## LANCASTER JETHAWKS (22-22) vs. LAKE ELSINORE STORM (19-25)

RHP RICO GARCIA (5-3, 3.44 ERA) vs. LHP ADRIAN MOREJON (2-3, 3.67 ERA)

**SETTING THE SCENE:** The JetHawks take on the Storm (San Diego) in the opening game of a 3-game series and 4th of a 6-game road trip (1-2)...RHP Rico Garcia takes the mound in search of his team-leading 6th win opposite Storm LHP Adrian Morejon (2-3).

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** Lancaster enters the day in a 1st-place tie with Inland Empire in the South Division...is 3.0 games up on both the Storm and Quakes...has been in 1st or tied for 1st in 38 out of 45 days this season.

**RICO SUAVE:** RHP Rico Garcia enters tonight's game having recorded quality starts in 4 of his last 5 outings...leads the JetHawks and ranks 9th in the league with a 3.44 ERA...also leads club and is 4th in league with 57 strikeouts over a league-leading 55.0 IP.

**INVINCIBLE:** OF Vince Fernandez was named the Cal League Player of the Week Monday for the week of 5/14-20...hit .370 with 3 HR, 6 RBI and a 1.322 OPS on the week...added 3 doubles and a triple...marks the 3rd weekly honor for the club this season...overall, leads the club batting .324 (5th in league) and is 2nd with a 1.054 OPS.

**SUNDAY BLOODY SUNDAY:** Lancaster dropped the rubber game at Inland Empire, 12-2, on Sunday afternoon...was out-hit 19-4...gave up a season-high 10 extra-base hits...dropped to 3-7 against the 66ers this season.

**THE WALL HITS BACK:** OF Forrest Wall's recorded his 20th multi-hit game of the season with a double and HR on Saturday...was his 40th game played...leads the league with 57 hits, 38 runs

scored and tied for first with 5 triples...ranks 2nd with 19 stolen bases.

**HUMP DAY:** RHP Reid Humphreys recorded his league-leading 10th save of the season Friday...has a 0.00 ERA (0ER/11.1IP) in 11 save chances...has not allowed a run over 7.0 IP in May with 10 strikeouts and just 3 hits allowed.

**THE GUILLOTINE:** RHP Alexander Guillen tossed 2.0-hitless innings of relief Saturday...has not allowed a hit, or run, over last 5 outings (8.1 IP)...opponents are hitting just .177 against him.

**MARIACHI MASHER:** IF Roberto Ramos ranks 2nd in the league with 11 HR and 32 RBI...is atop the circuit with a 1.054 OPS.

**BIENVENUE, BOWDEN:** LHP Ben Bowden joined the JetHawks from Asheville on 5/18...is org.'s 20th-ranked prospect according to *Baseball America*.

**BATTLING THE STORM:** The JetHawks are 2-2 against the Storm in 2018...today's game is the 5th of 28 in the season series and the 5th of 14 at The Diamond.

**SEEING STARS:** The Hangar is set to host the Cal League All-Star Game in 2018...the festivities begin with a 38 *Special* concert Monday, June 18...the All-Star Game & Home Run Derby will take place on Tuesday, June 19...it will mark the 3rd All-Star Game in Lancaster.

**ALOHA, 2018:** Tied seas out a season-high 8 batters in loss at IE on 4/20...tossed a career-high 7.0 scoreless-IP in shutout win at LE on 4/15...was club's Opening Night starter (4/5) and allowed 5 earned runs on 9 hits over 5.0 frames vs. Modesto.
