MDOESTO NUTS (34-50) vs. LANCASTER JETHAWKS (41-43)

RHP DARREN McCAUGHAN (4-5, 2.56 ERA) vs. RHP BRANDON GOLD (5-5, 5.98 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The JetHawks take on Modesto (Seattle) in the 2nd game of a 5-game series and homestand...RHP Brandon Gold (5-5) is slated to start for Lancaster opposite Nuts RHP Darren McCaughan (4-5).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The JetHawks scored 6 runs on 9 hits in the 2nd inning to break the game open...Alan Trejo went 4x5 with a double, and Joel Diaz delivered 2 hits and drove in 2 runs...Matt Dennis allowed 3 runs on 7 hits over 6.2 innings to pick up his 6th win.

FULL FOR FOURTH: Lancaster announced a crowd of 5,377, its largest of the season, for Wednesday's July 4th game...was 2nd sell out of season at The Hangar.

HITS FOR 'HAWKS: The JetHawks recorded 9 hits in the 2nd inning Wednesday, a new season-high...6-straight batters recorded RBI-hits in the frame.

IT WAS A TRIP: Lancaster finished its season-long 9-game road trip with a 5-4 record...started trip by taking 3 of 4 in Modesto...lost 3 out of 5 in Stockton...is 22-22 overall on the road.

HOT BAT AT HOT CORNER: IF Colton Welker has hit safely in each of his last 8 games...battingg .400 (12x30) during the streak...raised his average to a team-best .310.

DOUBLE-ACE: RHP Rico Garcia was transferred to Hartford (AA) on Sunday...ranked atop the league in wins (7), IP (100.0) and ranked 2nd with 101 strikeouts...led JetHawks with a 3.42

ERA and 10 quality starts over 15 starts...had a 2.14 ERA (8ER/33.2IP) over last 5 outings.

HUMP DAY: RHP Reid Humphreys recorded his league-leading 18th save Sunday night...has converted 15-straight saves...has a 0.49 ERA (1ER/18.1IP) in 19 save chances...franchise record for saves is 24 (RHP Matt Elliott, 2006).

SHO AND GO: Lancaster shut out Stockton in back-to-back games over the weekend...marked the first consecutive shutouts for Lancaster since at least 2004.

WON WITH ONE: Sunday's 1-0 final was the first such win for Lancaster since 4/29/16 at Lake Elsinore...RHP Trent Thornton (5.0IP) and RHP Josh James (4.0IP) combined on a 1-hitter...IF Nick Tanielu drove home the game's only run.

TIME MOVES FAST: The JetHawks finished June with a 13-13 record...posted a 4.66 ERA, the club's best monthly ERA this season...IF Carlos Herrera hit .338 with a team-best .948 OPS.

CRACKING THE NUTS: Tonight's game is the 9th of 13 in the season series and the 5th of 9 games at The Hangar...Lancaster is 6-2 against the Nuts this season and 3-1 in Lancaster...is 20-16 against North Division opponents.

ABOUT GOLD:

LAST START (6/29 at STK): Took a loss to even his record at 5-5...tied career-high allowing 8 earned runs and allowed career-high 13 hits...struck out 3 and walked 1...allowed a home run.

LAST SEASON: Pitched for Lancaster and Asheville...joined JetHawks rotation on July 1 and went 4-3 with a 4.40 ERA (37ER/75.2IP) over 12 starts...tossed 6-consecutive quality starts from July 9-Aug. 5 and pitched more than 6.0 inning in 5 of the 6 outings...tied a career-high with 8.0 IP on July 31 at LE and did not allow a run on 4 hits...started season with Asheville and went 4-5 with a 4.33 ERA (34ER/70.2IP) over 13 starts.

STOPPER: Was the JetHawks' best starting pitcher in the 2017 playoffs...went 1-0 with a 2.13 ERA (3ER/12.2IP) in 2 starts...threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a win over RC in Game 3 of the South Division Finals...started Game 2 of Championship Series against Modesto.
