SETTING THE SCENE: The JetHawks take on Inland Empire (LA Angels) in 2nd game of a 4-game series and homestand...RHP David Hill (1-2) takes the mound in search of his 2nd win opposite 66ers LHP Nate Bertness (1-4).

GIVE ME A BREAK: Last night's game marked the start of the 2018 season's 2nd Half...Lancaster finished the 1st Half in a tie for 3rd place with Inland Empire, 2.0 games behind the 1st-Half Champion Rancho Cucamonga.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The JetHawks scored 2 runs in each of the first 3 innings and held on late to take the 2nd-half opener...Ty Culbreth allowed 3 runs over 6.0 IP for the win and Justin Lawrence and Reid Humphreys held off a late 66ers rally to finish the win...Brian Serven hit a solo HR while Alan Trejo, Jacob Bosikovic and Stephen Linkous all added 2 hits.

STREAKING: C Brian Serven hit his 5th HR of the season Thursday to extend his hitting streak to 10 games...batting .325 (13x40) during the streak...tied for 3rd-longest streak on the team this season.

HUMP DAY: RHP Reid Humphreys picked up his league-leading 14th save to finish Thursday's win...allowed an earned run to snap his scoreless-innings streak at 16.0, the longest on the club this season...had not allowed an earned run since April 21.

WELCOME WES: OF Wes Rogers was added to Lancaster's roster from Hartford (AA) prior to Friday's game...2017 Cal League Postseason All-Star set a Lancaster franchise record with 70

stolen bases last season...hit .319 with 37 doubles, 9 HR and 82 RBI...was batting .200 in 54 games with Yard Goats in Eastern League.

MARIACHI MASHER MEMORIES: IF Roberto Ramos was promoted to Hartford (AA) after Tuesday's All-Star Game...leaves Lancaster leading the league with 17 HR and a 1.051 OPS...tied a club season-high with 4 walks in his final game Sunday...including last season, hit 30 HR in 182 Cal League games.

SHINING STARS: The North Division beat the South Division, 8-1, in Tuesday's All-Star Game at The Hangar...Stockton's Dairon Blanco was named MVP after going 4x5 with a double and HR...7 JetHawks appeared in the game, the most of any South club...the JetHawks introduced a brand new video board to the 4,673 fans in attendance for the 3rd All-Star Game in Lancaster history.

OTHER MOVES: OF Willie Abreu was placed on the 7-Day DL Thursday...OF Brett Stephens was added from Grand Junction (R)...former UCLA outfielder was drafted in the 28th round in 2017.
