SETTING THE SCENE: The JetHawks take on Inland Empire (LA Angles) in the final game of a 4-game series and 4th game of a 7-game road trip...RHP David Hill (1-1) takes the mound in his 3rd start opposite 66ers RHP Jeremy Beasley (1-1).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Lancaster enters the day in a 3rd-place tie with Inland Empire, 2.0 games behind 1st-place Rancho Cucamonga and 1.0 game behind 2nd-place Lake Elsinore...4 games remain in the 1st Half...the club finishes the half with 3 games at Lake Elsinore...Lancaster's first half elimination number is 3.

'HAWK STARS: The Cal League announced the rosters for next Tuesday's All-Star Game in Lancaster...eight JetHawks, the most of any South Division team, were selected...OF Vince Fernandez and IF Roberto Ramos were voted into the starting lineup...the club's pitching and reserve selections include RHP Rico Garcia, RHP Heath Holder, RHP Reid Humphreys, RHP Justin Lawrence, IF Alan Trejo and IF Colton Welker...the South club will be managed by JetHawks skipper Fred Ocasio.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Lancaster scored 4 runs in the 4th to overcome a 3-0 deficit...Steven Linkous delivered a go-ahead 2-run single in the inning...pitchers held 66ers scoreless over final 6 frames...Ty Culbreth picked up the win with a quality start over 7.0 innings...Justin Lawrence and Reid Humphreys each tossed perfect innings to end the game.

THAT'S CALLED A WINNING STREAK: Wednesday's win gave Lancaster wins in back-to-back games for the first time since May 17-18.

RICO SUAVE: RHP Rico Garcia picked up his team-leading 6th win with his team-best 8th quality start Tuesday...leads the league with 86.0 IP and ranks 2nd with 88 strikeouts.

MARIACHI MASHER: IF Roberto Ramos blasted his league-leading 17th homer Monday...also leads league with 42 RBI a .665 SLG and a 1.069 OPS...was named the Cal League Player of the Month for May...led league with 9 homers and hit .345 with a 1.201 OPS.

SERIES BUSINESS: A win tonight would give Lancaster its first series win since a 3-game sweep of Visalia May 15-17.

HUMP DAY: RHP Reid Humphreys has not allowed an earned run since April 21 at IE...current 16.0 scoreless-IP streak is longest on the club this season...ranked 1st in league with 13 saves.

vs. THE EVIL EMPIRE: The JetHawks are 7-10 in the season series against Inland Empire and 5-5 in games played at San Manuel Stadium...tonight's game is the 18th of 28 in the season series and the 11th of 14 in San Bernardino.

SEEING STARS: The Hangar is set to host the Cal League All-Star Game in 2018...the festivities begin with a 38 *Special* concert Monday, June 18...the All-Star Game & Home Run Derby will take place on Tuesday, June 19...it will mark the 3rd All-Star Game in Lancaster.
