June 18...the All-Star Game & Home Run Derby will take place on Tuesday, June 19...it will mark the 3rd All-Star Game in Lancaster.

## ABOUT GOLD:

**LAST START (5/4 vs. SJ):** Allowed 4 runs (3 earned) on 3 hits over 4.0 innings...left game after being hit in right forearm by line drive in 5th...struck out 3, did not issue a walk.

**THIS SEASON:** Returns to Lancaster after pitching for the JetHawks in the 2nd half of 2017.

**LAST SEASON:** Pitched for Lancaster and Asheville...joined JetHawks rotation on July 1 and went 4-3 with a 4.40 ERA (37ER/75.2IP) over 12 starts...tossed 6-consecutive quality starts from July 9-Aug. 5 and pitched more than 6.0 inning in 5 of the 6 outings...tied a career-high with 8.0 IP on July 31 at LE and did not allow a run on 4 hits...started season with Asheville and went 4-5 with a 4.33 ERA (34ER/70.2IP) over 13 starts.

**STOPPER:** Was the JetHawks' best starting pitcher in the 2017 playoffs...went 1-0 with a 2.13 ERA (3ER/12.2IP) in 2 starts...threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a win over RC in Game 3 of the South Division Finals...started Game 2 of Championship Series against Modesto.
